ITINERARY

DAY 1 Depart - USA/Canada [-/-/-]

Prepare yourself! You are leaving today for Paris to start your Paris and the French Riviera tour.

DAY 2 Paris Arrival [-/-/-]

Upon arrival in Paris, claim your bags and proceed towards the arrival hall. Our representative will meet you and assist you with your transfer to the hotel. (Standard check-in time is 3:00 pm)

If you have arrived early, you might like to take a stroll on the streets of Paris

Overnight in Paris

DAY 3 Paris - Guided tour of Paris including Eiffel Tower lunch with panoramic bay window seating [B/L/-]

Begin your unforgettable Paris adventure with a private hotel pickup. An expert English-speaking tour guide and chauffeur will escort you through the heart of Paris, where you'll visit iconic landmarks including the Arc de Triomphe, Champs-Élysées, Les Invalides, Opéra Garnier, Place Vendôme, Place de la Concorde, the Louvre, Musée d'Orsay, Notre-Dame Cathedral, the Latin Quarter, Île de la Cité, Île Saint-Louis, Montmartre, and the Panthéon. Enjoy plenty of photo opportunities at key spots such as Montmartre and Notre-Dame Cathedral.

The highlight of your tour is a panoramic lunch at Madame Brasserie, located on the 1st floor of the Eiffel Tower. Indulge in a delicious 3-course meal with a choice of starters, main courses, and desserts, paired with Champagne, fine wines, mineral water, and coffee. Enjoy panoramic views of Paris from your window-side seating. At lunchtime, you'll arrive at the base of the Eiffel Tower, where your timed access lift tickets will take you up to the restaurant for your meal.

After lunch, take more time to admire the stunning views of the city from the Eiffel Tower. See famous

landmarks like Champs de Mars, Trocadéro, Les Invalides, the George Pompidou Centre, Notre-Dame Cathedral, and Sacré-Cœur. Experience the transparent floor and explore the outer walkway with its photos, exhibits, and interactive screens showcasing historical facts.

(Note: The tour concludes at the quayside near the Eiffel Tower. A return transfer is available for an additional \$120 if booked in advance.)

Overnight in Paris

DAY 4 Paris - Black Paris tour [B/L/-]

Enjoy your morning meal, then at approximately 9:30 AM, your day in Paris steeped in Black history begins with a pickup from your hotel. We'll board a bus and start our exploration at the Arc de Triomphe, where your guide reveals the stories of African Americans arriving in Paris during the 1800s. Discover the notable history of Black soldiers in World Wars I and II, and visit the Champs Elysees Mansion, where Thomas Jefferson and Sally Hemings began their 38-year relationship in 1787.

A brief bus ride takes us to the stunning Parc Monceau, retracing the steps of Frederick Douglass, Dr. W.E.B. Dubois, Henry O. Tanner, and other prominent figures. We'll stand before a monument commemorating France's abolition of the African slave trade, honoring Napoleon's famous Black general and his son, Alexandre Dumas, a renowned French writer. Learn about Toussaint L'Ouverture and Haiti's historic revolt, passing by author Dumas' former residence and the church dedicated to African Saint Augustine, a Catholic Church founder.

Witness Josephine Baker's church funeral at Place de la Madeleine and pause at Place Concorde, once home to the guillotine during the French Revolution, now housing the US Embassy. Explore the African Obelisk, the oldest Parisian monument brought from Luxor in 1831, an astronomical device used at the Temple of Thebes.

Our next stop, the Olympia Concert Hall, hosted

legendary African American musicians like Louis Armstrong, Nina Simone, and Ray Charles. Continue to the Opera Garnier, where celebrated Black operatic talents graced the stage.

We'll visit "Little Africa" at Chateau Rouge, experiencing its vibrant outdoor market. Drive through historic Montmartre, once dubbed "The Harlem of Paris," then explore lesser-known corners in the Latin Quarter, Montparnasse, Lower Montmartre, and the Champs Elysées, recalling James Baldwin, Richard Wright, and Diaspora intellectuals.

Relish lunch at La Creole, followed by a visit to the Church of the Black Madonna, housing the Notre Dame de Bonne Délivrance, a significant Black Madonna statue from the 14th century.

Stop for a group photo at Place Josephine Baker in the 14th Arrt before your return to the hotel around 5:30 PM. Spend your evening exploring Paris's charming boulevards and lanes, savoring a café au lait while immersing yourself in the city's sophisticated ambiance.

You can take a relaxing stroll along the **Promenade des Anglais**, enjoy the stunning sunset over the Mediterranean, or discover the vibrant nightlife in the Old Town. Explore the charming cafés and restaurants offering delicious Mediterranean cuisine or visit a local bar for a drink. If you prefer something more peaceful, unwind on the beach or enjoy the views from **Castle Hill**. The evening is yours to create the perfect experience in this beautiful coastal city.

Overnight in Nice

DAY 7 Nice - Full day Nice, Monaco, Monte-Carlo and Eze Tour [B/-/-]

Experience the true essence of the Riviera, exploring both hidden treasures and popular landmarks with the expertise of your certified private guide. Begin with a panoramic drive along the iconic "Promenade des Anglais," passing the Bay of Angles, the Old Port, the Paillon Gardens, and Maseena Square, home to striking water mirrors and modern art sculptures. Enjoy a guided walking tour through the pedestrian center, featuring Baroque palaces, a cathedral, charming boutiques, the daily flower market, and the Cours Seleya artisan market.

Before admiring the yachts and high-end boutiques, we will explore the history of the Prince's Palace, originally built as a fortress and the site of numerous historical conflicts. Drive along the Monaco Formula One Grand Prix race track through the Monte Carlo neighborhood, taking in its luxurious hotels and famous landmarks. Stop at two iconic spots: the Monte Carlo Casino and the Monaco Cathedral. Next, visit the hillside village of **Opio**, surrounded by olive groves, pines, cork oak, and strawberry trees. Explore a rare 15th-century mill still in operation and enjoy tasting regional products paired with delicious olive oil.

Continue to **Gourdon**, a picturesque hilltop village offering stunning views of the French Riviera. Admire

its 9th-century castle and beautiful garden, designed by the famous Versailles landscaper, André Lenotre.

Marvel at the **Gorges du Loup**, home to a 40-meter-high waterfall, and visit **Tourrette-sur-Loup**, a village known for its violet cultivation since 1880.

End the day at a wine estate in **Saint-Jeannet**, where you'll sample six different wines, including red, rosé, white, and sweet varieties. Learn from the winemaker about aging wine using glass carboys powered by the sun.

After your tasting, enjoy the beautiful paintings by **Remy Rasse**, who also designs wine labels, before returning to your accommodation.

Next, head to **Antibes**, one of France's oldest cities, founded by Greek merchants in the 5th century. Here, you'll find a mix of locals at the traditional Provençal market and wealthy yacht owners. Explore the charming seafront, historic buildings, and the old town with its lively market.

Finally, visit **Saint-Paul-de-Vence**, a medieval town nestled between the Mediterranean and the Southern Alps. Known for its rich artistic heritage, the town is home to numerous workshops and art galleries.

Discover why it has inspired many artists, writers, and poets, including **Prévert**, **Pagnol**, and painters like **Chagall**, **Picasso**, and **Matisse**.

Add-on: Day trip to Saint-Tropez and Port Grimaud : USD 120 Per person on Shared basis

Saint-Tropez, a legendary village, has long been a favorite of international stars from fashion and literature since the 1920s and remains a hotspot for celebrities, models, and millionaires.
