ITINERARY

DAY 1 DEPART FOR INDIA

Prepare yourself! You are leaving today for Delhi to start your unbelievable journey to India.

DAY 2 DELHI ARRIVAL

Welcome to Delhi, the vibrant capital of India where ancient history and modern life coexist seamlessly. Upon arrival at the international airport, you will be warmly welcomed by our representative, who will assist you with your luggage and escort you to your hotel in a comfortable private vehicle. **(Standard hotel check-in time is 3:00 PM.)**

After checking in, the remainder of the day is at leisure to relax after your journey. You may choose to unwind at the hotel or, if arriving early, step out to explore the nearby surroundings independently. Delhi offers a wide range of cafés, local markets, and neighbourhood streets that give a first glimpse into everyday Indian life.

Overnight in Delhi

DAY 3 DELHI SIGHTSEEING - OLD DELHI & ICONIC LANDMARKS [B/L/-]

After breakfast, meet your professional local guide and set out for a full-day exploration of Delhi, offering an immersive introduction to the city's historical, spiritual, and cultural essence.

Begin in Old Delhi with a visit to Jama Masjid, the largest mosque in India and a masterpiece of Mughal architecture. Walk through its vast courtyard while your guide explains its religious importance and the legacy of Emperor Shah Jahan.

Proceed to the magnificent Red Fort, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and a powerful symbol of India's Mughal past. Explore its impressive gateways, royal pavilions, and courtyards as stories of emperors, ceremonies, and colonial history unfold.

Enjoy lunch at a well-known local restaurant, where you will be introduced to authentic Delhi flavours.

In the afternoon, visit Gurudwara Bangla Sahib, one of the most revered Sikh places of worship. Experience its serene atmosphere and learn about the Sikh tradition of community service and equality, highlighted by the sacred Sarovar (holy water tank).

Later, immerse yourself in the lively streets of Old Delhi. Walk through narrow lanes filled with spice shops, centuries-old businesses, and bustling street life. Sample traditional Indian sweets and savoury snacks, followed by an exciting rickshaw ride through Chandni Chowk, including a pass-through Mutton Street, famous for its rich Mughlai Street food culture.

Overnight in Delhi

DAY 4 DELHI EXPLORATION - MODERN & CULTURAL HIGHLIGHTS [B/-/-]

After breakfast, continue discovering Delhi by exploring its modern landmarks and cultural heritage sites.

Start at India Gate, a solemn national monument dedicated to Indian soldiers who lost their lives during World War I. Enjoy a leisurely walk around the ceremonial boulevard.

Drive past the grand avenues of New Delhi, viewing Rashtrapati Bhavan and Parliament House, showcasing colonial-era architecture and political significance.

Visit Raj Ghat, the peaceful memorial marking the cremation site of Mahatma Gandhi, where silence and simplicity reflect his philosophy.

Continue to Humayun's Tomb, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and an architectural precursor to the Taj Mahal. Wander through its elegant gardens and admire its Persian-influenced design.

Conclude the day at Qutub Minar, a striking red sandstone minaret and an outstanding example of early Indo-Islamic architecture.

Overnight in Delhi

DAY 5 DELHI - AGRA (231 KM / APPROX. 4.5 HOURS) [B/L/-]

After breakfast, check out from your hotel and travel by road to Agra, a historic city that once served as the capital of the Mughal Empire.

Upon arrival in Agra, check in to your hotel and enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. Spend some time relaxing before heading out in the afternoon.

Later, visit Agra Fort, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and a grand fortress built by Emperor Akbar. Explore its palaces, audience halls, and courtyards while learning about the dramatic lives of Mughal emperors.

DAY 6

AGRA - JAIPUR (239 KM / APPROX. 5 HOURS)
[B/-/D]

Early in the morning, visit the iconic Taj Mahal, one of the Seven Wonders of the World. Built by Emperor Shah Jahan in memory of his beloved wife Mumtaz Mahal, the monument is best admired in the soft morning light, revealing its exquisite marble craftsmanship and symbolic beauty.

Return to the hotel for breakfast, then check out and begin your journey to Jaipur, the capital of Rajasthan.

En route, stop at Chand Baori, a remarkable 13-storey stepwell dating back over a thousand years, known for its geometric precision and historical water-harvesting system.

Arrive in Jaipur by afternoon and check in to your hotel. In the evening, enjoy a guided walking tour through Jaipur's colourful bazaars, known for handicrafts, jewellery, textiles, and traditional arts.

Dinner features authentic Rajasthani cuisine, including regional specialities such as dal baati churma.

Overnight in Jaipur

DAY 7

JAIPUR SIGHTSEEING [B/-/D]

After breakfast, set out to explore the royal heritage of

Jaipur, famously known as the Pink City.

Begin with Hawa Mahal, an architectural landmark designed to allow royal women to observe street life unseen. Continue to Jantar Mantar Jaipur, a UNESCO World Heritage Site featuring historic astronomical instruments.

Visit the City Palace Jaipur, still home to Jaipur's former royal family, and explore its museums, courtyards, and art collections.

In the afternoon, stop at Jal Mahal for photographs before continuing to Amer Fort, an impressive hilltop fortress showcasing Rajput and Mughal architectural styles.

In the evening, visit Nahargarh Fort for sweeping views of Jaipur at sunset. Enjoy dinner at a deluxe heritage restaurant such as 1135 AD.

Overnight in Jaipur

DAY 8

JAIPUR - DELHI - DEPARTURE [B/-/-]

Your memorable journey through India comes to a close today. After breakfast, enjoy some free time depending on your flight schedule. This is a wonderful opportunity to relax at your hotel or step out for some last-minute exploration of Jaipur at your own pace.
