DAY 1 Depart New York [-/-/]

Prepare yourself! You are leaving today for Paris to start your unbelievable French Riviera and City of Lights tour.

DAY 2 PARIS - ARRIVAL -/-/D

Upon arrival in Paris, claim your bags and proceed towards the arrival hall. Our representative will meet you and assist you with your transfer to the hotel. (Standard check-in time is 3:00 pm).

DAY 3 PARIS - SIGHTSEEING INCLUDING EIFFEL TOWER AND LUNCH [B/L/-]

Today, we will explore the enchanting 'City of Lights' with our Local Specialist. Our tour will begin with a visit to the grand Champs-Élysées, the iconic Arc de Triomphe, the historic Place de la Concorde, and the majestic Notre Dame Cathedral. We will then stroll along the glamorous Champs-Élysées and witness the hustle and bustle of traffic around the Arc de Triomphe before reaching the Eiffel Tower. Here, our guide will provide us with fascinating insights that will help us make the most of our visit to this famous tower. With our guide, we will skip the waiting lines on the ground and head straight to the second level. On the second level, we will enjoy stories about the Eiffel Tower and its unique history, and admire the panoramic views of the City of Light, including Notre Dame, the Louvre Museum, the Arc de Triomphe, and Les Invalides.

Descend to the first floor of the Eiffel Tower and step into the contemporary yet cozy atmosphere of the Madame Brasserie restaurant. Indulge in a three-course lunch, consisting of a starter, main course, and dessert, made from locally sourced and seasonal products.

DAY 4 PARIS - VISIT LOUVRE MUSEUM [B/-/-]

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast. Later this morning meet your guide and proceed to the Louvre Museum, one of the most popular tourist destinations in the world. Then, go on a cruise along the magnificent Seine River and admire the famous monuments in the city. Being the world's largest museum, the Louvre packs 35,000 artworks into a 73,000 square-meter exhibition space in three wings. Each wing possesses more than 70 rooms and displays extensive paintings and objects of art.

See the iconic Mona Lisa, marvel at thousands of amazing paintings, and walk among perfect sculptures. Book the option with an audio guide included and enhance your experience and understanding of the works on display. After the visit to the Louvre Museum, return back to the hotel and spend the rest of the day at leisure exploring the city. Strolling through the park, Paris is home to several beautiful parks, including the Jardin des Tuileries and the Luxembourg Gardens. Take a leisurely stroll through one of these parks and enjoy the scenery.

Add On: Moulin Rouge Show with Dinner, Champagne, and Transfers (minimum 10 pax) - USD 475 Per person

Moulin Rouge is a cabaret and music hall, in the Montmartre neighborhood of Paris. It is known for its extravagant and colorful performances, featuring dancers, acrobats, and other talented performers. The evening begins with a delicious three-course meal, accompanied by a half bottle of champagne per person. The menu features French cuisine. After dinner, the show begins, featuring the famous can-can dance and other performances, including a variety of musical acts. The atmosphere is lively and energetic, with extravagant costumes, sets, and lighting. Moulin Rouge is an iconic Parisian experience and a great way to spend a night out in the city of lights.

DAY 5

PARIS - VERSAILLES CASTLE - FLIGHT TO NICE [B/-]

After having breakfast, you will check out of your hotel and meet your guide to embark on a visit to Versailles Castle. This opulent European castle, located outside of Paris, has been perfectly preserved and serves as a prime example of the lavishness of the French monarchy. The Palace of Versailles is one of the world's largest and most impressive castles, boasting 700 rooms filled with an incredible array of fine art and intricate designs for its 1,250 fireplaces. NICE- CANNES - ANTIBES -WINE TASTING - NICE [B/L/-]

Indulge in a delicious breakfast before embarking on a tour to explore the breathtaking French Riviera. Witness the stunning Promenade des Anglais and La Croisette in Cannes, and discover the hidden gems of the region, such as the picturesque beaches and quaint rural villages. The tour then continues to the Chateau de Berne, a vast estate steeped in history and character, where you can explore the historic winery that has been around for almost three centuries. Stroll through the vineyards and witness the wine-making process from press to bottle before indulging in a tutored tasting session of the wines, followed by a delicious lunch. After lunch, return to your hotel in Nice.

Spend the rest of the evening at your leisure, exploring the charming Old Town, with its narrow streets and historic buildings that are perfect for an evening stroll. Enjoy a gelato or a drink at one of the many bars and restaurants, or savor the delicious Mediterranean cuisine at a local restaurant, visit a bar or nightclub, and experience the vibrant nightlife of Nice, with its many bars and nightclubs open until the early hours of the morning. You could try a rooftop bar like Le Plongeur for cocktails with a view or dance the night away at a club like High Club.
