## DAY 1 | 08 May, 2026

### Nairobi Arrival [-/-]

## DAY 2 | 09 May, 2026

### Nairobi Sightseeing [B/-]

After breakfast, your guide will meet you at the hotel for a full-day Nairobi sightseeing tour.

The tour will begin with a panoramic view of the **modern city center**, showcasing Nairobi's skyline and vibrant urban atmosphere. You will drive past the **Parliament Buildings**, a symbol of Kenya's political history, followed by a visit to the **Nairobi Snake Park**, which houses various reptiles and amphibians native to East Africa.

Afterward, you will visit the historic **Karen Blixen Museum**, the former home of the Danish author of Out

of Africa. You'll explore the beautifully preserved house, gardens, and enjoy stunning views of the **Ngong Hills**, just as Karen Blixen did during her time in Kenya.

The tour will also include a stop at **Kazuri Beads**, a local workshop where African women handcraft exquisite ceramic jewelry and pottery. Here, you can witness the artistry involved in bead-making and purchase unique souvenirs.

After an enriching day, you will be transferred back to your hotel. The evening is at your leisure to relax or explore more of Nairobi's vibrant dining scene.

## DAY 3 | 10 May, 2026

### Nairobi - Masai Mara [B/L/D]

After an early breakfast, you will depart Nairobi and embark on a scenic drive towards the world-renowned **Masai Mara National Reserve**. The journey takes approximately **5-6 hours**, passing through the Great Rift Valley with breathtaking views along the way. A brief stop at a scenic viewpoint will allow you to capture panoramic photos of the escarpment.

Upon arrival at Masai Mara, you will check into your safari lodge or tented camp. After lunch and some rest, you will embark on an **afternoon game drive**, where you will have your first opportunity to spot the Big Five—lion, elephant, buffalo, leopard, and rhino—along with numerous other wildlife species.

Return to your lodge for dinner, followed by an evening around the campfire, where you can exchange stories and learn about Masai culture.

## DAY 4 | 11 May, 2026

### Masai Mara - Game drive [B/L/D]

Rise early for a **sunrise game drive**, the best time to witness wildlife activity as predators return from their hunts and herbivores begin their day. The Mara is especially known for its **abundant wildlife, rolling savannahs, and seasonal Great Migration**.

After breakfast in the wild or back at the lodge, you will continue with more game viewing, exploring different areas of the reserve. Lunch will either be a picnic in the bush or at the lodge, depending on the day's schedule.

In the afternoon, you can opt for a **cultural visit to a Masai village**, where you'll gain insight into the traditional lifestyle, customs, and dances of the Masai people.

As the sun sets, another game drive offers the chance to spot elusive nocturnal animals before returning to the lodge for dinner.

The tour begins with a scenic ferry ride from the V&A Waterfront, followed by a guided visit led by a former inmate. Walk through the historic prison, including Mandela's cell, and learn about the harsh realities of apartheid and the enduring fight for freedom. The full experience lasts about 3.5 hours and offers deep insight into South Africa's past.

DAY 8 | 15 May, 2026

Cape Town - Winelands tour  
[B/L/-]

After breakfast, begin your journey with a **scenic tour of the Cape Winelands**, where picturesque vineyards and historic estates await. While the region is famed for its crisp white wines, elegant French-style reds, and artisanal cheeses and olives, its true charm lies in the breathtaking landscapes—**rolling hills, oak-lined avenues, and majestic mountains overlooking fertile valleys**. Enjoy a **delicious lunch** along the way, showcasing the rich culinary traditions of the region.

DAY 9 | 16 May, 2026

Cape Town - Full day Peninsula  
Tour [B/-/-]

After breakfast, meet your guide and embark on an unforgettable journey along the Cape Peninsula, where dramatic scenery meets deep cultural roots. Start with a scenic drive along the Atlantic Seaboard, passing coastal gems like Clifton and Camps Bay, and take in views of the Twelve Apostles mountain range. Continue to the legendary Cape Point, where the Indian and Atlantic Oceans are believed to meet.

Ride the famous cableway up Table Mountain, one of the New7Wonders of Nature and a top tourist attraction with breathtaking views, walking trails, and a restaurant at the summit. Since opening in 1929, over 22 million visitors have made the ascent.

Don't miss Chapman's Peak Drive—affectionately called “Chappies”—a 9km stretch of road with 114 curves hugging the cliffs between Hout Bay and Noordhoek. Built during WWI, this route offers jaw-dropping ocean views and passes through the historical “Cape of Storms,” once praised by Sir Francis Drake as the “Fairest Cape in all the World.”

Cape Point itself is rich in biodiversity and heritage. Spot wildlife like eland, bontebok, zebra, and red hartebeest in the fenced nature reserve. Visit the Buffelsfontein Visitor Centre for seasonal wildlife insights. For panoramic views, head to the old lighthouse via the Flying Dutchman Funicular—the only one of its kind in Africa—saving the uphill walk.

End your trip in Simon's Town at Boulders Bay, home to a colony of African penguins that settled there in 1982. This charming beachside spot has become one of the region's most beloved attractions.

Evening, take a stroll around the harbor and enjoy the views of Table Mountain and the ocean
