ITINERARY

DAY 1 Depart USA/CANADA [-/-/-]

Get ready for the adventure of a lifetime as you fly to India, arriving in the vibrant capital city of Delhi—a captivating blend of ancient heritage, colorful culture, and contemporary charm.

DAY 2 ARRIVAL IN DELHI

Arrive at Indira Gandhi International Airport at any time, where our friendly representative will warmly greet you and transfer you to a comfortable hotel in the heart of the city. Spend the day at leisure, unwinding from your journey—lounging by the hotel pool, enjoy a spa treatment, or take a short stroll to nearby cafes in Connaught Place for a taste of Delhi's bustling vibe.

Overnight in Delhi

DAY 3 Delhi (ARTISTIC MARVELS AND HISTORIC TREASURES) [B/-/-]

After breakfast, Dive into Delhi's captivating history with a full day of iconic landmarks. Begin at the Red Fort (UNESCO World Heritage Site), a grand Mughal fortress with ornate palaces and tales of emperors—opt for an audio guide to uncover its secrets. Nearby, explore Jama Masjid, India's largest mosque, where you can climb the minaret for sweeping city views. After a flavorful lunch in Chandni Chowk, tasting street food like parathas, visit Qutub Minar (UNESCO site), a 12th-century towering minaret surrounded by ancient ruins that showcase Delhi's layered past. As evening falls, marvel at India Gate, a glowing war memorial, and stroll along Rajpath to admire the grandeur of government buildings.

Overnight in Delhi

DAY 4 DELHI (TEMPLES, TOMBS CULTURAL SPLENDOR) [B/-/-]

Following breakfast, your Delhi adventure continues with a blend of historical buildings and tranquil spiritual experiences. Start at Humayun's Tomb (UNESCO site), a magnificent Mughal mausoleum with lush gardens, often called the Taj Mahal's inspiration. Next, visit

Akshardham Temple, a sprawling masterpiece of carved stone showcasing India's cultural heritage—note that phones are restricted, so absorb every detail. After **lunch (Optional)**, head to Lotus Temple, a serene, flower-shaped architectural gem perfect for quiet reflection. Wrap up with an evening at Dilli Haat, a vibrant open-air market bursting with handicrafts, regional snacks, and live folk performances, ideal for souvenirs.

Overnight in Delhi

DAY 5 DELHI - AGRA (GATEWAY TO TAJ MAHAL) [B/-/-]

After a leisurely breakfast, embark on a scenic 3-4-hour drive (200 km) to Agra, the city of eternal love. Arrive by noon and check into your cozy hotel, then set out for Agra Fort (UNESCO site), a colossal red sandstone fortress with opulent palaces and distant glimpses of the Taj Mahal—don't miss the intricate Musamman Burj. Post- **lunch (Optional)**, discover Itimad-ud-Daulah's Tomb, nicknamed the "Baby Taj," famed for its delicate marble inlays and tranquil gardens. As the sun dips, visit Mehtab Bagh, a riverside garden offering breathtaking sunset views of the Taj Mahal across the Yamuna, perfect for photographers and romantics alike.

Overnight in Agra

DAY 6 AGRA - JAIPUR (TAJ MAHAL SUNRISE and PINK CITY ARRIVAL) [B/-/-]

Rise early for a bucket-list experience: a sunrise visit to the Taj Mahal (UNESCO site), where the marble monument shimmers in dawn's light—spend 2 hours exploring its symmetry and hearing the love story behind it, with fewer crowds for a magical moment. Later drive to Jaipur (240 km, 4-5 hours), stopping at Fatehpur Sikri (UNESCO site), a 16th-century Mughal ghost city with grand courtyards and the majestic Buland Darwaza. Arrive in Jaipur, Rajasthan's vibrant Pink City, by afternoon and settle into a heritage-style hotel. In the evening, visit the colorful Patrika Gate for stunning photos, then enjoy a Rajasthani feast at Chokhi Dhani, a cultural village with folk dances, puppet shows, and camel rides.

Overnight in Jaipur

DAY 7

JAIPUR - AJMER/PUSHKAR (SPIRITUAL HEART OF RAJASTHAN) [B/-/-]

After breakfast, drive 150 km (3 hours) to Ajmer and Pushkar, sacred gems of India. Start in Ajmer with the Ajmer Sharif Dargah, a revered Sufi shrine of Khwaja Moinuddin Chishti, where the serene ambiance and intricate arches draw pilgrims and travelers alike—experience the qawwali prayers if time aligns. After **lunch (Optional)**, head to Pushkar (15 km, 30 minutes) to visit Pushkar Lake, a holy site ringed by 52 ghats, ideal for a soulful walk. Explore the rare Brahma Temple, one of the world's few dedicated to this deity, and shop for silver jewelry and textiles in the lively Pushkar Bazaar. Check into a charming hotel in Pushkar and you'll feel the town's mystical serenity.

Overnight in Pushkar

DAY 8

PUSHKAR - JODHPUR (BLUE CITY FORST AND LOCAL BITES) [B/-/-]

Begin your day with breakfast, followed by a 200 km drive (roughly 4-5 hours) to Jodhpur, the captivating Blue City, reaching by early afternoon. Check into your hotel, then visit **Mehrangarh Fort**, one of India's most imposing fortresses, towering over the city—its museum displays royal artifacts, and the views of blue-painted houses are breathtaking. Next, stroll to **Jaswant Thada**, a serene marble cenotaph with intricate carvings and lake views, perfect for history lovers. In the evening, dive into the vibrant **Clock Tower Market** and **Sardar Market**, sampling local treats like makhaniya lassi and shopping for bandhani fabrics.

Overnight in Jodhpur

DAY 9

JODHPUR (PALACES AND CULTURAL CHARM) [B/-/-]

Today, you'll uncover more of Jodhpur's royal heritage with a morning visit to Umaid Bhawan Palace, a spectacular Art Deco landmark housing a museum, royal residence, and hotel—admire its vintage cars and manicured gardens. After **lunch (Optional)**, wander the blue-hued streets of Brahmpuri, capturing the essence of Jodhpur's unique aesthetic in photos. Then, head to Mandore Gardens (8 km away), a historic site

with ancient temples, royal cenotaphs, and quirky sculptures, offering a glimpse into Rajput glory. Return to the hotel.

Overnight in Jodhpur

DAY 10

JODHPUR TO UDAIPUR (TEMPLES AND LAKES AWAIT) [B/-/-]

After breakfast, set off for Udaipur (250 km, 5-6 hours), the romantic City of Lakes, with a captivating stop at Ranakpur Jain Temple (2.5 hours from Jodhpur). This 15th-century architectural wonder features 1,444 uniquely carved marble pillars, a must-see for art enthusiasts (dress modestly). Arrive in Udaipur by late afternoon and check into a hotel with views of shimmering lakes. Freshen up for a mesmerizing boat ride on Lake Pichola, gliding past Jag Mandir Island as the sun sets, casting golden hues over the City Palace.

Overnight in Udaipur

DAY 11

UDAIPUR (PALACES AND GARDENS) [B/-/-]

Begin your day with breakfast and experience Udaipur's royal splendor with a full day of iconic sights. Begin at City Palace, a sprawling complex of palaces, courtyards, and museums overlooking Lake Pichola—its crystal gallery and Durbar Hall are showstoppers. Next, visit Jagdish Temple, a 17th-century shrine with intricate carvings, just a short walk away. After **lunch (Optional)**, stroll through Saheliyon-ki-Bari, a charming garden with fountains and lotus pools, built for royal maidens. End your day at Bagore ki Haveli, where a sunset cultural show of Rajasthani dance and music brings the region's traditions to life.

Overnight in Udaipur

DAY 12

UDAIPUR (HILLTOPS AND CULTURAL TREASURES) [B/-/-]

Your final day in Udaipur blends scenic beauty with cultural immersion. Start with a morning drive to Monsoon Palace (Sajjangarh), a hilltop retreat offering sweeping views of Udaipur's lakes and Aravalli hills—perfect for panoramic photos (weather permitting). Return to the city to explore Bhartiya Lok Kala Mandal, a museum celebrating Rajasthani folk art, puppets, and costumes, ideal for cultural enthusiasts. After **lunch (Optional)**, visit Hathi Pol Bazaar,

shopping for handicrafts, or relax at Fateh Sagar Lake, watching locals enjoy paddle boats.

Overnight in Udaipur

After breakfast at the hotel, today you will be transferred to Udaipur Airport to catch your flight to Delhi. Upon arrival in Delhi, you will proceed to board your onward flight back home.
