DAY 1 DEPART FOR MUNICH

Prepare yourself! You are leaving today for Germany to embark on a magical Christmas journey through Bavaria's charming medieval towns, spectacular Alpine scenery, storybook castles, and enchanting festive markets.

DAY 2 MUNICH ARRIVAL [-/-/-]

DAY 3 DAY TRIP TO NEUSCHWANSTEIN & HOHENSCHWANGAU CASTLES [B/L/-]

After breakfast, depart Munich and travel south towards the Bavarian Alps to visit two of Germany's most spectacular castles—Hohenschwangau and Neuschwanstein. Dating back to the 12th century, these fairytale castles are among the most photographed landmarks in the world and famously inspired Disney's Cinderella Castle. Commissioned by King Maximilian of Bavaria and later by his son, King Ludwig II, both castles are adorned with elegant towers, domes, and soaring pinnacles that rise dramatically above the stunning alpine landscape.

Enjoy guided tours of both castles, where you will discover the grandeur of the era and gain insight into King Ludwig II's extraordinary imagination. The lavish interiors feature exquisite furnishings, intricate woodwork, and remarkable works of art, reflecting the king's unique vision and artistic taste.

Following the visits, enjoy a light lunch at a restaurant overlooking the tranquil waters of Lake Alpsee before returning to Munich in the evening.

The evening is free to explore Munich's vibrant Christmas markets at your own pace. Wander through beautifully decorated stalls filled with handcrafted gifts, traditional Bavarian delicacies, fragrant gingerbread, roasted almonds, and steaming cups of Glühwein. Later, enjoy a relaxed guided stroll through Munich's enchanting Old Town, transformed into a winter wonderland. Against a backdrop of snow-dusted Alpine scenery, medieval streets adorned with festive decorations, and the irresistible aromas of the Christmas season, discover the city's iconic landmarks at their most magical.

DAY 4 MUNICH SIGHTSEEING - TRANSFER TO NUREMBERG [B/-/-]

Following breakfast, embark on a privately guided tour showcasing Munich's medieval and baroque treasures. Begin at the magnificent Residenz Palace, once home to the Wittelsbach rulers, surrounded by beautifully landscaped gardens where artisans dressed in traditional attire demonstrate historic candle-making and glass-blowing techniques.

Continue to Marienplatz, the historic heart of Munich, where a magnificent Christmas tree stands proudly in the centre of the famous Christkindlmarkt. This festive market comes alive with music, twinkling lights, and seasonal celebrations. Enjoy the delightful sounds of the famous Glockenspiel, accompanied by performances from a brass band and an Alpine choir singing from the balcony of the Neo-Gothic Town Hall.

Following the sightseeing tour, continue your journey to Nuremberg. With nearly one thousand years of history, Nuremberg is renowned for its remarkably preserved medieval charm. Explore its picturesque Altstadt (Old Town), where narrow cobbled streets, charming bridges, and traditional half-timbered houses evoke the atmosphere of the Middle Ages. Dominating the skyline just north of the Old Town is Nuremberg Castle, one of Europe's finest surviving medieval fortresses.

Overnight in Nuremberg

DAY 5 NUREMBERG [B/-/D]

Enjoy a leisurely morning at your own pace.

Later this afternoon, meet your guide at 2:00 PM for a visit to Germany's most celebrated Christmas market. Begin at the Hauptmarkt, home to the impressive 14th-century "Beautiful Fountain," admired for its intricate craftsmanship and beautifully detailed figures. The square hosts the world-famous Nuremberg Christkindlesmarkt, recognised by the German National Tourist Board as one of Germany's Top 100 attractions. Featuring around 180 charming wooden stalls decorated with festive wreaths and garlands, the market creates an unforgettable Christmas atmosphere.

Take time to immerse yourself in the festive surroundings and browse the wide variety of seasonal gifts and local delicacies. Be sure to sample Nuremberg's famous Lebkuchen, the city's iconic gingerbread that has been baked here for more than 600 years. Available in a variety of sizes and coated with chocolate or sugar, these traditional treats make excellent souvenirs, often beautifully packaged in decorative tins. No visit would be complete without enjoying a warming mug of traditional mulled wine.

In the evening, enjoy dinner at the historic Bratwurst Roeslein. Established in 1431, this renowned Bavarian restaurant combines centuries of tradition with a warm and welcoming atmosphere in the heart of Nuremberg's medieval district.

Overnight in Nuremberg

DAY 6 NUREMBERG - REGENSBURG [B/L/-]

After breakfast, check out of your hotel and continue your journey to Regensburg, home to one of Europe's best-preserved medieval city centres.

Upon arrival, enjoy lunch at the Historic Sausage Kitchen, one of the world's oldest continuously operating restaurants. Originally serving the workers who built the nearby 12th-century Stone Bridge, this family-run establishment has been passed down through generations and is celebrated for its hearty potato soup and its famous Regensburger sausages, traditionally served with sweet mustard and

sauerkraut.

Following lunch, check in to your hotel and enjoy some time to relax.

In the evening, meet your guide and visit the Christmas market near Neupfarrplatz, where you can sample a variety of regional festive treats. Stop at the legendary Historische Wurstkuchl to savour its traditional sausages served with sauerkraut. As night falls, enjoy a romantic walk along the riverside while admiring the beautifully illuminated cathedral and the charming Old Town, glowing softly in the winter evening.

Overnight in Regensburg

DAY 7 REGENSBURG, FAREWELL [B/-/D]

After breakfast, enjoy a leisurely morning at your own pace before meeting your guide in the afternoon for a guided walking tour of Regensburg's picturesque Old Town, one of the best-preserved medieval city centres in Europe.

During the tour, admire the impressive residences once owned by wealthy merchants, reflecting the city's prosperous trading history. You will also see the historic Old Town Hall, the magnificent cathedral (viewed from the outside), the iconic Stone Bridge, and the ancient Porta Praetoria, each offering a fascinating glimpse into Regensburg's rich architectural and cultural heritage.

Your guide will then lead you to the Romantic Christmas Market, beautifully set within the charming inner courtyard of Thurn und Taxis Castle. Surrounded by festive decorations, twinkling lights, and traditional wooden stalls, take time to soak in the magical Christmas atmosphere while browsing the market's seasonal offerings. Enjoy a warm glass of mulled wine as you experience the unique charm and festive spirit of one of Germany's most enchanting Christmas markets.

In the evening, gather with your fellow travellers for a memorable farewell dinner, celebrating the wonderful experiences and festive moments shared throughout your journey across Bavaria.
