DAY 4 | 22 Feb, 2027

Melbourne - City Sightseeing tour with Yarra River Cruise with Lunch [B/L/-]

Our Melbourne sightseeing experience begins at Fitzroy Gardens, a beautifully landscaped 26-hectare park showcasing classic Victorian-era design, located just beyond the city center. A key attraction within the gardens is Cook's Cottage, originally constructed in 1755 in Yorkshire, England, by the parents of renowned explorer Captain James Cook.

We then pass by Rod Laver Arena, part of Melbourne's famous sporting and entertainment precinct. This premier venue hosts international sporting events, concerts, and cultural shows year-round.

The journey continues to the Royal Exhibition Building, one of the city's most significant landmarks. A UNESCO World Heritage Site, this impressive structure is celebrated for its grand architecture and tranquil setting within the Carlton Gardens, making it a highlight of any Melbourne city tour.

Walking along the stately Spring Street, we admire several historic icons, including Parliament House, the

refined Treasury Building, and the much-loved Princess Theatre. From there, we drive along Collins Street's celebrated "Paris End," known for its luxury boutiques and elegant European-inspired streetscape.

We then pass Federation Square, a lively cultural precinct and one of Melbourne's most visited attractions. Located opposite Flinders Street Station, this area marks the birthplace of the city.

Our next stop is the Shrine of Remembrance, where sweeping panoramic views over the Royal Botanic Gardens and Melbourne's skyline provide an ideal setting for reflection and photography.

The tour continues to St Patrick's Cathedral, a magnificent example of Gothic Revival architecture and an enduring symbol of Melbourne's religious and cultural history. Built between 1858 and 1897 and designed by acclaimed architect William Wardell, the cathedral is renowned for its soaring spires, detailed stone carvings, and exquisite stained-glass windows inspired by medieval European churches. Its impressive façade, adorned with sculptures depicting biblical stories and saints, creates a powerful and inspiring presence.

Next, enjoy a Spirit of Melbourne lunch cruise on the Yarra River. Dine in comfort and style as you savor expertly prepared dishes made from locally sourced ingredients. Panoramic windows offer uninterrupted views of Melbourne's iconic riverside landmarks, with the constantly changing scenery providing a beautiful backdrop to your dining experience.

The remainder of the day is yours to enjoy at leisure.

Overnight in Melbourne

DAY 5 | 23 Feb, 2027

Melbourne - Day free at leisure [B/-/]

Enjoy a day at your own pace in Melbourne, with the freedom to explore this vibrant city however you choose. Whether you prefer to wander through its eclectic laneways filled with street art and boutique shops, relax in one of its many charming cafes, or visit world-class attractions like the Melbourne Museum or

the National Gallery of Victoria, the day is yours to design. You might opt to take a stroll through the lush Royal Botanic Gardens, browse the bustling Queen Victoria Market, or even venture a bit further afield to explore nearby beaches or wineries. However you decide to spend your time, today offers the perfect opportunity to experience Melbourne in your own unique way.

Add-on : Phillip Island tour - USD 280 Per person [Minimum 10 travelers]

We'll begin our day in Melbourne and travel along the coastline to our first stop, Moonlit Sanctuary Wildlife Conservation Park. Here, your guide will take you through the award-winning park, home to many iconic Australian animals, such as kangaroos, wombats, and Tasmanian devils, as well as lesser-known species like the spot-tailed quoll, the yellow-bellied glider, and the long-nosed potoroo. You'll enjoy a ranger presentation on koalas, learn more about this much-loved marsupial, see native birds and reptiles, hand-feed kangaroos and wallabies, or even have the chance to take a photo with a koala (at your own expense).

We'll then continue to Phillip Island, stopping first at Cape Woolamai Beach. Take a walk along the sand, feel the sea breeze, and watch surfers riding the waves. Our next destination is the Nobbies, where you can explore the coastal boardwalks and take in the dramatic rocky coastline. Look out toward Seal Rocks to spot fur seals and watch the blowhole send seawater spraying into the air. During winter, whales are sometimes visible offshore, while in summer, you may catch a glimpse of penguin chicks resting in their burrows as they wait for their parents to return.

As evening approaches, we'll head to Summerland Beach for the highlight of the day. After sunset, the little penguins will begin emerging from the ocean in small groups, crossing the beach and waddling back to their nests. Walk along the boardwalks beside these charming birds as they return home after a day of fishing. At the end of the experience, we'll regroup at the bus and travel back to Melbourne.

After we depart the city, we'll head straight for the eastern end of the Great Ocean Road to begin our journey along this spectacular coastal drive. We'll stop for some morning tea where you can relax and enjoy the scenery, before we head off to the Memorial Arch. Here, you can snap some photos at one of the route's most iconic landmarks. Lunch is in the beachside town of Apollo Bay, where you can tuck into local fare and refuel for an afternoon of incredible sightseeing. Afterwards, we'll enjoy a 20-minute guided bush walk to the Cascades of Melba Gully. When all have returned, we then head on to the 12 Apostles, one of Australia's most famous landmarks. These limestone stacks form an incredible backdrop to the sea views, so be sure to bring your camera along. Afterwards, we'll move on to Loch Ard Gorge, which is shrouded by impressive limestone cliffs. We'll take a walk here and check out the local attractions, including the Archway, the Razorback, and Dumpling Pots. You'll also get to learn about Australia's most famous shipwreck while you're here. Finally, we'll make our way back to Melbourne via the road inland, travelling through several country towns along the way. Please note: during peak periods, this tour may operate in reverse. Keep in mind that this popular area is large, and therefore the tour involves a significant amount of driving. This is just because we really want to show you the best bits of the beautiful Great Ocean Road! We have packed the day with lots of amazing stops, which means it's going to be a long, but awesome day

Please note: *During busy times, this tour may run in*

reverse order.

And just a heads up—this is a full day with a lot of ground to cover, but that's because we want to make sure you experience all the highlights of the stunning Great Ocean Road. It's going to be a big day, but one packed with unforgettable sights and experiences!

Overnight in Melbourne

DAY 6 | 24 Feb, 2027 Melbourne - Cairns [B/-/-]

After breakfast, you will be transferred to Melbourne airport for your flight to Cairns. Upon arrival in Cairns, you will be transferred to your hotel (Standard check-in time is 3:00 pm).

Your rest of the day in Cairns is free for you to enjoy at your own pace, offering the perfect chance to explore this laid-back tropical city. You might choose to take a leisurely stroll along the scenic Esplanade, where you can enjoy views of the waterfront, public art installations, and perhaps even catch some live entertainment. If you're in the mood for dining, Cairns offers a variety of restaurants and bars serving everything from fresh seafood to international cuisine. You could also browse the Night Markets for souvenirs, local crafts, or a quick bite to eat. Whether you prefer a quiet evening by the lagoon or a lively night out in the town, Cairns has something for every mood.

DAY 7 | 25 Feb, 2027 Cairns - Kuranda Skyrail & Scenic Rail Experience [B/-/-]

Following pick up from your hotel in central Cairns, you'll be gliding over the UNESCO World Heritage-listed tree canopy on the 7.5-kilometre Skyrail Rainforest Cableway. From its two intermediate stations, there's the opportunity to head onto the boardwalks of the forest floor and take in another glimpse of Barron Falls from the glass floor of The Edge Lookout. You will then be escorted by your driver and guide to Freshwater Station, where the vintage train carriages of the Kuranda Scenic Railway await. Heading north, you'll parallel the route of the Barron River northward, with every minute of the two-hour journey offering something new. Protected by Barron Gorge National Park, you'll pass several stunning cascades along the way. After a stop to absorb the full magnificence of Barron Falls, you'll arrive in Kuranda. First settled by Europeans in 1885, Kuranda has a series of fascinating

relics from the making of modern Australia. These include the tiny St Saviour's Church and the wreck of a Japanese bomber which crashed during the Second World War. Both are well worth seeking out, having explored the stalls of the daily heritage market. Approximately 3.5 hours of free time in this town of 3,000 also gives you the chance to visit the lovable inhabitants of Kuranda Koala Gardens, the Australian Butterfly Sanctuary, or Birdworld. After taking in amazing scenery from an array of different viewpoints, you will head back to Cairns to conclude your day.

DAY 8 | 26 Feb, 2027 Cairns - Day free at leisure [B/-/-]

Whether you're in the mood for some relaxation or ready for a bit of adventure, it's your time to enjoy. You might want to stroll along the Esplanade, stop by the lagoon, check out the lively cafés, or simply kick back and observe the local wildlife. If shopping's your thing, Cairns has some charming boutique shops and local markets to browse. Or, if you're feeling adventurous, head out and explore the nearby rainforest or beaches. Cairns offers the perfect balance of chill vibes and exciting activities to make your day unforgettable.

Embark on an eco-adventure to Green Island from Cairns and discover the natural beauty of the Great Barrier Reef with a unique Seawalker Helmet Dive experience. Guests enjoy a brief three-minute boat transfer to Seawalker's support vessel, anchored in the

calm, shallow reef waters just offshore from Green Island. Unlike traditional diving, Seawalker allows you to walk along the ocean floor around a carefully chosen coral formation known as a “bombie,” located approximately 520 metres from the beach. You’ll descend to a depth of around five metres (16 feet) for an unforgettable underwater walk.

Immerse yourself in the island’s tropical environment, home to more than 120 native plant species, vibrant coral gardens, diverse birdlife, and abundant marine creatures. Visitors can choose between a glass-bottom boat coral viewing tour or snorkeling equipment, allowing you to explore the reef directly from the island’s pristine white-sand beaches.

Spend time discovering Green Island at your own pace—wander through the lush rainforest on a self-guided walk, enjoy coral viewing from the glass-bottom boat, snorkel in the clear waters, or cool off with a swim in the island’s freshwater pool.

Green Island also offers excellent day-visitor facilities, including a pool bar, dive shop, and a variety of restaurants and food outlets where you can purchase tasty lunches, snacks, and refreshing beverages.

DAY 10 | 28 Feb,

Of course, a visit to Sydney wouldn't be complete without some time at the world-famous Bondi Beach. Watch surfers ride the waves, feel the sand beneath your feet, or unwind with a cup of tea at a cozy beachside café.

To wrap up the experience, we'll board a cruise for a scenic lunch on the harbour. As you enjoy a spread of local delicacies—featuring fine meats, cheeses, fresh fruits, and artisan breads—you'll sail past some of Sydney's most captivating sights, offering a relaxing and delicious end to the day.

While in the area, you'll enjoy access to all three of Scenic World's top attractions: ride the Scenic Cableway—the highest cable car in the country—the Scenic Skyway, and the Scenic Railway, known as the steepest passenger railway in the world. Our final stop will be at Sydney Olympic Park Wharf, where the day's tour comes to an end. Rather than navigating through city traffic, you'll have the option to board a ferry back to Sydney Harbour (at your own expense). As the sun dips below the horizon, witness the harbour transition from golden hues to evening glow, with iconic sights such as the Sydney Harbour Bridge, the

Opera House, and the Royal Botanic Gardens beautifully illuminated against the night sky.

Savour a freshly prepared buffet dinner offering a wide variety of hot and cold dishes. This enjoyable dining experience provides a fun and relaxed way to admire Sydney's most famous landmarks, along with plenty of opportunities to capture stunning nighttime photographs.
