DAY 1 | 12 Jan, 2026

DAY 2 | 13 Jan, 2026

Johannesburg Arrival [-/-/-]

DAY 3 | 14 Jan, 2026

Johannesburg Sightseeing [B/-/-]

After breakfast, meet with the tour guide at the hotel in Johannesburg and depart to explore the vibrant sights and sounds of Soweto and Johannesburg, Africa's economic powerhouse. The tour delves into the political and historical significance of the struggle against apartheid, and visits key memorial sites, such as the Apartheid Museum, Soweto's suburbs, and informal settlements.

Our first stop is at Apartheid Museum, exploring the exhibits that cover the turbulent history of the Apartheid era in South Africa. It offers a comprehensive overview of South Africa's Apartheid era, from the onset of segregation to the implementation of the Apartheid system, and covers all of the factors that have shaped the country's 20th-century history, including the discovery of gold, black consciousness, and the first democratic elections. Next, depart for Mandela House and spend some time touring the national monument and learning about Nelson Mandela's personal life and the families that he lived with from 1946 to 1990.

Continue to the Hector Peterson Memorial, to pay respects to those who lost their lives during the Soweto uprising, and learn about the pivotal moment in the anti-Apartheid struggle.

The tour concludes with drop-off at your hotel. Spend rest of the day free at leisure

DAY 4 | 15 Jan, 2026

Johannesburg -Mpumalanga (KRUGER) [B/-/D]

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for the flight to Mpumalanga. Upon arrival, you will be transferred to your lodge in Africa's Iconic Kruger National Park.

Mpumalanga, which means "the place where the sun rises" in Zulu, is a magnificent province of South Africa. It boasts stunning canyons, rivers, mountains, and impressive caves that visitors can explore. Some of the world's top nature reserves, including the Kruger National Park, are located here, providing opportunities to encounter African wildlife and appreciate the breathtaking scenery. DAY 5 | 16 Jan, 2026

Mpumalanga - (Kruger National Park Safari) [B/-/D]

Indulge in a scrumptious breakfast and get ready for an exhilarating morning safari at the Kruger National Park, one of Africa's vast game reserves. To witness the animals in their most active state, wake up early and venture out in an open vehicle with an experienced guide, who will show you the various landscapes ranging from grassy plains to riverine forests.

During the safari, be on the lookout for the "Big Five," which includes lions, leopards, elephants, buffalo, and rhinos, as well as giraffes, zebras, antelopes, and diverse bird species. Enhance your knowledge of the animal's habitat and behavior and get a better understanding of the delicate equilibrium of life in the

African wilderness.

Once the safari is over, head back to the lodge for a relaxed lunch and some free time to unwind and appreciate the natural surroundings.

DAY 6 | 17 Jan, 2026

Mpumalanga - Johannesburg - Cape Town [B/-/]

After breakfast, we will leave the lodge and drive to Johannesburg, airport for your flight to Cape Town. Upon arrival in Cape Town, transfer to the hotel. The evening is at leisure.

Overnight in Cape Town

DAY 7 | 18 Jan, 2026

Cape Town - City Sightseeing including Robben Island Tour [B/-/]

After breakfast, your day begins with a ferry ride across the bay to Robben Island, weather permitting. From the 17th to 20th centuries, the island was used for exile, isolation, and imprisonment. Today, it stands as a UNESCO World Heritage Site and museum, symbolizing the sacrifices made for freedom. A visit to Robben Island is a must when in Cape Town.

Located about 7 kilometers from Cape Town in Table Bay, Robben Island is a significant symbol of South Africa's fight against apartheid. It was once a prison for political detainees, including Nelson Mandela, for almost fifty years. Now a popular museum and tourist site, the tour begins with a 30-minute ferry ride from the V&A Waterfront, offering scenic views of Table Mountain and Cape Town's skyline.

Once on the island, a former political prisoner will guide you, sharing personal stories and providing insight into life on the island. You'll explore the prison cells, including Mandela's, and learn about the severe conditions the prisoners faced. The tour also includes a visit to the island's museum, where exhibits highlight its history and the struggle against apartheid. The entire experience lasts around 3.5 hours, including the ferry trip.

After returning to the mainland, you will drive through

the city center, passing iconic landmarks like the Castle of Good Hope, built in 1666 by the Dutch East India Company, City Hall, and the Grand Parade. The route continues along Adderley Street, where you'll see St. George's Cathedral, the seat of Nobel Peace Laureate Archbishop Desmond Tutu, and the Company Gardens. You'll also visit the Malay Quarter (Bo-Kaap), a historic neighborhood with a rich cultural heritage, shaped by descendants of slaves from Java, Ceylon, and other regions in the East.

Next, enjoy a sparkling tour to see the art of diamond cutting and jewelry manufacturing by expert craftsmen. Learn about the history of South Africa's diamond and gold trade. Finally visit Table Mountain (weather permitting), where you can take a revolving cable car to the summit. From the top, marvel at panoramic views of the city, beaches, and, on a clear day, both Robben Island and Cape Point.

Overnight in Cape Town

DAY 8 | 19 Jan, 2026

Cape Town - Full day Peninsula Tour [B/-/]

After breakfast, meet your guide and embark on a full-day tour of the Cape Peninsula. The first stop is Hout Bay, a picturesque coastal suburb that boasts a vibrant fishing harbor. A boat ride to Seal Island is available at an additional cost.

Next, drive along Chapman's Peak, a scenic coastal road that offers breathtaking views of the Atlantic Ocean and the rugged coastline. Stop at the Cape of Good Hope, the most southwestern point of the African continent, and take a short hike to the lighthouse for panoramic views of the coastline.

After lunch at a local restaurant (own expense), visit Boulders Beach to see the African penguin colony. This is a unique opportunity to see these fascinating creatures in their natural habitat.

Next, head to the historic naval village of Simon's Town and visit the South African Naval Museum. Finally, on the way back to Cape Town, take a scenic drive through the affluent suburb of Constantia, known for its world-renowned wine estates. The tour ends with drop-off at your hotel in the late afternoon
