## DAY 3 Banff - Lake Louise - Columbia Ice Fields - Jasper [B/L/-]

Jasper - Discover Jasper tour with Maligne lake Cruise [B/-/-]

Weather permitting, an opportunity arises for a cruise to Spirit Island, a small gem embellishing the lake. Along the way, you'll encounter the intriguing Medicine Lake, famous for its unique "disappearing" phenomenon. The tour proceeds to Maligne Lake,

where a captivating 90-minute interpretative boat cruise awaits, guiding you to the renowned Spirit Island. Keep your camera ready, as this location unfolds a truly picturesque setting worthy of a postcard.

After the enchanting boat cruise, take a moment to unwind and soak in the scenic beauty or treat yourself to a delightful experience at the Lake Chalet. Alternatively, for those seeking a different perspective, a 75-minute guided walk along the shoreline trail of Maligne Lake is available as a charming alternative to the boat cruise. Whether gliding over the waters or exploring the shoreline on foot, this tour ensures a remarkable encounter with the natural marvels of Jasper National Park, leaving you with enduring memories of this extraordinary journey.
