DAY 1 | 30 Sep, 2025

Prepare yourself! You are leaving today for Paris to start your Paris explorer tour.

DAY 2 | 01 Oct, 2025

Paris Arrival [-/-/-]

Upon arrival in Paris, claim your bags and proceed towards the arrival hall. Our representative will meet you and assist you with your transfer to the hotel. (Standard check-in time is 3:00 pm)

Overnight in Paris

DAY 3 | 02 Oct, 2025

Paris - City Highlights tour including Lunch at Eiffel Tower [B/L/-]

After breakfast, your Paris sightseeing adventure begins with a hotel pick up. Accompanied by a private guide, your tour kicks off as you drive through Paris, soaking in the city's charm from the comfort of your ride. Your first stop is the Arc de Triomphe. Marvel at this grand monument that honors those who fought and died in France. Standing beneath its majestic arches, you'll learn about its historical significance and the detailed sculptures that adorn it. Continue to the Palais Garnier, Paris's opulent opera house. Admire its ornate façade and elaborate interiors, including the grand staircase, lavish chandeliers, and the stunning ceiling painted by Marc Chagall. Learn about its history and its role in Parisian cultural life. Drive through Place Vendôme, known for its elegant column and luxury boutiques. This square is a symbol of French grandeur, lined with high-end jewelry stores and historic hotels. Visit Place de la Concorde, one of Paris's largest public squares. Here, you'll see the impressive Egyptian obelisk and the beautiful fountains that mark this historical site, which played a significant role during the French Revolution. Stroll down the Champs-Élysées, Paris's most famous avenue, flanked by theaters, cafés, and shops. Enjoy the bustling atmosphere and the view of the Arc de Triomphe at the opposite end of

the avenue. Your tour continues with a visit to the Eiffel Tower. Ascend to the 2nd floor by elevator and take in panoramic views of Paris's skyline. At Madame Brasserie, located on the Eiffel Tower's first floor, indulge in a gourmet three-course lunch. Savor exquisite French cuisine while enjoying breathtaking views of the city's landmarks.

The journey continues with a visit to Paris's emblem, the Eiffel Tower. Take an elevator ride to the 2nd floor and enjoy stunning panoramic views of the city's skyline. Experience the enchantment and romance of Paris from this iconic vantage point. Next, enjoy a gourmet lunch at Madame Brasserie, located on the Eiffel Tower's first floor. Delight in a three-course meal while soaking up spectacular views of Parisian landmarks. This special experience is ideal for couples, friends, or families wanting to celebrate their time in France. After lunch, you'll be returned to your hotel.

The remainder of the day is yours to explore Paris at your own pace. Consider taking a leisurely stroll along the Seine River. As evening falls, the city takes on a golden hue, with the river reflecting the light. The riverside paths, flanked by notable sites like Notre-Dame and the Eiffel Tower, create a stunning setting for your walk.

Overnight in Paris

DAY 4 | 03 Oct, 2025

Paris - Day is free at leisure [B/-/-]

Begin your day with a leisurely breakfast at a Parisian café. Enjoy a buttery croissant, a pain au chocolat, or a traditional baguette with a café au lait or fresh orange juice. Find a charming café in neighborhoods like Le Marais, Saint-Germain-des-Prés, or the Latin Quarter. Choose a Parisian neighborhood to explore at your own pace. Each district has its own character: Wander through trendy boutiques, art galleries, and historical sites like the Place des Vosges. Stroll through this bohemian district, visit the Basilica of Sacré-Cœur, and explore the artists' square, Place du Tertre. Discover elegant shops, historic cafés like Café de Flore, and the beautiful Luxembourg Gardens. Spend some time

shopping or window-shopping along the famous boulevards like the Champs-Élysées or Rue de Rivoli. Explore charming boutiques, luxury stores, or specialty shops.

Overnight in Paris

DAY 5 | 04 Oct, 2025

Paris - Black Paris tour  
Including Lunch [B/L/-]

Enjoy your morning meal, then at approximately 9:30 AM, your day in Paris steeped in Black history begins with a pickup from your hotel. We'll board a bus and start our exploration at the Arc de Triomphe, where your guide reveals the stories of African Americans arriving in Paris during the 1800s. Discover the notable history of Black soldiers in World Wars I and II, and visit the Champs Elysees Mansion, where Thomas Jefferson and Sally Hemings began their 38-year relationship in 1787.

A brief bus ride takes us to the stunning Parc Monceau, retracing the steps of Frederick Douglass, Dr. W.E.B. Dubois, Henry O. Tanner, and other prominent figures. We'll stand before a monument commemorating France's abolition of the African slave trade, honoring Napoleon's famous Black general and his son, Alexandre Dumas, a renowned French writer. Learn about Toussaint L'Ouverture and Haiti's historic revolt, passing by author Dumas' former residence and the church dedicated to African Saint Augustine, a Catholic Church founder.

Witness Josephine Baker's church funeral at Place de la Madeleine and pause at Place Concorde, once home to the guillotine during the French Revolution, now housing the US Embassy. Explore the African Obelisk, the oldest Parisian monument brought from Luxor in 1831, an astronomical device used at the Temple of Thebes.

Our next stop, the Olympia Concert Hall, hosted legendary African American musicians like Louis Armstrong, Nina Simone, and Ray Charles. Continue to the Opera Garnier, where celebrated Black operatic talents graced the stage.

We'll visit "Little Africa" at Chateau Rouge, experiencing its vibrant outdoor market. Drive through historic Montmartre, once dubbed "The Harlem of Paris," then explore lesser-known corners in the Latin

Quarter, Montparnasse, Lower Montmartre, and the Champs Elysées, recalling James Baldwin, Richard Wright, and Diaspora intellectuals.

Relish lunch at La Creole, followed by a visit to the Church of the Black Madonna, housing the Notre Dame de Bonne Délivrance, a significant Black Madonna statue from the 14th century.

Stop for a group photo at Place Josephine Baker in the 14th Arrt before your return to the hotel around 5:30 PM. Spend your evening exploring Paris's charming boulevards and lanes, savoring a café au lait while immersing yourself in the city's sophisticated ambiance.

Spend the evening getting to know your surrounds. Wander through the leafy boulevards and winding lanes of the French capital, stopping for a leisurely café au lait while watching sophisticated Parisians go by.

**Add-on - Moulin Rouge Show with Transfers - USD 390 Per person (minimum 15 Pax)**

Feast your senses on the vibrant color and charisma of the 'Féerie' show at Paris' iconic Moulin Rouge during an extravagant evening in the City of Light. Take a seat in the atmospheric theater and prepare for a dazzling spectacle of drama, dance and music. See elaborately dressed show girls dominate the stage; marvel at dancers as they perform compelling choreography; and opt to upgrade to include a French feast and fine Champagne before the show starts.

Overnight in Paris

DAY 6 | 05 Oct, 2025

Paris - Day trip to Versailles  
and evening Seine Dinner  
Cruise [B/-/D]

Travel from Paris on this half-day trip to Versailles. Save time with skip-the-line tickets, a convenient return transfer, and an engaging tour of Versailles Palace and its historic rooms and chambers. Upon arrival, access the palace through a separate entrance. Then, discover the opulence, beauty, and history of the palace on an interactive guided tour. During the 90-minute tour, see the State Apartments, the King's Bedroom, and the emblematic Hall of Mirrors. Learn about the main figures of the French monarchy, from King Louis XIV to Marie Antoinette. Hear about the many fascinating historical events that took place in

the palace's rooms. After your tour of the palace, take some free time to stroll around the beautiful French Gardens. Enjoy a guided tour of the gardens Finally, hop back on the bus for your journey back to your hotel

Evening get ready to enjoy dinner on-board whilst cruising on the River Seine. Discover Paris, the City of Lights, from the water and see the iconic monuments of Paris illuminated. Climb aboard a panoramic sightseeing boat for a dinner cruise along the River Seine in central Paris. Enjoy an à-la-carte 3-course meal as you take in views of the "City of Lights" at night. Dine in a glassed-in boat and admire the historic quays and iconic monuments that pass by. See the golden dome of Les Invalides, the French Parliament, the former Beaux-Arts railway station of the Musée d'Orsay, and the gothic façade of Notre Dame Cathedral. Compliment your cruise with a 3-course meal complete with optional extras, including Champagne, more aperitifs, and priority seating. Dock back at your starting point with your eyes full of wonder and your belly full of delicious food and drinks.

DAY 7 | 06 Oct, 2025

Paris - Visit Louvre [B/-/-]

Morning meet your guide and visit the Louvre Museum.

This iconic masterpiece offers unique insights into each work. Delve into the former residence of the Kings of France, now one of the world's oldest and most visited museums, showcasing art from ancient civilizations to the mid-19th century. Follow a curated route through the Louvre's highlights. Experience close encounters with renowned sculptures like the Venus de Milo and The Winged Victory of Samothrace, an iconic Hellenistic statue representing Nike, the Greek goddess of victory. Marvel at the Mona Lisa, the world's most famous Renaissance portrait, whose 1911 theft contributed to its legendary status. Explore both celebrated and lesser-known artworks deserving of admiration. Discover treasures from the Renaissance, ancient Greece, and paintings spanning the 13th to 19th centuries, along with prints from the Royal Collection. Delve into the Louvre Palace's basement to see the foundations of its medieval origins and uncover its rich history. Post tour return back to the hotel and relax
