DAY 1 NIAGARA FALLS - ARRIVAL [-/-/D]

You may take a relaxing walk near the illuminated Falls in the evening or enjoy the ambiance of this iconic destination on your own. A welcome dinner provides the perfect opportunity to meet fellow travelers and begin your Canadian adventure.

DAY 2 NIAGARA FALLS SIGHTSEEING [B/-/D]

After breakfast, embark on an unforgettable day exploring Niagara Falls, one of the most awe-inspiring natural wonders of the world. Begin your adventure with a visit to Journey Behind the Falls, where a network of tunnels leads you to observation decks directly behind the thunderous Horseshoe Falls. Feel the power of nature as millions of gallons of water cascade just meters away, filling the air with mist and roar.

Continue with a leisurely stroll along the scenic Niagara Parkway, a stretch famously described by Winston Churchill as “the prettiest Sunday afternoon drive in the world.” Take in spectacular viewpoints overlooking the American Falls and Bridal Veil Falls, capturing unforgettable photos of this natural masterpiece.

Later, enjoy free time to explore at your own pace. Visit Queen Victoria Park, adorned with beautifully manicured gardens and seasonal floral displays, or enjoy a coffee or snack at a café overlooking the falls. Optional experiences include a thrilling boat cruise to the base of the falls or a ride on the Niagara SkyWheel, offering panoramic views from above.

As evening approaches, gather for dinner at a local restaurant and then marvel at the evening illumination of Niagara Falls, where the cascading waters are lit up in an ever-changing array of colors.

DAY 3 NIAGARA FALLS - TORONTO [B/-/D]

After breakfast, depart Niagara Falls and travel along the picturesque Niagara Parkway, lined with vineyards, orchards, and historic landmarks. The afternoon is free to explore at your own pace. Perhaps wander through the bohemian Plateau-Mont-Royal neighborhood, relax in a stylish café, or explore Montreal's cutting-edge fashion boutiques and art galleries. Food lovers may wish to sample local favorites such as poutine or Montreal-style bagels.

Enjoy a full day at leisure to experience Montreal in your own way.
