ITINERARY

DAY 1

ARRIVAL IN CALGARY - TRANSFER TO BANFF [-/-]

Welcome to Alberta! Upon arrival in Calgary, meet your driver for a scenic transfer through rolling foothills and into the breathtaking landscapes of Banff National Park. As you approach Banff, the majestic peaks of the Canadian Rockies rise dramatically around you, offering a spectacular introduction to this mountain paradise.

After checking into your hotel, the rest of the day is free for you to relax and explore at your own pace. Stroll along Banff Avenue, browse charming local shops, or simply unwind and take in the fresh alpine air. Whether you choose to enjoy a quiet evening surrounded by mountain views or sample local cuisine at one of Banff's inviting restaurants, your first day sets the tone for a peaceful and inspiring Rockies retreat.

DAY 2

BANFF SIGHTSEEING TOUR [B/-/-]

After breakfast, embark on a guided sightseeing tour of Banff, a picturesque mountain town nestled within Banff National Park. Your knowledgeable guide will introduce you to the area's rich history, geology, and wildlife as you visit some of its most iconic landmarks.

Begin with a visit to Bow Falls, where the rushing waters create a dramatic backdrop against the forested mountains. Continue to Surprise Corner, a scenic viewpoint offering postcard-perfect views of the Fairmont Banff Springs Hotel, often called the "Castle in the Rockies." You may also choose to visit Banff Avenue's vibrant shops, stop by Central Park for a stroll along the Bow River, or take the optional Banff Gondola ride (at an additional cost) up Sulphur Mountain for sweeping views of six mountain ranges. The afternoon is yours to enjoy at leisure—perhaps unwind in the Banff Upper Hot Springs, or explore one of the nearby hiking trails.

DAY 3

BANFF TO JASPER VIA THE ICEFIELDS PARKWAY [B/-/-]

Today, set out on one of the most scenic drives in the world—the legendary Icefields Parkway, stretching 232 kilometers between Banff and Jasper. As you travel this breathtaking route, you'll be surrounded by towering peaks, sparkling glaciers, and deep turquoise lakes.

Your journey includes several scenic stops such as Bow Lake, Peyto Lake, and Mistaya Canyon, each offering spectacular photo opportunities. Stop at the Columbia Icefield, one of the largest accumulations of ice south of the Arctic Circle. Here, you may take an optional Ice Explorer ride onto the Athabasca Glacier or walk along the Glacier Skywalk, a glass-floored observation platform with dramatic views of the Sunwapta Valley below.

Continue northward through pristine wilderness before arriving in Jasper, a tranquil mountain town known for its relaxed atmosphere and stunning natural surroundings. Check into your hotel and enjoy an evening at leisure—perhaps dine in one of Jasper's cozy restaurants or take a gentle evening walk beneath the vast, star-filled sky.

DAY 4

JASPER NATIONAL PARK TOUR [B/-/-]

After breakfast, begin a full-day guided exploration of Jasper National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site celebrated for its rugged landscapes and abundant wildlife. Your tour will take you to scenic highlights such as Maligne Canyon, where water has carved narrow limestone walls over centuries, and Pyramid Lake, framed by the striking Pyramid Mountain.

Keep an eye out for elk, deer, or even bears as you travel through the park's alpine meadows and forests. You may also visit Medicine Lake, known for its mysterious disappearing waters, and Maligne Lake (seasonal), where you can opt for a short cruise to Spirit Island, one of Canada's most photographed spots.

The afternoon is free to enjoy Jasper at your own

pace—browse the local shops, visit the Jasper Yellowhead Museum, or simply relax and breathe in the crisp mountain air.

DAY 5 JASPER TO EDMONTON - DEPARTURE [B/-/-]

Enjoy a final breakfast in the Rockies before departing Jasper. Travel eastward through rolling foothills and forested landscapes as you make your way toward Edmonton, Alberta's vibrant capital city, or to the nearest airport for your flight home. Reflect on the awe-inspiring scenery and unforgettable experiences of your Canadian Rockies adventure as your journey comes to an end.
