ITINERARY

DAY 1 Depart USA/Canada [-/-/-]

Prepare yourself! You are leaving today for Amsterdam to start your Amsterdam and Paris Highlights tour.

DAY 2 Amsterdam Arrival

Upon arrival in Amsterdam, claim your bags and proceed toward the arrival hall. Our representative will meet you and assist you with your transfer to the hotel. (Standard check-in time is 3:00 pm). Check-in at the hotel and catch up on your rest.

Overnight in Amsterdam

DAY 3 Amsterdam - Sightseeing [B/-/-]

Experience the beauty of the Netherlands with this exciting Private Windmill Tour from Amsterdam, showcasing the best of Holland in a single unforgettable day. Step outside the city to explore the picturesque Dutch countryside. Start your day with a visit to a local dairy farm, where you'll learn about the tradition of clog-making (wooden shoes) and sample homemade Gouda cheese. After a delicious lunch (own expense), drive through the UNESCO World Heritage polders of De Beemster and Schermer. These fertile lands were created through impressive engineering, including the use of windmills to pump water from the lakes. Marvel at the 17th-century wooden windmills that create this scenic, postcard-worthy landscape. Edam, a quintessential Dutch town, is famous for its cheese and charming canals, traditional houses, and historic bridges. Take a leisurely stroll through this quaint town, where you'll meet friendly locals. DAY 5 Amsterdam - Paris [B/-/-]

DAY 6 Paris - Guided tour of Paris including Eiffel Tower lunch with panoramic bay window seating [B/L/-]

(Note: The tour concludes at the quayside near the Eiffel Tower. A return transfer is available for an additional \$120 if booked in advance.)

Overnight in Paris

After breakfast, take a leisurely walk along the Seine River to the impressive **Notre-Dame de Paris**, a prime example of French Gothic architecture built between the 12th and 14th centuries. Continue along the riverbanks, passing the iconic booksellers who have long been a part of the scene, until you arrive at **Place de la Concorde**, the largest square in Paris, home to the 3,300-year-old **Luxor Obelisk** from Egypt. Your journey then leads you to the **Eiffel Tower**, the symbol of Paris and France, where you can capture unforgettable moments of the City of Lights.
