DAY 1 | 09 Jun, 2026

Depart Birmingham [-/-/-]

Prepare yourself! You are leaving today for Athens to start your magical journey to Greece

DAY 2 | 10 Jun, 2026

Athens - Arrival [-/-/-]

Upon arrival in Athens, claim your bags and proceed toward the arrival hall. Our representative will meet you and assist you with your transfer to the hotel. (Standard check-in time is 3:00 pm). Our local representative will assist you with a smooth check-in.

Check in at the hotel and catch up on your rest. You can unwind or tour the city throughout the remaining part of the day.

Overnight in Athens

DAY 3 | 11 Jun, 2026

Athens Sightseeing [B/L/-]

Today, after the luscious breakfast at the hotel,, meet your guide and start with a brief stop at the Panathenaic Stadium, where the inaugural Olympic Games were held in 1896. This stadium stands out as the only one constructed entirely from white marble. Continue your journey by passing landmarks such as the Zappeion and the Temple of Olympian Zeus. You will also see the Athens Trilogy, comprised of the University of Athens, the Academy of Athens, and the National Library.

Continue your exploration through the National Garden, Hadrian's Arch, St. Paul's Church, Parliament, the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, Schliemann's House (Numismatic Museum), the Catholic Cathedral, the Old Parliament, Constitution Square, the Russian Orthodox Church, and finally, arrive at the ACROPOLIS. Explore its entrance, the Propylaea gateway, the Temple of Athena Nike, the Parthenon, and the Erechtheion with its iconic Porch of Maidens. Ascend to this UNESCO-listed ancient citadel and learn about how its structures reflected Athens' prosperity during the 5th century BC.

Continue to Acropolis museum where, you will be captivated by main attractions such as votives,

everyday artifacts, statues from the archaic period, Caryatids, and the impressive Parthenon hall featuring metopes, pediments, and the frieze.

Enjoy your lunch at a local restaurant. Post lunch you will be dropped off at the hotel.

The rest of the day is free for leisure, immerse yourself in the city's vibrant atmosphere. Take a leisurely walk through the charming neighborhood of Plaka, known as the "Neighborhood of the Gods." Explore its narrow streets lined with neoclassical houses, browse through souvenir shops, and stop by cozy cafes and tavernas for a drink or traditional Greek meal.

DAY 4 | 12 Jun, 2026

Athens - Day free at leisure [B/-/-]

Enjoy a full day at leisure in Athens, allowing you the freedom to explore this captivating city at your own pace. Whether you choose to delve deeper into the city's ancient heritage by visiting world-renowned landmarks such as the Temple of Olympian Zeus, or the Ancient Agora, or prefer to immerse yourself in local culture with a stroll through the charming neighborhoods of Plaka and Monastiraki, the day is yours to design. You might indulge in some retail therapy along Ermou Street or unwind at a traditional café while sampling local delicacies like souvlaki and baklava. Alternatively, simply relax and soak up the vibrant atmosphere of the city, perhaps booking one of our suggested add-ons -

Add-on: - Day trip to Delphi : USD 175 Per person (minimum 15 travelers)

Your journey begins early in the morning, with a comfortable coach collecting you at the designated time for a scenic drive to this iconic archaeological treasure, recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. As you pass through Thebes and approach the slopes of Mount Parnassus near the picturesque town of Arachova, the scenery shifts dramatically—from dry and rugged terrain to lush, breathtaking landscapes. Beneath the towering cliffs known as the Fedriades and atop a commanding plateau lies Delphi, a sacred sanctuary established in honor of Apollo, the god of

music, harmony, and protector of divine law. In ancient times, Delphi was believed to be the very center of the world—the mythical “navel” of the Earth. The oracle of Delphi, represented by the high priestess Pythia, held immense sway across the ancient world. Her cryptic prophecies, believed to be inspired directly by Apollo, were interpreted by temple priests and often shaped the destiny of individuals and even entire city-states. As you make your way along the Sacred Way leading to the Temple of Apollo, you’ll encounter significant monuments such as the Treasury of the Athenians, built in gratitude to Apollo following their triumph at the Battle of Marathon. These treasuries, often constructed in the form of miniature temples, housed countless offerings from Greek and foreign city-states. The tour continues with a visit to the Delphi Archaeological Museum, regarded as one of Greece’s most significant museums. Here, you can marvel at artifacts like the “Omphalos” stone, symbolizing the center of the world, reliefs depicting the labors of Hercules, and the stunning bronze Charioteer of Delphi—an enduring example of classical Greek artistry. Before concluding your visit, you may also explore the nearby sanctuary of Athena Pronaia, situated about half a mile from the main site and offering yet another glimpse into the spiritual life of ancient Delphi. The tour concludes with a return to Athens in the late afternoon, leaving you with lasting impressions of one of the most mystical and culturally rich destinations of ancient Greece.

Add-on: -Dinner show in Plaka including transfers (minimum 6 travelers)

Discover the vibrant spirit of Athens by night with an unforgettable evening of traditional Greek music, dance, and delicious cuisine in the charming Plaka district. Your night begins at 8:00 PM with a classic Greek dinner featuring a selection of hot and cold starters, a fresh Greek salad, and a main course offering various meat options, with vegetarian dishes also available. Dessert includes choices like ice cream or seasonal fruit, accompanied by your choice of local wine, beer, or a soft drink.

As the evening unfolds, live music fills the air, setting the stage for a lively performance of traditional Greek dances that continues until around midnight. Guests are encouraged to join in the fun and dance along. It’s a perfect way to immerse yourself in Greek culture and

enjoy an authentic Athenian night out in one of the city's most historic neighborhoods.

DAY 5 | 13 Jun, 2026
