DAY 1 DEPART FOR CROATIA [-/-/-]

Prepare yourself! You are leaving today for Lima to start your CROATIA TOUR - from Dubrovnik to Zagreb!

DAY 2 DUBROVNIK ARRIVAL [B/-/-]

Greetings in the charming city of Dubrovnik, Croatia! DAY 3 DUBROVNIK CITY TOUR [B/-/-]

After enjoying your morning meal, you embark on a guided exploration of Dubrovnik, led by a knowledgeable expert who will introduce you to the city's primary attractions.

Dubrovnik, recognized as one of the Mediterranean's most splendid medieval cities, has earned a place on UNESCO's World Cultural Heritage List due to its impeccably preserved Gothic, Renaissance, and Baroque churches, monasteries, palaces, and fountains. Your walking expedition through the Old City commences at Pile Gate and encompasses a stroll along its graceful main thoroughfare, featuring prominent landmarks such as Onofrio's Fountains, Sponza Palace, Orlando's Column, City Bell Tower, and the Church of St. Blaise, the city's revered patron saint, among others. As part of the tour, you'll have the opportunity to explore the interiors of the Franciscan Monastery and the Rector's Palace.

Subsequent to the tour, you'll return to your hotel, with the remainder of the day available for your leisure and relaxation.

DAY 4 DUBROVNIK - DAY FREE AT LEISURE [B/-/-]

You have a free day in Dubrovnik to spend as you please. You can explore the city on your own or take part in any of the optional excursions. You could also relax at your hotel, stroll along the Old Town, enjoy a seaside café, or try some local cuisine. Alternately, pre-book one of the suggested tours, such as Mostar & Kravica Waterfall or Montenegro including Kotor & Perast. Whatever you choose, make the most of your free day and enjoy your time in Dubrovnik!

Optional Tour 1 - Day trip to Mostar & Kravica Waterfall including lunch

Commence your journey in Dubrovnik and savor a drive of under two hours in the company of your English-speaking chauffeur. Traverse the picturesque roads of Croatia and venture across the border into Bosnia and Herzegovina. Your initial destination is the Kravica Falls, a hidden gem of Bosnia and Herzegovina. These cascades, shaped by the Trebizat River, form a serene backdrop for swimming and leisurely picnics during the summer months. Subsequently, proceed to your next point of interest, the city of Mostar. Meander through the winding cobblestone alleys of the historic town and stand in awe of the Old Bridge that spans the Neretva River. Lunch in Mostar. Lastly, make a visit to the medieval town of Počitelj before returning to Dubrovnik.

Optional Tour 2 - Day trip to Montenegro including lunch - visit of Perast and Kotor

Embark on a day trip from Dubrovnik to discover the charms of Montenegro. Relish leisurely hours in the picturesque towns of Kotor & Perast and partake in a scenic ferry voyage across the Boka Kotorska Bay. Setting off from Dubrovnik in the morning, take in the sights of the Old Town and its environs as you traverse through the stunning Župa Dubrovačka and the Konavle region. Upon crossing the Montenegro border, your journey continues along the scenic Montenegro coastline. En route through the Boka Kotorska Bay, make a pause in the enchanting town of Perast. You'll

have the option to visit the island of Our Lady of the Rocks. During your drive, your guide will share intriguing details about Montenegro's significant cultural landmarks, as well as the country's rich history and captivating legends. Upon reaching Kotor, revel in free time for self-guided exploration. Kotor is renowned for its maritime heritage, illustrious commercial fleet, and formidable city walls. Lunch in Kotor. Free time after the visit.

DAY 5 DUBROVNIK - SPLIT - ZADAR [B/L/-]

Following your morning breakfast, you complete your hotel check-out process. Meet your driver and embark on a tranquil and picturesque journey up the Dalmatian coast towards northern Croatia. En route to Zadar, you make a stop in Split, where you'll be guided on a 2-hour walking tour by a skilled local guide. This immersive tour grants you access to the historic 1,700-year-old Diocletian Palace, allows you to explore the Cathedral of St. Duje, also known as Saint Domnius, and unveils the wonders of the Temple of Jupiter, considered one of the most captivating cultural treasures along the Adriatic shoreline. Your journey through history also includes a visit to the ancient cellars, a glimpse of the Peristyle at the heart of the palace, Roman temples, the renowned Golden Gate, and the monumental statue of Grgur Ninski. Lunch in Split.

Upon concluding the tour, you'll be transferred to Zadar. Upon arrival, you'll complete your hotel check-in, and the remainder of the day is yours to enjoy as you please. Relax and savor the breathtaking vistas of the Croatian shoreline as you travel from Dubrovnik to Zadar.

Overnight in Zadar

DAY 6 ZADAR [B/-/-]

After your morning breakfast, you rendezvous with your guide to commence a 2-hour walking tour through the city of Zadar.

Zadar stands at the core of the Croatian Adriatic, boasting a wealth of tourist attractions. Throughout its history, Zadar served as the residence of the Illyrian Liburni for many centuries and was the capital of Dalmatia for a millennium. On this tour, you'll discover

landmarks such as St. Anastasia's Cathedral, the Sea Organ, and the Greeting to the Sun (please note that the tour does not include interior visits to these sites). Following the tour, the remainder of the day is yours to enjoy at your leisure.

Overnight in Zadar

DAY 7 ZADAR - PLITVICE - RASTOKE - ZAGREB [B/L/-]

After your morning meal, you wrap up your hotel check-out and rendezvous with your personal chauffeur, who will convey you to Zagreb. On the way, you'll have the opportunity to explore the captivating Plitvice Lakes National Park. These lakes, often referred to as the "Falling Lakes," secured their spot on the UNESCO World Heritage Sites list back in 1979, marking them as one of the earliest natural sites globally to receive this prestigious recognition. This provides an exceptional chance to immerse yourself in the breathtaking beauty of the shapes and colors found within Croatia's oldest national park. Your visit encompasses admission tickets and a guided tour within the park. Following your time in the Plitvice Lakes, you'll head to the riverside town of Karlovac and the historic watermill village of Rastoke, granting you a sense of these smaller, ancient communities. Lunch in Plitvice / Slunja area.

You'll then continue your journey to Zagreb and proceed with your hotel check-in. The rest of the evening is yours to relish at your own pace.

Overnight in Zagreb

DAY 8 ZAGREB [B/-/-]

Following your breakfast, relish a guided tour of Zagreb. Zagreb is a city characterized by verdant parks and exquisite architecture. Throughout the tour, you'll explore the Upper Town, which encompasses the former Gradec and Kaptol, constituting the city's oldest districts that merged historically into a single town that expanded further to the south. Once the tour concludes, you'll make your way back to the hotel, where you'll have the remainder of the evening to enjoy at your own pace.
