ITINERARY

DAY 1 | 16 Sep, 2025

Depart New York or Atlanta [-/-/-]

Prepare yourself! You are leaving today for Madrid to start your unbelievable Best of Spain Journey.

DAY 2 | 17 Sep, 2025

Barcelona Arrival [-/-/-]

Upon arrival in Barcelona, claim your bags and proceed toward the arrival hall. Our representative will meet you and assist you with your transfer to the hotel. (Standard check-in time is 3:00 pm).

Check in at the hotel and catch up on your rest. You can unwind or tour the city throughout the remaining part of the day.

Overnight in Madrid

DAY 3 | 18 Sep, 2025

Barcelona Sightseeing with Montserrat [B/-/-]

Enjoy your breakfast. Meet your guide and proceed to explore Barcelona. For the first part of the activity, enjoy a walking tour of the **Born neighborhood** and the **Gothic Quarter**. Stroll down one of the most important streets in the city until you reach the Cathedral of Barcelona. Walk the narrow streets of the oldest part of the city and discover the many secrets it holds. Marvel at the quaint medieval places hidden to the crowds and learn about their huge historical significance. Follow your guide through the streets of Born neighborhood and the Gothic Quarter and discover places such as Plaça Sant Felip Neri, Arc de Triomf and Plaça Sant Jaume.

Board an air-conditioned coach for a panoramic tour through the city. We will head towards the **Mountain of Montjuic**, main scenery of the Olympic Games in 1992. Ride the cable car for amazing views over the city. At the end of the tour, you will stop in the MNAC viewpoint to see one of the most beautiful panoramic views of the city. During the way back to the office, the bus will drive through Passeig de Gràcia and you will see some of the most emblematic Gaudi buildings such as Casa Batlló and la Pedrera. Check in back again at

our office in Estació del Nord before the starting time of the afternoon activity. Meet your guide and come aboard an air-conditioned coach to Montserrat. After a 1h drive on the highway, board the cogwheel train up the mountain and enjoy the amazing views. Admire the Mountain's peculiar morphology, which comes from the Catalan words **Mont** (mountain) and **Serrat** (serrated). World-famous for its rocky geography, Montserrat beautiful scenery was declared National Park in 1987 to protect its natural and cultural wealth. Follow your local guide through the site and learn about the history and architectural style of the Monastery. A community of 80 monks currently lives and follow the rule of Saint Benedict in Montserrat. Fall in love with the Gothic and Renaissance details of the basilica and sanctuary. Learn about the legend of the miraculous apparition of the Madonna and Child in the cave of Santa Cova. To this day, their woodcarving is kept in the Church of the monastery, which you will be able to visit. The figure is popularly known as **La Moreneta** (The Black Madonna) as a result of a varnish reaction. Besides the main area, there are a great number of small churches and trails you can follow. You will be given free time to taste the finest liquors, shop for locally produced treats or visit the audio-visual exhibition once our guided tour finishes.

Your day will conclude with drop-off at your hotel.

DAY 4 | 19 Sep, 2025

Barcelona - Day is free at leisure [B/-/-]

You have the whole day to explore Barcelona at your own pace and according to your preferences. This is a great opportunity to discover the city independently. Take a leisurely walk through the Gothic Quarter or visit Park Güell. Indulge in a tasty lunch at a local tapas bar, sampling favorites like patatas bravas, jamón ibérico, and churros. Explore upscale shops and admire the impressive architecture, including Gaudí's Casa Batlló and Casa Milà.

Add-on - Sagrada Familia Tour with Skip-the-line

Ready to explore Spain's most iconic landmark alongside an expert guide? Join us on a guided tour of the Sagrada Família benefiting from skip-the-line access and begin your tour of Antoni Gaudí's most famous work. Learn about the history of this magnificent structure that to this day is under construction, and admire the two contrasting facades of its exterior: the Facade of the Nativity, and the Facade of Passion. Learn about the intricate details of the building and about the life of Gaudí. If you're impressed by the exterior of the Sagrada Família, be ready for a whole new perspective upon entry. Watch a rainbow of colours wash over you as you set foot into this breath-taking monument. Following your guided tour, you'll have the chance to descend below the basilica where you can visit the Sagrada Família Museum and discover the ins and out of this impressive monument.

Add-on - Flamenco Show with Dinner - USD 275 Per person (minimum 6 pax)

A classic tablao, the Tablao de Carmen offers an exceptional experience by showcasing top artists in a unique venue designed like an Andalusian amphitheater. This setup fosters a close connection between performers and the audience, allowing you to enjoy dinner and drinks while immersed in the show. The ambiance and flamenco performances transport viewers through time and space. Located in Poble Espanyol, an open-air museum that highlights the best of Spain's architecture, crafts, contemporary art, and traditions, combining a visit to Poble Espanyol with an evening of dinner and flamenco at the Tablao de Carmen guarantees an authentic experience for any visitor!

Overnight in Barcelona

DAY 5 | 20 Sep, 2025 Barcelona - Mallorca [B/-/-]

Today after breakfast, say good bye to Barcelona and proceed to Barcelona airport and jet off to the crown jewel of the country's Balearic Islands, Mallorca. Upon arrival, our representative will take you to your accommodation on the largest of the Balearic Islands. This island boasts some of Europe's finest beaches and stunning coves with turquoise waters, drawing

Next, cross the valley of Lluc by bus to reach the spectacular Sa Calobra Beach and the Torrent of Pareis. Enjoy some free time to find something to eat (not included) or sunbathe on the beach. Then, board a boat and cruise to Soller Harbor. If the weather is bad, ride a bus through Puig Major. In Soller Port, board a vintage tram to ride to Soller, where you'll board a vintage train. Sit back and relax as you ride across the island to return to Palma.

Overnight in Mallorca

DAY 7 | 22 Sep, 2025

Mallorca - Evening Tapas and Wine tour [B/-/-]

Take a relaxed morning in Mallorca to discover the island at your own pace. Spend some time basking in the sun at one of Mallorca's lovely beaches, like Playa de Alcúdia or Cala Millor. Explore Palma by visiting the impressive Palma Cathedral (La Seu) and wandering through the delightful streets of the Old Town, which are lined with shops and cafes.

Evening get ready to Experience Palma's culinary delights on a guided tapas and wine tour. Enjoy gourmet tapas and local wines at your leisure. Begin your culinary adventure at your preferred time and head to the first location on your list of stops. This carefully curated tour takes you to five contemporary eateries in the city, all within comfortable walking distance of each other. Visit Fervor Tapas Bar, Bodega Mayor, Bocalto Palma, Manto Negro Tapas Bar, and Maura Cafe and Bar. Enjoy a tasting at each location, with two gourmet tapas options available to select

from. You'll also receive a drink with each tasting – your choice of local wine, sangria, beer, water, or a soft drink. Get the opportunity to discover some of Palma's highlights while you walk, passing by Plaça Major, Plaça de la Reina, and more as you make your way from one eatery to the next.

You might choose to relax at one of the beaches, such as Portals Nous, known for its fine golden sands, crystal-clear turquoise waters, and scenic views of a small island nearby. Spend your time soaking up the sun or get active by renting a pedal boat, kayak, jet ski, or windsurfing equipment. Alternatively, you could explore the Santa Catalina neighborhood in Palma de Mallorca, where you'll find vibrant market stalls, bohemian cafes, lively bars, and charming fishermen's houses adorned with blooming balconies.

Experience the allure of constant 21-degree Celsius temperatures, ensuring a

comfortable exploration year-round. From the caves head to Porto Cristo, a tranquil haven beckoning with its natural harbor, charming fishing village, and idyllic beaches kissed by the azure-green sea. Conclude your journey with a visit to the Majorca Pearls Factory Shop, where exquisite craftsmanship meets timeless elegance. Explore a treasure trove of fine pearls, meticulously crafted to perfection, and delve into the rich heritage of Mallorca's renowned pearl industry.
