You will also have the chance to explore a lowland rainforest area, famous as the habitat of the Gurney's Pitta bird, once thought extinct.

Next, visit the Emerald Lagoon, which involves a scenic 1,200-meter walk through the rainforest, providing opportunities to observe a variety of plant and animal species in their natural habitat.

Lunch will be served at a local restaurant, featuring authentic Thai cuisine.

In the afternoon, visit the Tiger Cave Temple (Wat Tham Sua), one of Krabi's most beautiful temples.

Surrounded by serene gardens, plants, and flowers, it offers a peaceful setting ideal for meditation. For those seeking adventure, a climb of 1,260 steps leads to a golden pagoda at the top of the mountain, rewarding visitors with panoramic views of Krabi town and Khao Kanab Nam—a truly unforgettable sight.

DAY 9 | 04 Mar, 2027

KRABI TO BANGKOK - CITY & TEMPLE TOUR [B/-/-]

After breakfast, check out of your hotel and enjoy a **private transfer to Krabi Airport** with an English-speaking guide for your flight to Bangkok.

Upon arrival in Bangkok, your English-speaking guide will escort you through the city's main streets to the vibrant **Chinatown** district, where your first stop is **Wat Traimit**, the Temple of the Golden Buddha. This historic temple is home to a **5-ton solid gold Buddha**, which remained hidden for centuries and carries a fascinating story of discovery.

Next, visit **Wat Pho**, the Temple of the Reclining Buddha, famous for its enormous **46-metre-long reclining statue**. At the statue's feet, admire a stunning engraving of **108 images** representing the key virtues and positive actions in Buddhism. Following this, explore the **Grand Palace**, a magnificent complex and former royal residence of Thai kings from the 18th to mid-20th century, renowned for its intricate design blending traditional Thai architecture with Renaissance influences. Within the palace grounds, visit **Wat Phra Kaew**, or the Temple of the Emerald Buddha, Thailand's most sacred temple. After the tour, return to your hotel for a well-deserved rest.

FULL-DAY MAEKLONG RAILWAY & DAMNOEN SADUAK FLOATING MARKET TOUR, EVENING CHAO PHRAYA RIVER DINNER CRUISE [B/L/D]

with an English-speaking guide. On the way, stop at **Mae Klong Market**, located about 120 km from Bangkok in Samut Songkhram. Also known as **Talad Rom Hub** or the "Umbrella Pull-Down Market," this unique market sits along active railway tracks. Several times a day, vendors quickly pull back their goods and umbrellas to allow a train to pass, then resume business immediately. The market offers fresh produce, seafood, snacks, and local products, creating a fascinating mix of daily life and a must-see tourist spectacle.

Next, continue to **Damnoen Saduak Floating Market** in Ratchaburi province. Here, take a ride in a long-tail boat through the canals to witness the floating market in action, where vendors sell their goods from boat to boat or boat to shore. You'll be amazed by the variety of local products and souvenirs available. After exploring the market, transfer to your hotel.

Enjoy **lunch at a local restaurant** and return to your hotel, leaving the afternoon free at leisure.

In the evening, head to **ICONSIAM**, Bangkok's stunning riverside shopping mall. From there, board a modern cruise ship for a **buffet dinner along the Chao Phraya River**.
