DAY 1 DEPART FOR FRANCE

Prepare yourself! You are leaving today for Paris to start your Best of London and Paris explorer tour.

DAY 2 PARIS ARRIVAL [-/-/-]

Upon arrival in Paris, claim your bags and proceed to the arrival hall. Our representative will meet you and assist with your transfer to the hotel. (Standard check-in time is 3:00 pm.)

If you arrive early, you might like to take a stroll through the streets of Paris.

DAY 3 PARIS - GUIDED TOUR OF PARIS INCLUDING EIFFEL TOWER LUNCH WITH PANORAMIC BAY WINDOW SEATING [B/L/-]

Begin your unforgettable Paris adventure with a private hotel pickup. An expert English-speaking tour guide and chauffeur will escort you through the heart of Paris, where you'll visit iconic landmarks including the Arc de Triomphe, Champs-Élysées, Les Invalides, Opéra Garnier, Place Vendôme, Place de la Concorde, the Louvre, Musée d'Orsay, Notre-Dame Cathedral, the Latin Quarter, Île de la Cité, Île Saint-Louis, Montmartre, and the Panthéon. Enjoy plenty of photo opportunities at key spots such as Montmartre and Notre-Dame Cathedral.

The highlight of your tour is a panoramic lunch at Madame Brasserie, located on the 1st floor of the Eiffel Tower. Indulge in a delicious 3-course meal with a choice of starters, main courses, and desserts, paired with Champagne, fine wines, mineral water, and coffee. Enjoy panoramic views of Paris from your window-side seating. In the afternoon or at sunset, enjoy a one-hour Seine River cruise (included), offering a unique and scenic way to explore Paris. Along the way, learn about the city's rich history and architectural marvels.

It is the burial site of more than 3,300 persons of prominence in British history: at least 16 monarchs, 8 Prime Ministers, poets laureate, actors, scientists, military leaders, and the Unknown Warrior, an unknown soldier killed in Europe during World War I.

Next, visit the stunning St. Paul's Cathedral, a masterpiece by Sir Christopher Wren featuring a breathtaking dome, historic tombs, mosaics, and a fascinating history, including its role as the wedding venue for Princess Diana and Charles.

No trip to London is complete without a photo stop at Buckingham Palace, where you can experience the grandeur of this royal residence and witness the traditional Changing of the Guard ceremony with the iconic red uniforms and bearskin hats. If the ceremony isn't available, a visit to Horseguards Parade will be included instead.

Next up is the lastminute.com London Eye Experience, where you'll ascend 135 metres in one of its famous glass capsules for panoramic views of the city. On clear days, you can spot landmarks as far as Windsor Castle! Following this breathtaking experience, unwind with a relaxing River Thames Boat Ride. This leisurely journey offers a unique perspective of London as you glide through the heart of the city and dock at Tower Pier.

The final stop on your journey is an extended visit to the Tower of London. This iconic historic site offers tales of intrigue, royalty, and history. Marvel at the dazzling Crown Jewels, learn about the gruesome past of Anne Boleyn's execution on Tower Green, and explore the Royal Beasts Exhibition and the Royal Mint. Add-on: Oxford, Stratford-upon-Avon, Cotswolds and Warwick Castle Tour - USD 109 Per person on shared basis

Begin your British adventure at Windsor Castle, the world's oldest and largest occupied castle, home to the British monarchy for over 900 years. Explore the opulent State Apartments, featuring art by Da Vinci and Rembrandt, and visit St George's Chapel, the venue for royal weddings and the resting place of Queen Elizabeth II. If visiting on Thursday or Saturday, enjoy the Changing of the Guard ceremony. Windsor Castle is closed on Tuesdays and Wednesdays, but a guided walking tour of Windsor is available on those days.

Next, visit Stonehenge, the ancient stone circle that has stood for 5,000 years. Discover its mysteries at the visitor centre, showcasing archaeological finds, contemporary art, and a café. Don't miss the recreation of Neolithic houses from past excavations.

In Bath, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, explore its

stunning Georgian architecture and visit the Roman Baths. Though you can't bathe in the waters, enjoy the views and taste the waters at the Pump Room. Time permitting, wander the charming streets to see Bath Abbey, the Royal Crescent, Pulteney Bridge, and the Jane Austen Centre for a Regency afternoon tea.

Add-on: Windsor Castle, Bath and Stonehenge Tour - USD 109 Per person on shared basis

Maximize your time in England with a day trip to the countryside. Explore Oxford, visiting the University Church of St Mary the Virgin, and admire the city's historic colleges and cobbled streets. Discover the beauty of the Cotswolds, passing through scenic villages and market towns.

In Stratford-upon-Avon, visit Shakespeare's birthplace and learn about the early years of the world's most famous playwright.

End the day at Warwick Castle, where you can step back into medieval times. Experience battle preparations, try on a battle helmet, tour the grand State Rooms, and enjoy a medieval host's introduction to the castle.

DAY 9 LONDON - DEPARTURE [B/-/-]

Your unforgettable journey through London and Paris concludes today. Depending on your flight schedule, you may enjoy some free time to explore London at your own pace. Take the opportunity to visit any attractions you may have missed, such as the iconic Tower Bridge, the British Museum, or the lively Covent Garden, or indulge in some last-minute shopping along Oxford Street or at one of London's famous markets. Whether you choose to soak in the city's vibrant atmosphere or pick up a few final souvenirs, the time is yours to enjoy.
