OVERVIEW

Bavarian Charm to Iberian Soul is a sweeping multi-city journey that pairs the fairy-tale castles and beer-hall traditions of southern Germany with the passionate, history-steeped cities of Spain. The journey begins in Munich, Bavaria's elegant capital, with a guided walking tour through the atmospheric Old Town, taking in Marienplatz, the Frauenkirche and the bustling Viktualienmarkt. An evening Beer and Food Tour introduces the flavours and traditions of Bavarian cuisine, paired with a visit to the Oktoberfest Museum, before a full-day excursion into the Alps reveals two of King Ludwig II's most extraordinary royal residences, Neuschwanstein and Linderhof. From Munich, the journey continues by air to Madrid, Spain's vibrant capital, for a guided city sightseeing tour and a full-day excursion to the UNESCO-listed city of Toledo, renowned for its blend of Christian, Muslim and Jewish heritage. Travelling south by high-speed train to Seville, the fiery heart of Andalusia, guests enjoy full-day excursions to Granada, home to the breathtaking Alhambra palace complex, and to Córdoba, famed for its extraordinary Mezquita-Catedral, along with a free day to soak up Seville's flamenco-filled streets at leisure. The tour concludes in Barcelona, Catalonia's dynamic capital, with a guided city tour showcasing Antoni Gaudí's celebrated modernist landmarks, including the still-unfinished Sagrada Família, and a half-day excursion to the dramatic mountain monastery of Montserrat. A further free day allows guests to explore Barcelona's beaches, markets and museums independently, bringing this rich Bavarian-and-Iberian adventure to a memorable close.

ITINERARY

DAY 1 DEPART FOR GERMANY

Prepare yourself! You are leaving today for Munich to begin your Bavarian adventure, followed by a journey south into the sun-soaked cities of Spain.

Overnight onboard flight

DAY 2 MUNICH - ARRIVAL [-/-/-]

Arrive into Munich, the vibrant Bavarian capital, and once you have collected your luggage, make your way toward the arrivals hall. A representative will be waiting to greet you and assist with a smooth transfer to your hotel. (Standard check-in time is 3:00 pm), so if you arrive earlier in the day, consider a relaxed stroll through the streets surrounding your hotel to get your first taste of Bavarian charm.

DAY 3 MUNICH - OLD TOWN WALKING TOUR & BAVARIAN EVENING [B/-/D]

Enjoy a hearty breakfast at your hotel before setting off on a guided walking tour of Munich's atmospheric Old Town. Wander through Marienplatz, the city's historic main square, and admire the intricate Neo-Gothic façade of the New Town Hall with its famous Glockenspiel. Continue past the twin onion domes of the Frauenkirche, Munich's iconic cathedral, and explore the lively stalls of the Viktualienmarkt, a beloved open-air food market. Your guide will share stories of the city's royal Wittelsbach heritage and its transformation over the centuries into Bavaria's cultural capital. In the evening, embark on a delightful Beer and Food Tour, sampling traditional Bavarian specialties alongside the region's celebrated beer at some of Munich's most characterful taverns, complete with dinner. Conclude the evening with a visit to the Oktoberfest Museum, where exhibits bring to life the origins and traditions of the world's most famous beer festival.

DAY 4 MUNICH - NEUSCHWANSTEIN & LINDERHOF CASTLES [B/-/-]

After a leisurely breakfast, depart for a full-day excursion into the foothills of the Bavarian Alps to discover two of King Ludwig II's most celebrated royal residences. Begin at Neuschwanstein Castle, the fairy-tale fortress perched dramatically on a rugged hilltop above the village of Hohenschwangau, said to have inspired Walt Disney's own castle designs. Explore the castle's ornate interiors, including richly decorated halls inspired by Wagnerian opera, and take in sweeping views across the surrounding lakes and mountains. Continue to Linderhof Palace, the smallest yet most opulent of Ludwig's palaces, set within beautifully landscaped gardens complete with fountains, pavilions and the extravagant artificial Venus Grotto. Your guide will share insights into the eccentric "Fairy Tale King," his passion for architecture and the legacy he left across Bavaria. Return to Munich in the evening with time to relax before dinner at leisure.

DAY 5 MUNICH - MADRID [B/-/-]

Following breakfast, check out of your hotel and transfer to Munich Airport for your onward flight to Madrid. Upon arrival in Spain's dynamic capital, you will be met and transferred to your hotel. The remainder of the day is free to relax after your travels or begin exploring the streets around your hotel at your own pace.

DAY 6 MADRID - CITY SIGHTSEEING TOUR [B/-/-]

Start your morning with breakfast before setting out on a guided sightseeing tour of Madrid. Drive past the elegant boulevards of Gran Vía and admire the grandeur of the Royal Palace, Spain's official residence though used today mainly for state ceremonies. Continue to the Plaza Mayor, the city's magnificent 17th-century square, and wander through the atmospheric lanes of the historic centre toward the

Puerta del Sol, the symbolic heart of Madrid. Your guide will point out highlights such as the Cibeles Fountain and the elegant Paseo del Prado, home to some of the world's finest art museums. Learn about Madrid's transformation from a modest medieval town into one of Europe's great capitals as you take in its striking mix of architecture. The afternoon is free for you to revisit favourite sights, browse local boutiques or simply enjoy a coffee at one of the city's classic plazas.

Overnight in Madrid

DAY 7 FULL-DAY TOLEDO EXCURSION [B/-/-]

Fuel up with breakfast before departing for a full-day excursion to Toledo, the former capital of Spain and a UNESCO World Heritage Site perched dramatically above the Tagus River. Wander through the city's labyrinth of narrow medieval streets, where Christian, Muslim and Jewish influences have coexisted for centuries, earning Toledo its reputation as the "City of Three Cultures." Visit the soaring Toledo Cathedral, one of the finest examples of Gothic architecture in Spain, and explore the fortress-like Alcázar, which dominates the city's skyline. Discover the artistry of Toledo's famous damascene metalwork and sword-making traditions, crafts that have been practised in the city since Roman times. Take in panoramic views across the city and river from one of Toledo's scenic viewpoints before returning to Madrid in the evening.

Overnight in Madrid

DAY 8 MADRID – SEVILLE BY TRAIN [B/-/-]

Once breakfast is enjoyed, check out of your hotel and transfer to the train station for your onward journey to Seville aboard a high-speed train. Sit back and watch the Castilian countryside give way to the sun-drenched landscapes of Andalusia as you travel south in comfort. On arrival in Seville, the passionate heart of Andalusia, you will be met and transferred to your hotel. The remainder of the day is free for you to settle in and begin discovering the city's flamenco rhythms and orange-blossom-scented streets at your own pace.

DAY 9 GRANADA & ALHAMBRA DAY TRIP [B/-/-]

Wake up to a delicious breakfast before setting off on a full-day excursion to Granada, home to one of the world's most extraordinary architectural treasures. Spend the day exploring the Alhambra, the magnificent Moorish fortress-palace complex that once served as the residence of the Nasrid sultans. Marvel at the intricately carved stucco and tilework of the Nasrid Palaces, and stroll through the tranquil, fountain-filled gardens of the Generalife, the sultans' summer retreat. Your guide will bring to life the history of Al-Andalus and the layers of Moorish, Christian and Jewish heritage that shaped Granada over the centuries. Continue into the whitewashed lanes of the Albaicín quarter, Granada's old Moorish neighbourhood, for sweeping views back across to the Alhambra's red walls. Return to Seville in the evening after a day steeped in history and breathtaking architecture.

Overnight in Seville

DAY 10 SEVILLE – DAY FREE AT LEISURE [B/-/-]

Begin the day with a relaxed breakfast before setting out to explore Seville entirely at your own pace. Wander through the fragrant orange-tree-lined streets of the Santa Cruz quarter, once the city's Jewish district, or visit the opulent Real Alcázar, a stunning Mudéjar palace still used by the Spanish royal family today. History enthusiasts may wish to climb the Giralda Tower for panoramic views, while others might prefer an afternoon at leisure along the Guadalquivir River or an evening flamenco show in one of the city's traditional tablaos.

DAY 11 DAY TRIP TO CORDOBA [B/-/-]

Indulge in breakfast before departing on a full-day excursion to Córdoba, once the glittering capital of Moorish Spain and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Step inside the extraordinary Mezquita-Catedral, a former mosque transformed into a cathedral, famed for its forest of red-and-white striped arches and stunning fusion of Islamic and Christian architecture. Wander through the enchanting Jewish Quarter, with its whitewashed houses and flower-filled courtyards, a hallmark of Córdoba's springtime Patios Festival. Visit the Alcázar de los Reyes Cristianos, the fortress-palace

once used by the Catholic Monarchs, and admire its terraced gardens overlooking the city. Cross the ancient Roman Bridge spanning the Guadalquivir River, a structure dating back nearly 2,000 years, before returning to Seville in the evening.

Overnight in Seville

DAY 12 SEVILLE - BARCELONA BY TRAIN [B/-/-]

Set off after breakfast and transfer to the train station for your journey to Barcelona, travelling in comfort as the landscape shifts from Andalusian plains to the Mediterranean coast. On arrival in Barcelona, Catalonia's vibrant capital, you will be met and transferred to your hotel. The rest of the day is free for you to acclimatise, wander nearby streets or simply relax after your journey.

DAY 13 BARCELONA CITY TOUR & SAGRADA FAMÍLIA [B/-/-]

Kick off the day with breakfast before joining a guided sightseeing tour of Barcelona, one of Europe's most architecturally captivating cities. Wander through the atmospheric Gothic Quarter, with its medieval lanes, hidden squares and the striking Barcelona Cathedral, before continuing along the elegant Passeig de Gràcia to admire the whimsical façades of Casa Batlló and Casa Milà, two of Antoni Gaudí's celebrated modernist masterpieces. The highlight of the day is a visit to the Sagrada Família, Gaudí's still-unfinished basilica and Barcelona's most iconic landmark, renowned for its extraordinary spires and light-filled, forest-like interior. Your guide will share insights into Gaudí's visionary style and Barcelona's transformation during the Catalan Modernisme movement. Time permitting, enjoy a stroll along the lively Las Ramblas boulevard before the afternoon is left free to explore further at your leisure.

Overnight in Barcelona

DAY 14 BARCELONA - DAY FREE AT LEISURE [B/-/-]

Treat yourself to breakfast before spending the day exploring Barcelona at your own pace. Relax on the golden sands of Barceloneta Beach, browse the vibrant stalls of La Boqueria Market, or delve into the artistic legacy of the city at the Picasso Museum. Alternatively, take a cable car up to Montjuïc Hill for sweeping views over the city and the Mediterranean, or simply enjoy a leisurely lunch at one of Barcelona's many tapas bars.

DAY 15 DAY TRIP TO MONTSERRAT [B/-/-]

Refuel with breakfast before departing for a half-day excursion to Montserrat, the dramatic multi-peaked mountain range located northwest of Barcelona. Ride the cable car or rack railway up through the striking rock formations to reach the Benedictine Monastery of Montserrat, perched high above the Catalan countryside. Visit the basilica to see the revered Black Madonna, a wooden statue of the Virgin Mary and one of Catalonia's most important religious icons, and, if timing allows, listen to the world-famous boys' choir perform. Take in breathtaking panoramic views across the surrounding valleys and, weather permitting, enjoy walking one of the scenic trails that wind through the mountain's unusual rock spires. Return to Barcelona in the afternoon with the remainder of the day free at leisure.

DAY 16 BARCELONA - DEPARTURE [B/-/-]

Conclude your journey with a final breakfast at your hotel before checking out at the appropriate time. Transfer to Barcelona Airport in good time for your return flight home, bringing to a close an unforgettable journey through Bavaria, Madrid, Andalusia and Catalonia.
