## DAY 1 Depart USA/CANADA [-/-/-]

## DAY 4 DELHI - TEMPLES, BAZAARAS AND LOCAL CULTURE [B/-/-]

Today is a delightful blend of spirituality, architecture, and everyday life. Visit the Bahai Lotus Temple, followed by the intricately designed Akshardham Temple complex. After **(Optional) lunch** head to Dilli Haat—a vibrant open-air market showcasing crafts and foods from across India. The evening can be spent at leisure, or you may choose to participate in a **(Optional) cooking demonstration** and **(Optional) dinner** with a local family, offering a glimpse into Indian domestic life.

## DAY 5 DELHI - (2-HOUR BY FLIGHT) KOLKATA & COLONIAL LANDMARKS [B/-/-]

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for a morning flight to Kolkata. Upon arrival, check in to your hotel and relax. In the afternoon, begin discovering Kolkata's colonial legacy with a visit to the majestic Victoria Memorial and a walk around the Maidan area. As the sun sets, enjoy a traditional Bengali **(Optional) dinner** at a classic restaurant, introducing you to the flavors of eastern India.

## DAY 6 KOLKATA - HERITAGE WALK AND ICONIC FIGURES [B/-/-]

## DAY 8 KOLKATA - CHENNAI (2.5-HOUR BY FLIGHT) [B/-/-]

This morning, fly to Chennai, where upon arrival, you'll check-in to the hotel and enjoy some downtime. In the late afternoon, take a walk along Marina Beach and

visit the nearby San Thome Basilica, believed to house the remains of St. Thomas the Apostle. In the evening, if available, attend a Bharatanatyam dance performance or Carnatic music recital, for an introduction to classical South Indian art forms.

DAY 9

#### CHENNAI – TEMPLES AND SOUTH INDIAN CULTURE [B/-/-]

Begin the day in the Mylapore district with a visit to the ornately carved Kapaleeshwarar Temple. A walking tour through the surrounding lanes provides insight into the spiritual and daily life of the neighborhood. In the afternoon, visit DakshinaChitra, a living museum that showcases South Indian homes, arts, and traditions. The evening is perfect for a relaxed seafood **(Optional) dinner** by the beach or on a rooftop overlooking the city lights.

DAY 10

#### CHENNAI – DAY EXCURSION TO MAHABALIPURAM [B/-/-]

Today you'll enjoy a full-day guided excursion to Mahabalipuram, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Discover ancient rock-cut temples, including the iconic Shore Temple, Arjuna's Penance, and the Five Rathas. You'll also have time to relax by the sea or enjoy a seafood **(Optional) lunch** before returning to Chennai in the evening free to relax at the hotel or go for a shopping for silk sarees and jewelry at Local Bazaar.

DAY 11

#### CHENNAI – MUMBAI (2-HOUR BY FLIGHT) – GATEWAY TO THE WEST [B/-/-]

After a morning flight to Mumbai, check in and unwind. Later in the day, visit the Gateway of India, a prominent landmark overlooking the Arabian Sea. Stroll through the nearby Colaba and Kala Ghoda neighborhoods—full of art galleries, boutiques, and heritage cafés. Cap the evening with **(Optional) dinner** at a popular seafood restaurant or one of the city's historic dining spots.

#### MUMBAI – CITY HIGHLIGHTS [B/-/-]
