DAY 1 | 19 Sep, 2025

Depart Los Angeles [-/-/]

Prepare yourself! You are leaving today for Tokyo to start your unbelievable Best of Japan Journey.

DAY 2 | 20 Sep, 2025

Tokyo Arrival [-/-/]

Konnichiwa Tokyo. Welcome to Japan! You will be met in the arrivals hall by our local representative, who will welcome you to Japan and go through any immediate questions you might have. You will then be assisted to a private vehicle to enjoy a relaxed, hassle-free transfer to your downtown hotel. Depending on traffic, this transfer will take around 75-90 minutes. (standard check-in time 3:00 Pm)

After a peaceful night's rest, Embark on an exciting day starting at **Tsukiji Outer Market**, Japan's "Food Town," where you'll delight in a myriad of traditional culinary delights. Explore the vibrant wholesale and retail shops, savor fresh sushi, and immerse yourself in the bustling atmosphere. Afterward, dive into the captivating world of the samurai with a thrilling **Samurai Lesson Experience**. Learn the ancient art of swordsmanship and immerse yourself in Japan's rich samurai culture. Continue your journey to **Ginza**, Tokyo's upscale district, renowned for its high-end shopping and exquisite dining. Discover luxury boutiques, and art galleries, and indulge in the district's sophisticated ambiance. Continue to **Akihabara**, mecca for otaku shoppers. You can enjoy wandering around huge anime stores with hundreds of figurines

and cosplay goods. For a head-turning look at Japanese youth fashion, **Harajuku** is the place. Afterward, explore the iconic Shibuya district, the site of the world's most trafficked pedestrian crossing. Shibuya Scramble Square, a 755-foot (230 m) tower, is a great place to people-watch on the crossing below. To finish your day, take in the panoramic cityscape from the 52nd floor of the **Mori Tower** in Roppongi Hills.

DAY 4 | 22 Sep, 2025

Tokyo - Day free at leisure [B/-/]

You can then stroll through the serene Meiji Shrine, nestled in a peaceful forested area, offering a quiet escape from the city's fast-paced life. For a taste of Tokyo's eclectic shopping scene, head to Harajuku or Ginza, where you'll find everything from high-end designer boutiques to quirky, trendy shops. Food lovers can indulge in delicious sushi, or sample traditional ramen at one of the many local eateries. Tokyo - Mt. Fuji - Hakone [B/-/D]

After breakfast today Step away from the hustle and bustle of Tokyo and surround yourself with nature as you visit the highest mountain in Japan. Ride the thrilling Hakone Ropeway and enjoy a scenic cruise on

Lake Ashi. Upon arrival at Mt. Fuji, we will first take you to all the way up to the 5th station of Mt. Fuji, 2,000 meters above ground. Take a deep breath at the wonderful nature in Mt. Fuji while seeing magnificent scenery. Also feel the sacred atmosphere at Japanese shinto Shrine there! *If you can't go beyond the 4th station, we will visit Oshino Hakkai or alternative place.

After recharging some energies, the bus head to Hakone area! Starting with "Owakudani" a valley once was called "Valley of Hell." It is still an active volcano that you can still see the steam coming from the ground. We will take a Hakone Ropeway, an exhilarating experience with an amazing view of Mt. Hakone. You can see the rich nature of the mountain and you can even see Mt. Fuji in a clear sky! This ropeway will take you to Lake Ashi, a caldera lake. Enjoy the refreshing cruise of Lake Ashi and see the beautiful natural landscape and Mt. Fuji. Don't miss out to see Torii Gate which is floating on the water!

DAY 7 | 25 Sep, 2025

Kyoto - sightseeing visiting Fushimi Inari, Green tea Ceremony with Kimono Photo shoot [B/-/-]

Good morning! Enjoy your breakfast and get ready to meet your guide for a full day of exploring some of Kyoto's most iconic and beautiful sites. Kyoto, which served as Japan's capital from 794 to 1868, is often regarded as the cultural heart of the country. The city was spared from WWII bombings due to its priceless historical landmarks.

Begin your day early with a visit to the famous Fushimi Inari Shrine. Dedicated to Inari, the deity of rice, this shrine is famous for its stunning vermilion-colored path

lined with 10,000 torii gates. As you walk further up the winding trail, you'll be rewarded with breathtaking views of Kyoto. To fully experience the trail, it takes about three hours, but starting early will allow you to capture the best photos without the crowds.

Next, you'll have some free time for lunch (at your own expense). Following lunch, explore the Gion District, one of Kyoto's most famous neighborhoods. Stroll through charming streets lined with traditional wooden buildings and tea houses, and you might even catch a glimpse of a geisha or maiko on their way to a tea ceremony. You'll also have the opportunity to dress in a kimono and learn about the history and cultural significance of the tea ceremony. Take part in preparing your own matcha green tea and enjoy it with traditional sweets.

The rest of the day is free for you to explore at your leisure. For dinner, be sure to try a traditional Kyoto meal. The city is known for its culinary specialties, including tofu dishes, yudofu (hot pot), and kaiseki (a multi-course meal). Choose a local restaurant to sample these delicacies and experience the warm hospitality that Kyoto is famous for.

Overnight in Kyoto

DAY 8 | 26 Sep, 2025

Kyoto - Day free at leisure [B/-/-]

Enjoy a leisurely day to explore Kyoto's blend of tradition and natural beauty at your own pace. Visit Kiyomizu-dera, a stunning Buddhist temple offering panoramic views of the city, surrounded by lush woods—perfect for a peaceful walk. For history, explore Nijo Castle, a UNESCO World Heritage site famous for its beautiful gardens and "nightingale floors" that chirp when stepped on, once designed to ward off intruders.

For lunch, head to Nishiki Market for a taste of local specialties, from fresh seafood to Kyoto sweets like yatsushashi (cinnamon-flavored treats). If you're feeling adventurous, try *yuba* (tofu skin) or *kaiseki* (a multi-course meal).

In the afternoon, visit the Arashiyama Bamboo Grove, where you can walk through towering bamboo stalks, or relax by the Katsura River. Nearby, explore Tenryu-ji Temple, a Zen temple with beautiful gardens.

Overnight in Kyoto

DAY 9 | 27 Sep, 2025

Kyoto - Osaka [B/-/-]

Your journey continues today as you take the train to Osaka. Once settled at your hotel, go out and experience two of Osaka's most dynamic and delicious foodie neighborhoods. Osaka gives Tokyo a run for its money when it comes to delicious cuisine, and this evening you can experience its culinary delights on a three-hour street food tour. You'll sample the most unique dishes in Osaka, focusing on regional foods from Kansai. Try *takoyaki*, ball-shaped octopus bites, and *okonomiyaki*, a savory Japanese pancake with toppings. The tour includes two drinks, but feel free to get a few more rounds in afterward!

In one of the liveliest districts of Osaka, Dotonbori (pronounced Dotombori) is located on the Tombori River. Cap off your evening by heading to the Tazaemonbashi Bridge boat dock to enjoy a 20-minute cruise along the river. As you float along the waterway, learn about hidden highlights and the backstory to famous spots from your guide. While it's one of the more touristy things to do, it's also a great way to experience the neon city lights from a different angle. After the cruise, wander nearby to discover bars, restaurants, and clubs at every turn.

Overnight in Osaka

DAY 10 | 28 Sep,
2025

Osaka - Visit Universal Studios
[B/-/-]

Relax as you travel door-to-door by van or coach from your Osaka hotel to Universal Studios Japan, and enter the theme park without delay with your pre-purchased day ticket.
