DAY 1 USA/CANADA - CAPE TOWN

Get ready for an unforgettable adventure! Today, you set off for Cape Town — the gateway to your incredible journey through the heart of South Africa.

DAY 2 CAPE TOWN ARRIVAL [-/-/-]

DAY 4 FULL DAY CAPE PENINSULA TOUR (CAPE TOWN ROUNDTRIP) [B/-/-]

DAY 5 CAPE TOWN TO STELLENBOSCH [B/-/-]

Arriving in **Oudtshoorn**, the “ostrich capital of the world,” you’ll get a first glimpse of this unique town set amid striking desert scenery. Oudtshoorn is renowned not only for its thriving ostrich farms but also for its fascinating history tied to the feather trade and its nearby natural wonders, including the Cango Caves.

DAY 7
