OVERVIEW

Continue by train to Florence, where a full-day excursion takes you through the Tuscan countryside to Siena and San Gimignano. From Florence, travel by high-speed train to Venice, arriving by private water taxi and enjoying an evening gondola ride through the historic canals. A free day allows for independent exploration of Venice before departure by private water taxi to the airport. Throughout the journey, private transfers, and licensed local guides ensure a seamless and comfortable travel experience.

DAY 1 | 09 Jul, 2027

DEPART FOR ITALY

Your Italian adventure starts today! Depart for Rome and get ready to discover the history, beauty and charm of Italy.

DAY 2 | 10 Jul, 2027

ROME - ARRIVAL [-/-/-]

Upon arrival at Rome Fiumicino Airport, proceed through immigration and collect your baggage. Our English-speaking local representative will be there to assist you with your transfer to the hotel. Please note that the standard hotel check-in time is 3:00 PM.

After checking in, take some time to relax and settle into your surroundings. The remainder of the day is at leisure, allowing you to ease into the atmosphere of Rome at your own pace. You may wish to take a leisurely stroll through the historic streets and charming piazzas near the hotel, enjoy an authentic espresso at a local café, or simply unwind after your journey.

This gentle introduction to the Eternal City offers the perfect opportunity to rest and recharge before beginning your sightseeing adventures in earnest the following day.

Overnight in Rome

DAY 3 | 11 Jul, 2027

ROME - THE VATICAN [B/-/-]

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before meeting your guide and setting out to discover the wonders of Vatican City.

Begin your visit at the Vatican Museums, exploring their magnificent collection of classical art and sculpture, including celebrated masterpieces such as the Laocoön and the Belvedere Torso. Continue through the Gallery of Tapestries and the Gallery of Maps, followed by the Raphael Rooms, where masterpieces including *The School of Athens* reflect the extraordinary achievements of the High Renaissance.

The tour then continues to the Sistine Chapel, renowned for Michelangelo's breathtaking ceiling frescoes, including the iconic *Creation of Adam*, as well

as his monumental *Last Judgment* on the altar wall.

From the Sistine Chapel, proceed to St. Peter's Basilica, the magnificent centerpiece of Vatican City and one of the world's most important churches. Inside, admire some of its most treasured works, including Michelangelo's *Pietà*, Bernini's magnificent bronze baldachin above the high altar, and the soaring dome, famously designed by Michelangelo.

With ample time dedicated to the Vatican throughout the day, there will also be an opportunity to appreciate the grandeur of St. Peter's Square and Bernini's elegant sweeping colonnades.

Return to the hotel afterward and enjoy a relaxed evening at leisure, with the perfect opportunity to experience Rome's renowned restaurants and traditional trattorias.

Overnight in Rome

DAY 4 | 12 Jul, 2027

ROME TO NAPLES [B/-/-]

Enjoy a delicious breakfast at the hotel before checking out and meeting your guide for a morning exploration of Ancient Rome.

Discover the city's most iconic archaeological landmarks from the outside, including the magnificent Colosseum, the Roman Forum, and Palatine Hill. As you walk through this remarkable open-air museum, your guide will bring ancient Rome to life, sharing fascinating stories of its history and legacy.

Admire the imposing arches of the Colosseum and the nearby Arch of Constantine while learning about the gladiatorial spectacles that once captivated crowds of thousands. Continue along the Via Sacra through the Roman Forum, once the political, religious, and commercial heart of the Roman Empire. From the scenic viewpoints of Palatine Hill, traditionally considered the birthplace of Rome and once home to the imperial palaces, enjoy sweeping views across the Forum and toward the Circus Maximus.

Following the tour, proceed to Rome Termini Station to board your train to Naples Central Station. The journey takes just over an hour, offering glimpses of the

picturesque Italian countryside along the way.

Upon arrival in Naples, meet your transfer and continue to your hotel in this vibrant city nestled along the Bay of Naples beneath the imposing presence of Mount Vesuvius. The remainder of the afternoon is at leisure, giving you time to relax, settle in, or begin exploring the lively neighbourhood surrounding your hotel.

Overnight in Naples

DAY 5 | 13 Jul, 2027

NAPLES, AT LEISURE [B/-/-]

Delight in a fresh breakfast buffet to start your day. A free day to relax in Naples or explore independently. Guests may wander the historic centre, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, with its baroque churches, bustling piazzas, and the famous Spaccanapoli street cutting straight through the old town, or stroll the bayfront promenade for views across to Mount Vesuvius and the islands of the Gulf of Naples. Naples is also known for its cuisine — this is the birthplace of pizza, and a relaxed lunch or dinner at a local pizzeria is a fitting way to spend part of the day.

Optional - Day trip to Amalfi Coast - USD 175 Per person (minimum 10 travelers)

Enjoy a full-day private excursion along the spectacular Amalfi Coast, travelling comfortably by private coach with your English-speaking local guide. As you journey along the dramatic coastal roads, admire breathtaking views of the Mediterranean, colourful hillside villages, and terraced landscapes that have made this region one of Italy's most celebrated destinations. Your guide will share fascinating insights into the history, culture, and traditions of the Amalfi Coast as you make your way to the charming town of Amalfi. Spend time exploring Amalfi at a leisurely pace, taking in its picturesque streets, historic architecture, and lively waterfront. Later, experience the beauty of the coastline from the water with a scenic boat ride from Amalfi to Maiori. Sit back and enjoy panoramic views of the rugged cliffs, hidden coves, and enchanting seaside villages as you cruise along this stunning stretch of coastline. Upon arrival in Maiori, continue with your planned arrangements, carrying with you wonderful memories of a day spent discovering the timeless beauty of the Amalfi Coast.

Overnight in Naples

DAY 6 | 14 Jul, 2027

NAPLES, AT LEISURE [B/-/-]

Indulge in a hearty breakfast spread before heading out. Another day of leisure to explore Naples at your own pace. With two consecutive free days, guests have the flexibility to revisit favourite spots from the day before, explore at a slower pace, or use the time to rest ahead of the excursions still to come. The hotel's central location makes it easy to reach the waterfront, local markets, and cafés on foot.

Optional - Day trip to Capri : USD 195 Per person (minimum 10 travelers)

Enjoy a full-day excursion to the enchanting islands of Capri and Anacapri, beginning with a convenient return transfer from your hotel in Sorrento to the harbour. From there, board the boat to Capri and enjoy a scenic journey across the sparkling waters of the Bay of Naples, with beautiful views of the Sorrento coastline and the island as you approach.

Upon arrival at Marina Grande, meet your full-day guide and begin your exploration of Capri. Travel by minibus to the picturesque hilltop village of Anacapri, where you can soak in the relaxed atmosphere, charming streets, and spectacular panoramic views across the Mediterranean. Continue your discovery of the island with your guide, who will share insights into Capri's history, culture, and natural beauty. After exploring Anacapri, return by minibus to Capri and make your way from Marina Grande to the famous Piazzetta, the lively heart of Capri, where you can enjoy some free time to browse the boutiques, admire the elegant surroundings, or simply relax at a café.

Later, return to Sorrento by boat, followed by your transfer back to the hotel.

*(Note - Please note that a visit to the **Blue Grotto** is **not included** in the tour package, as access is dependent on weather and sea conditions, which can be unpredictable. However, guests who wish to visit the famous sea cave may make the decision locally on the day, subject to operational conditions and availability, by paying the applicable additional fee directly.)*

DAY 7 | 15 Jul, 2027

NAPLES TO FLORENCE [B/-/-]

Appreciate a freshly prepared morning breakfast buffet. Later this morning you will be transferred to Naples train station for your train to Florence. A scenic journey north through the Italian countryside of around three hours. On arrival, in Florence, you will be transferred to your hotel. With the remainder of the day free to get settled and take a first look at the city — perhaps a walk towards the Duomo or along the banks of the River Arno before dinner.

Guests may also choose to browse Florence's leather workshops and boutiques, relax in the Boboli Gardens, or simply enjoy a coffee in one of the historic piazzas at their own pace.

Optional - Walking tour of Florence with Accademia Galleria - USD 85 Per person (minimum 10 travelers)

Enjoy a guided walking tour through the historic heart of Florence, discovering the city's magnificent Renaissance heritage and its iconic landmarks. Accompanied by your local guide, stroll through the atmospheric streets and elegant piazzas while learning about Florence's fascinating history, art, and architecture. The highlight of the tour is a visit to the Accademia Gallery, home to some of Italy's most celebrated works of art and renowned as the home of Michelangelo's magnificent *David*. Take time to admire this extraordinary masterpiece along with other important sculptures and artworks housed within the gallery, gaining insight into the artistic achievements of the Renaissance and Florence's enduring influence on the world of art. After the visit, continue exploring the surrounding historic centre on foot, taking in the timeless beauty and vibrant atmosphere of this remarkable Tuscan city.

Optional - Cooking class with lunch at a Tuscany farmhouse - USD 310 Per person (minimum 10 travelers)

Upon arrival, meet your hosts and immerse yourself in the traditions of authentic Tuscan cuisine through a hands-on cooking class. DAY 9 | 17 Jul, 2027

FLORENCE - DAY TRIP TO SIENA AND SAN GIMIGNANO [B/L/-]

Begin the day with a delightful breakfast before setting out on an unforgettable journey through the picturesque Tuscan countryside. Meet your guide and travel to the historic city of Siena, where a local licensed guide will accompany you on a private two-hour walking tour.

Wander through Siena's charming medieval streets and discover its remarkable Gothic architecture, including the striking striped marble façade of the city's cathedral. Continue to the magnificent Piazza del Campo, the iconic shell-shaped square that forms the heart of Siena and is famous for hosting the historic Palio horse race twice each year. Admire the elegant Torre del Mangia rising above the square while your guide introduces you to the fascinating traditions of Siena's seventeen historic *contrade* — neighbourhood districts whose centuries-old rivalries remain an important part of the city's identity and culture.

Continue into the surrounding Tuscan countryside and

visit a welcoming local farmhouse. Here, enjoy a **tasting of regional wines** accompanied by a selection of authentic Tuscan specialties, including locally produced cheeses, cured meats, and fragrant olive oil. Relax over **lunch** while taking in the peaceful scenery of rolling hills, vineyards, and picturesque landscapes characteristic of the Chianti region.

The afternoon continues with a private two-hour walking tour of San Gimignano, the enchanting walled hill town often referred to as the “Medieval Manhattan.” Its distinctive skyline is defined by a collection of imposing medieval towers, originally built by rival noble families as symbols of wealth and power. With your local licensed guide, explore the town’s atmospheric narrow lanes, charming piazzas, and historic streets while learning about its fascinating medieval heritage. Along the way, enjoy beautiful views stretching across the surrounding Tuscan countryside.

Following the tour, rejoin your vehicle for the scenic return journey to Florence, concluding a memorable day immersed in Tuscany’s history, culture, cuisine, and breathtaking landscapes.

DAY 10 | 18 Jul, 2027 FLORENCE TO VENICE [B/-/-]

Enjoy a relaxed breakfast at your own pace before preparing for the day ahead. Later this morning, transfer to Florence Railway Station and board your train to Venice Santa Lucia Railway Station.

Arriving directly in the heart of Venice, you will continue your journey by water taxi to your hotel. Travelling along the city’s picturesque waterways offers a wonderful first glimpse of Venice, a unique destination where traditional roads and cars give way to winding canals, historic bridges, and elegant palazzos.

This evening, discover the timeless charm of Venice with a traditional gondola ride, with up to four guests sharing each gondola. Gently cruise through the city’s enchanting waterways, passing magnificent centuries-old palaces and navigating the quieter back canals. As dusk settles and the lights begin to illuminate the city, enjoy a magical and atmospheric view of Venice from

the water.

DAY 11 | 19 Jul, 2027 VENICE, AT LEISURE [B/-/-]

Indulge in breakfast at the hotel before spending a leisurely day discovering Venice independently. A free day to explore Venice independently. Guests may wander the narrow calli and quiet canals away from the main tourist routes, browse the shops and market stalls around the Rialto Bridge, or simply sit and take in the atmosphere of St Mark’s Square with its café orchestras and pigeons. For those who wish to venture further, the vaporetto water-bus network makes it easy to reach the colourful island of Burano or the glass-making island of Murano, right on the hotel’s doorstep, at your own pace.

Optional - Venice Guided tour including St. Marks Basilica and Doge Palace - USD 180 Per person (minimum 10 travelers)

Explore Venice, accompanied by a local licensed guide on a private four-hour walking tour. Discover the timeless beauty and rich history of the lagoon city as you wander through its atmospheric streets, picturesque squares, narrow alleyways, and charming canals. The tour includes admission to the magnificent **St. Mark’s Basilica**, one of Venice’s most celebrated landmarks. Continue to the impressive **Doge’s Palace**, once the seat of Venetian political power and the residence of the Doge. DAY 12 | 20 Jul, 2027

VENICE, DEPARTURE [B/-/-]

Conclude the journey with breakfast at the hotel before transferring to Venice Airport for the departure flight.

A private taxi-boat transfer takes the group from the dock close to the hotel to Venice Airport for the departure flight, with luggage transferred separately (1 bag pp), bringing a fitting close to the journey with one last glimpse of Venice from the water before departure.
