## DAY 3 DELHI SIGHTSEEING - OLD DELHI & ICONIC LANDMARKS [B/-/-]

**After breakfast, meet your expert local guide for a full-day discovery tour of Delhi, offering an authentic introduction to the vibrant pulse of Indian life.**

Begin with the impressive **Jama Masjid**, the largest mosque in India, built by Emperor Shah Jahan between 1644 and 1656. Wander through its expansive courtyard and take in the spiritual ambiance as you learn about its historical and religious significance.

**Continue to the majestic Red Fort**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and an enduring symbol of India's Mughal legacy. Built in the 17th century by Emperor Shah Jahan, this architectural marvel features grand palaces, lush gardens, and fascinating museums waiting to be explored.

Enjoy Lunch at a renowned local restaurant offering authentic Delhi cuisine. Post lunch visit **Gurudwara Bangla Sahib**, one of Delhi's most prominent Sikh houses of worship. Known for its serene atmosphere and its association with the eighth Sikh Guru, **Guru Har Krishan**, the temple also features a sacred water tank called the **Sarovar**, believed to possess healing

properties.

Finally dive into the dynamic atmosphere of **Old Delhi**, where time seems to stand still amidst the chaos and charm. Stroll through age-old lanes as your guide brings the history of this area to life, and enjoy traditional Indian sweets and savory snacks from local vendors. Then, hop aboard a **rickshaw** for a thrilling ride through **Chandni Chowk**, the legendary "Moonlit Market." Wind your way to **Mutton Street**, renowned for its sizzling kebabs, spiced skewers, and rich Islamic street food. This immersive experience offers a true taste of Old Delhi's colorful character and culinary heritage.

## DAY 4 DELHI EXPLORATION - MODERN & CULTURAL HIGHLIGHTS [B/-/-]

**After breakfast, explore the spiritual and modern facets of Delhi.**

Begin with a visit to **India Gate**, a solemn war memorial honoring the sacrifices of Indian soldiers. Enjoy a peaceful walk around the area, soaking in its patriotic atmosphere. Continue with a drive past **Rashtrapati Bhavan** (the President's House) and the **Parliament House**, pausing for exterior views and excellent photo opportunities. Stop at **Raj Ghat**, the serene memorial dedicated to **Mahatma Gandhi**, marking the spot of his cremation.

Next, visit **Humayun's Tomb**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site built in 1570. This impressive structure is a prime example of Mughal architecture and is considered the first garden tomb in India, setting a precedent for later monuments like the Taj Mahal.

Conclude your tour with a visit to **Qutub Minar**, another UNESCO-listed site. Standing 73 meters tall, this historic red sandstone minaret, started in 1192 by **Qutub-ud-din Aibak**, is a remarkable representation of Delhi's early Islamic architecture and legacy.

## DAY 5 DELHI - AGRA [B/-/-]

Today, after breakfast, check out from your hotel and travel to Agra, home to the stunning **Taj Mahal**, one of the seven wonders of the world. Agra itself was once the capital of the Mughal Empire, rich with history and culture.

Arrive in Agra by afternoon and check into your hotel. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before taking some time to relax and freshen up.

In the afternoon, visit **Agra Fort**, a magnificent fortress that served as the main residence of the Mughal emperors until 1638. Walk through its vast courtyards of red sandstone and marble while your guide shares fascinating stories about its history. Afterwards, explore **Sadar Bazaar**, known for its exquisite marble handicrafts. Wrap up your day with a chance to savor authentic Mughlai cuisine, such as kebabs or biryani, before spending the night in Agra.

#### DAY 6 AGRA - JAIPUR [B/-/-]

Early in the morning, visit the stunning **Taj Mahal**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site built in 1632 CE by Emperor Shah Jahan as a memorial to his beloved wife, Mumtaz Mahal.

Return to your hotel for breakfast. Afterward, check out and continue your journey to the **Pink City, Jaipur**, famous for its broad avenues, grand forts, magnificent palaces, ornate temples, and rich royal history.

On the way, stop at **Chand Baori**, an extraordinary 13-story stepwell in the village of Abhaneri, Rajasthan. Constructed over a thousand years ago, it stands as one of the largest and most beautiful stepwells in the world.

Arrive in Jaipur by afternoon and check into your hotel. Take some time to relax. Later in the evening, embark on a guided walking tour of Jaipur's bustling markets. Known as a shopper's paradise, these vibrant bazaars are ideal for browsing handcrafted bangles and traditional decorative items. Immerse yourself in the lively culture and unique energy of the city as you

explore.

For dinner savor Rajasthani dishes like dal baati churma for **dinner**.

#### DAY 7 JAIPUR SIGHTSEEING [B/-/-]

After breakfast, begin your exploration of Jaipur's top attractions. Start with the **Hawa Mahal**, or "Palace of Winds," a striking façade designed to allow royal women to watch street festivals without being seen. Next, visit **Jantar Mantar**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site featuring nineteen architectural astronomical instruments built by Rajput king Sawai Jai Singh in 1738.

Continue to the **City Palace**, constructed by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh between 1729 and 1732. This vast complex covers about one-seventh of the old city and includes multiple courtyards, buildings, and gardens.

In the afternoon, stop by **Jal Mahal**, a beautiful palace situated in the middle of Man Sagar Lake, dating back to the 17th century. Then, visit the impressive **Amer Fort**, another UNESCO World Heritage Site and Jaipur's main attraction. Built in the late 16th century by Rajput rulers, this magnificent fort is crafted from pale yellow and pink sandstone and white marble and divided into four main sections, each with its own courtyard.

In the evening, head to **Nahargarh Fort** for a stunning panoramic view of Jaipur city from above.

#### DAY 8 JAIPUR - KATHMANDU (BY FLIGHT) [B/-/-]

We fly through Delhi to Kathmandu, the capital of Nepal, nestled amid the breathtaking Himalayan mountains. Upon arrival, a local representative will welcome you and escort you to your hotel in a private vehicle. After checking in, you can relax and enjoy the comforts of your accommodation. The rest of the day is free for you to rest or explore the nearby area at your own pace.

If you feel up to it, take a stroll through the lively streets of Thamel, a popular tourist area filled with shops, cafes, and cultural sites. This day marks the

start of your remarkable journey through Nepal's stunning landscapes and rich cultural heritage.

## DAY 9 KATHMANDU - SIGHTSEEING [B/L/-]

For lunch, enjoy a flavorful meal at a local restaurant, choosing between authentic **Nepali cuisine** or a selection of international dishes.

In the afternoon, visit the historic **Patan Durbar Square**, a **UNESCO World Heritage Site** renowned for its rich artistry and architecture. Wander through ancient temples, statues, and the former royal palace, and—if you're fortunate—receive a blessing from the **Kumari**, the living goddess revered as an embodiment of Durga.

Your final stop is the majestic **Boudhanath Stupa**, one of the world's largest Buddhist stupas. Here, you'll observe devotees spinning prayer wheels, chanting mantras, and walking clockwise around the sacred site. It's the perfect place to pause, reflect, and take in the serene energy.

## DAY 10

KATHMANDU - DAY TRIP TO BHAKTAPUR [B/-/D]

We then explore the stunning **Bhaktapur Durbar Square**, a **UNESCO World Heritage Site** known for its historic statues, temples, and architectural treasures. Our journey continues to **Kathmandu Durbar Square**, another UNESCO site and the city's cultural heart, where we discover ancient royal residences, a museum filled with historical artifacts, and the **House of the Kumari**, home to Nepal's living goddess.

Later, we hop into a **rickshaw for a ride through Thamel**, Kathmandu's bustling tourist district, filled with lively shops, cozy cafes, and traditional crafts. We end the day with a delicious dinner at a local restaurant.
