Begin with a visit to Sintra, a UNESCO World Heritage Site often described as a fairy-tale town for its rolling hills, elegant villas, and grand palaces. Known for its romantic charm, Sintra is one of Portugal's most celebrated destinations. Explore the Sintra National Palace, renowned as the best-preserved medieval royal palace in the country, showcasing a blend of Gothic, Manueline, and Moorish architectural styles. You'll also have free time to wander the town and soak in its unique atmosphere. Continue west to Cabo da Roca, the dramatic cape marking the westernmost point of mainland Europe. This breathtaking cliffside location offers panoramic views of the Atlantic Ocean and is famously described by poet Luís de Camões as the place "where the land ends and the sea begins." The journey then leads to Cascais, a stylish coastal town once favored by Portuguese royalty. Once a humble fishing village, Cascais is now known for its marina, sandy beaches, and vibrant cultural scene. It's also a major golf destination, boasting over ten courses in the region. Take a relaxing walk along the bay and feel the ocean breeze before returning to Lisbon via Estoril, home to one of Europe's most iconic casinos.

Add-on: Full-day tour to Obidos, Nazare, Batalha, and Fatima including lunch: -USD 125 Per person (minimum 15 pax)

Begin your journey with a drive to Óbidos, a charming medieval town enclosed by ancient walls and filled with narrow, winding streets and historic whitewashed houses. Upon arrival, enjoy free time to admire its Gothic architecture, relax at a local café, or sample the region's famous cherry liqueur, Ginja, at one of the many wine shops.

Next, continue to Nazaré, a traditional fishing village known for its picturesque setting and delicious Portuguese cuisine. Take a break here for a leisurely

lunch and savor local specialties before exploring this beloved coastal destination. Enjoy sweeping views of the Atlantic Ocean and capture memorable photos of the dramatic shoreline.

Afterward, travel to Batalha to visit its renowned Gothic monastery—an architectural masterpiece and UNESCO World Heritage Site. The final stop is Fátima, home to Portugal's most significant Marian shrine and a major pilgrimage site.

Depart Lisbon and head north to begin your journey through some of Portugal's most historic and scenic destinations. Your first stop is Coimbra, a renowned university city steeped in history. Here, you'll visit the University of Coimbra, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and explore the ancient cathedral—one of the finest Romanesque monuments in the country. Wander through the city's charming streets, stairways, and medieval courtyards, as well as its bustling commercial district filled with cafés, pastry shops, restaurants, and boutiques. Enjoy lunch before continuing on to Aveiro.

Known as the "Venice of Portugal," Aveiro enchants visitors with its winding canals, colorful Art Nouveau buildings, and traditional Moliceiro boats. You'll enjoy a scenic cruise along the canals before making your way to Porto. Upon arrival, check in to your hotel and enjoy the evening at your leisure.
