DAY 4 | 17 Mar, 2026

Melbourne - City Sightseeing tour with River Cruise [B/-/-]

Enjoy your breakfast this morning. We'll kick off the afternoon with a relaxing cruise along the Yarra River, offering you the chance to unwind and enjoy stunning city views from a unique perspective. As we sail, we'll pass by the historic "Polly Woodside" and the bluestone wharves, remnants of Melbourne's early settlement days.

After the cruise, we'll return to land and embark on a coach tour of the city. We'll drive through Melbourne's lively Central Business District and Melbourne Park, then make a stop at the Royal Botanic Gardens, where you can take a leisurely stroll through the beautiful, well-maintained grounds.

Next, we'll head towards the Docklands waterfront via the Bolte Bridge, continuing along the Port Melbourne bay. During this leg of the tour, you'll be treated to scenic views of St Kilda and Brighton.

We'll then make a stop in the trendy Acland Street for a coffee and a pastry (own expense). After indulging in some delicious treats and recharging with a hot drink, you'll have the chance to take a photo in front of the iconic Brighton Beach bathing boxes.

For sports fans, there's plenty to see, including Melbourne's beloved cricket ground, Etihad Stadium, and Albert Park Lake, which hosts the Australian Formula One Grand Prix.

By the end of the tour, you'll have experienced Melbourne from a variety of viewpoints, immersing yourself in the city's culture, history, and breathtaking scenery.

Overnight in Melbourne

DAY 5 | 18 Mar, 2026

Melbourne - Day free at leisure [B/-/-]

Enjoy a day at your own pace in Melbourne, with the freedom to explore this vibrant city however you choose. Whether you prefer to wander through its eclectic laneways filled with street art and boutique shops, relax in one of its many charming cafes, or visit world-class attractions like the Melbourne Museum or the National Gallery of Victoria, the day is yours to design. You might opt to take a stroll through the lush Royal Botanic Gardens, browse the bustling Queen Victoria Market, or even venture a bit further afield to explore nearby beaches or wineries. However you decide to spend your time, today offers the perfect opportunity to experience Melbourne in your own unique way.

Add-on : Great Ocean Road & 12 Apostles Tour - USD 120 Per person on shared basis

Leaving the city behind, we'll make our way to the eastern starting point of the Great Ocean Road to begin our scenic coastal adventure. Our first stop includes a relaxing break for morning tea, giving you a chance to unwind and take in the stunning views before we continue to the famous Memorial Arch. This iconic spot offers the perfect opportunity for some memorable photos. We'll then head to the charming seaside town of Apollo Bay for lunch, where you can enjoy a delicious meal and recharge before the afternoon's exploration. After lunch (own expense), we'll take a short, guided 20-minute bushwalk through Melba Gully to see the serene Cascades waterfall nestled in the rainforest. Once everyone is back on board, we'll travel to one of the tour's highlights—the magnificent 12 Apostles.

These towering limestone formations rising from the Southern Ocean offer breathtaking photo opportunities and a true sense of Australia's coastal beauty. Next, we'll explore the dramatic scenery of Loch Ard Gorge, framed by towering cliffs. As we walk around, we'll visit natural landmarks like the Archway, the Razorback, and the Dumpling Pots, while also hearing the fascinating tale of Australia's most well-known shipwreck. To wrap up the day, we'll return to Melbourne via an inland route, passing through a series of quaint country towns along the way.

Please note: *During busy times, this tour may run in reverse order.*

And just a heads up—this is a full day with a lot of ground to cover, but that's because we want to make sure you experience all the highlights of the stunning Great Ocean Road. It's going to be a big day, but one packed with unforgettable sights and experiences!

Add-on : Phillip Island tour - USD 150 Per person on Shared basis

Our day begins in Melbourne as we journey along the coast to our first stop—Moonlit Sanctuary Wildlife Conservation Park. Here, your guide will lead you through this award-winning park, home to a wide variety of native Australian animals. From iconic creatures like kangaroos, wombats, and Tasmanian devils to more unique species such as the spot-tailed quoll, yellow-bellied glider, and long-nosed potoroo, there's plenty to discover. You'll also have the chance to attend a ranger-led talk on koalas and gain insight into these beloved marsupials. Wander through the park to observe native birds and reptiles, hand-feed kangaroos and wallabies, or opt for a photo opportunity with a koala (additional cost). We'll then continue on to Phillip Island, with our next stop at the scenic Cape Woolamai Beach. Here, you can enjoy a stroll along the sand and watch the surfers ride the waves. From there, we head to the Nobbies, where coastal boardwalks offer stunning views of rugged cliffs and crashing waves. Keep an eye out for fur seals on the nearby Seal Rocks, and be impressed by the natural blowhole as it sprays water into the air. Depending on the season, you may spot migrating whales offshore in winter or tiny penguin chicks nestled in their burrows during summer. As evening approaches, we'll make our way to Summerland Beach to witness the unforgettable Penguin Parade. Once darkness falls, the little penguins

begin their nightly return from the ocean, waddling across the sand in small groups to reach their burrows. Stroll along the boardwalks for a close-up view of these charming creatures as they head home after a day of fishing at sea. At the end of this magical experience, we'll regroup and travel back to Melbourne.

Add-on: Yarra Valley Sunset tour - USD 190 Per person on shared basis

The tour will begin at noon at Federation Square, which is across the street from Flinders Station. As we drive out of the hustle and bustle of the city, we will head towards Yarra Valley. The first stop of the day will be at Domaine Chandon. You will be able to take in the gorgeous vineyard scenery from our table with a view. The Chandon is known for its sparkling wine, which is available for purchase along with fresh oysters and other tasty hors d'oeuvres. After enjoying a glass of wine and some food, you will have time to visit the chic boutique and purchase any goodies you may want to bring home. The next stop of the tour is Yarra Valley Dairy. You'll get to sample a large variety of cheese produced right in the centre of the Yarra Valley. After grazing on cheese samples, we will visit Yering Station Winery. Here, you can sample classic cool climate wines including the world-famous Shiraz. The gourmet adventure is completed with a visit to Yarra Valley Chocolaterie and Ice Creamery. You will get to indulge in a private chocolate tasting before taking some time to browse the large range of truffles available at the shop. After a tasting tour through the Yarra Valley, you will get to enjoy a Kangaroo Safari. As the sun starts to drift towards the horizon, the kangaroos will begin to come out of their resting spots. You'll see anywhere from a dozen to one hundred kangaroos as they hop around and graze along the lower Yarra Valley. The exciting afternoon of tastings and wildlife spotting will wrap up between 6:30 pm to 7:30 pm as we make our way back to Melbourne

DAY 6 | 19 Mar, 2026

After breakfast, you will be transferred to Melbourne airport for your flight to Cairns. Upon arrival in Cairns, you will be transferred to your hotel (Standard check-in time is 3:00 pm).

Your rest of the day in Cairns is free for you to enjoy at

your own pace, offering the perfect chance to explore this laid-back tropical city. You might choose to take a leisurely stroll along the scenic Esplanade, where you can enjoy views of the waterfront, public art installations, and perhaps even catch some live entertainment. If you're in the mood for dining, Cairns offers a variety of restaurants and bars serving everything from fresh seafood to international cuisine. You could also browse the Night Markets for souvenirs, local crafts, or a quick bite to eat. Whether you prefer a quiet evening by the lagoon or a lively night out in the town, Cairns has something for every mood.

DAY 7 | 20 Mar, 2026

Cairns - Day free at leisure [B/-]

You've got a whole day to yourself in Cairns, so take it easy and explore the city however you like. Whether you're in the mood for some relaxation or ready for a bit of adventure, it's your time to enjoy. You might want to stroll along the Esplanade, stop by the lagoon, check out the lively cafés, or simply kick back and observe the local wildlife. If shopping's your thing, Cairns has some charming boutique shops and local markets to browse. Or, if you're feeling adventurous, head out and explore the nearby rainforest or beaches. Cairns offers the perfect balance of chill vibes and exciting activities to make your day unforgettable.

Add-on: Great Barrier Reef Cruise- USD 250 Per person on shared basis

The day begins at 8:00 am as we board the boat in Cairns. Before we depart, you'll receive a quick briefing and a snorkelling demonstration to ensure you're ready to jump right in when we reach the first reef. As we head out, enjoy a delicious breakfast roll to energize you for the day ahead. Once we arrive at the first reef, you'll have the opportunity to dive into the water and explore the underwater world through scuba diving.

The specific reefs we visit will depend on the weather, but we may explore Hastings Reef, Breaking Patches Reef, Saxon Reef, Norman Reef, or Jorgensen Patch. Each location offers great diving conditions and unique marine life.

After your first dive, we'll enjoy a tasty lunch and you'll have plenty of time to relax on deck, taking in the stunning reef views. We'll then head to the next reef for an afternoon of diving, where you can continue to

explore the vibrant underwater ecosystem.

If diving isn't for you, feel free to swim, snorkel, or simply lounge on the deck and soak up the sun.

On our return journey to Cairns, you can enjoy the final views of the Great Barrier Reef before we arrive back around 4:30 pm.

Add-on: Day trip to Fitzroy Island - USD 120 Per person on shared basis

The Great Barrier Reef is made up of thousands of stunning, unique islands, and Fitzroy Island is one of its gems. This national park is primarily covered in lush tropical rainforest, which gently slopes down to pristine shores that border the Great Barrier Reef. Just a 55-minute cruise from Cairns, Fitzroy Island is the perfect destination for a day trip, where you can admire the beauty of this natural wonder and engage in exciting activities.

The island's beaches are a highlight, and our full-day tour gives you plenty of time to sink your toes into the sand and take in the breathtaking views of the Great Barrier Reef. In addition, you can explore the untouched forests and take part in activities such as snorkelling, hiking, or swimming in the calm, shallow waters.

The adventure begins with a comfortable air-conditioned catamaran ride to the island, where you'll enjoy scenic views along the way. Once on Fitzroy Island, you'll have up to 5 hours to explore, snorkelling along the fringing reef just meters from the beach, taking a self-guided walk through the rainforest, or participating in other exciting activities.

Options include self-guided bushwalks, kayaking, stand-up paddleboarding (SUP), or booking a guided snorkel tour. You can also upgrade your experience by adding a glass-bottom boat tour and hiring snorkel gear for the day. Whether you choose to snorkel, swim, or simply relax on the beautiful beaches, there's something for everyone. In the afternoon, we'll return to Cairns, taking the scenic route through the Great Barrier Reef.

DAY 8 | 21 Mar, 2026

Cairns - Day free at leisure [B/-]

You'll have a full day at leisure in Cairns, allowing you to explore the city at your own pace. Whether you want to relax or embark on your own adventure, the day is yours to enjoy. You could take a walk along the Esplanade, where you can visit the lagoon, enjoy the vibrant café scene, or simply sit and watch the local wildlife. For those interested in shopping, Cairns has a mix of boutique stores and local markets to browse. Alternatively, you might choose to venture further out and discover nearby natural wonders, such as the rainforest or the beaches. Whatever your preference, Cairns offers a perfect mix of relaxation and adventure for your free day.

**Add-on: Kuranda Skyrail & Scenic Rail Experience
- USD 195 Per person on Shared basis**

After being picked up from your hotel in central Cairns, you'll soar above the UNESCO World Heritage-listed rainforest canopy on the 7.5-kilometre Skyrail Rainforest Cableway. During the journey, you'll have the chance to stop at two intermediate stations, where you can explore the forest floor on boardwalks and enjoy a stunning view of Barron Falls from the glass floor of The Edge Lookout.

Next, your driver and guide will escort you to Freshwater Station, where you'll board the vintage carriages of the Kuranda Scenic Railway. As you travel north, the train follows the Barron River, with a scenic two-hour ride offering views of spectacular cascades, all protected by Barron Gorge National Park. After stopping to admire the stunning Barron Falls, you'll arrive in Kuranda.

Originally settled by Europeans in 1885, Kuranda is home to several interesting historical sites, including the charming St Saviour's Church and the wreckage of a Japanese bomber that crashed during World War II. After exploring the heritage markets, you'll have approximately 3.5 hours of free time to visit attractions such as the Kuranda Koala Gardens, the Australian Butterfly Sanctuary, or Birdworld.

After experiencing the breathtaking scenery from various viewpoints, you'll make your way back to Cairns to wrap up your day.

After breakfast, you will be transferred to Cairns airport for your flight to Sydney. Upon arrival in Sydney, you will be transferred to your hotel (Standard check-in time is 3:00 pm).

You might choose to take a leisurely walk around Circular Quay, where the Sydney Opera House and Harbour Bridge are beautifully lit after dark. For food lovers, Sydney boasts a diverse culinary scene—from trendy rooftop bars and fine dining restaurants to casual eateries offering everything from fresh seafood to international cuisine. If you're in the mood for shopping or entertainment, areas like Darling Harbour and The Rocks come alive in the evening with bustling markets, live music, and waterfront views. Whether you prefer a quiet evening soaking in the atmosphere or diving into the city's buzzing energy, the night is yours to enjoy however you please.

DAY 10 | 23 Mar,

After breakfast, proceed on a sightseeing tour of Sydney. We'll begin the day by heading to The Rocks, one of Sydney's oldest neighborhoods and often considered the city's birthplace. a popular lookout spot that offers sweeping views of the harbour and skyline.

As we move through the day, you'll also get a taste of Sydney's diverse neighborhoods—from the upscale residences of the eastern suburbs to the stylish streets of Paddington and the energetic vibe of Chinatown. Of course, a visit to Sydney wouldn't be complete without some time at the world-famous Bondi Beach. Watch surfers ride the waves, feel the sand beneath your feet, or unwind with a cup of tea at a cozy beachside café.

To wrap up the experience, we'll board a cruise for a scenic lunch on the harbour. As you enjoy a spread of local delicacies—featuring fine meats, cheeses, fresh fruits, and artisan breads—you'll sail past some of Sydney's most captivating sights, offering a relaxing and delicious end to the day.

Next, we'll make our way to Echo Point for breathtaking views over Jamison Valley and the famous Three Sisters rock formation. While in the area, you'll enjoy access to all three of Scenic World's top attractions: ride the

Scenic Cableway—the highest cable car in the country—the Scenic Skyway, and the Scenic Railway, known as the steepest passenger railway in the world. Each offers a different, thrilling perspective of the stunning Blue Mountains.

Our final stop will be at Sydney Olympic Park Wharf, where the day's tour comes to an end. Rather than navigating through city traffic, you'll have the option to board a ferry back to Sydney Harbour (at your own expense). Sit back with a drink in hand and relax as you cruise past the city's skyline. You can choose to disembark at either Darling Harbour or Circular Quay and enjoy a leisurely evening in Sydney.
