OVERVIEW

Beginning in Rome with a private airport transfer, the tour opens with a full-day excursion to the Vatican Museums, Sistine Chapel and St Peter's Basilica, followed the next day by a guided tour of Ancient Rome before travelling by high-speed train to Naples. Guests then enjoy free time to relax and explore Naples and its surroundings at their own pace, before continuing by high-speed train to Florence, cradle of the Renaissance. A full-day excursion into the Tuscan countryside visits the medieval hill towns of Siena and San Gimignano, rounding out the Florence stay. From Florence, the group travels by high-speed train to Venice, arriving by private water taxi and enjoying an evening gondola ride through the city's historic canals, with a further free day to explore Venice independently before departing from Venice airport by private water-taxi transfer. Throughout the tour, private coach transfers, portorage and licensed local guides ensure a smooth and comfortable journey between each destination, while the free days in Naples, Florence and Venice give guests the flexibility to explore at their own pace.

ITINERARY

DAY 1 DEPART FOR ITALY

Your Italian adventure starts today! Depart for Rome and get ready to discover the history, beauty and charm of Italy.

DAY 2 ROME - ARRIVAL [-/-/-]

On arrival at Rome Fiumicino Airport, an English-speaking local assistant welcomes the group (available for up to 2 hours) before a private coach transfer to the hotel. With the rest of the day at leisure, guests can begin settling into Rome and exploring the historic streets and piazzas near the hotel at their own pace. It's a gentle first taste of the Eternal City — perhaps a short stroll to a nearby piazza, an espresso at a local café, or simply resting after the journey before the sightseeing begins in earnest the following day.

DAY 3 THE VATICAN [B/-/-]

Partake in a wonderful breakfast buffet at the hotel. Enjoy a full-day excursion to the Vatican, with a full-day private coach hire and a 6-hour licensed English-speaking guide (one guide per 20 participants), includes admission to the Vatican Museums, the Sistine Chapel and St Peter's Basilica. The morning is spent moving through the Museums' vast galleries of classical sculpture — among them the Laocoön and the Belvedere Torso — as well as tapestries, ancient maps in the Gallery of Maps, and the Raphael Rooms, where frescoes such as The School of Athens showcase High Renaissance painting at its peak. The guide then leads the group into the Sistine Chapel, famed for Michelangelo's ceiling depicting the Creation of Adam and his monumental Last Judgment fresco on the altar wall, before continuing into St Peter's Basilica, the largest church in Christendom and the heart of Vatican City. Inside, the guide points out highlights such as Michelangelo's Pietà, Bernini's bronze baldachin over the high altar, and the dome designed by Michelangelo himself, which visitors can admire from below. With guiding hours extending across the full day, there is

time to take in the scale of St Peter's Square and Bernini's sweeping colonnades before returning to the hotel, with the evening free to enjoy Rome's restaurants and trattorias.

DAY 4 ROME TO NAPLES [B/-/-]

Savor a delicious morning breakfast at the hotel. A morning 3-hour guided tour of Ancient Rome with a licensed English-speaking guide and private coach hire takes in the city's most iconic landmarks from the outside, including the Colosseum, the Roman Forum and the Palatine Hill (exterior viewing only; admission is not included). The guide brings this open-air museum to life, standing before the Colosseum's towering arches and the nearby Arch of Constantine while explaining how gladiatorial contests once drew crowds of tens of thousands, before tracing the ceremonial heart of ancient government along the Via Sacra through the Roman Forum, once the political, religious and commercial centre of the empire. From vantage points around the Palatine Hill — traditionally regarded as the birthplace of Rome and home to the palaces of the emperors — there are sweeping views back over the Forum and towards the Circus Maximus. Afterwards, a private coach transfer brings the group to Rome Termini Station to board the 2nd class high-speed train to Naples Central Station, a journey of a little over an hour through the Italian countryside. On arrival, a further private coach transfer takes the group to the hotel in Naples, the lively bayfront city beneath Mount Vesuvius, with the remainder of the afternoon free to settle in and explore the neighbourhood around the hotel.

DAY 5 NAPLES, AT LEISURE [B/-/-]

Delight in a fresh breakfast buffet to start your day. A free day to relax in Naples or explore independently. Guests may wander the historic centre, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, with its baroque churches, bustling piazzas and the famous Spaccanapoli street cutting straight through the old town, or stroll the bayfront

promenade for views across to Mount Vesuvius and the islands of the Gulf of Naples. Naples is also known for its cuisine — this is the birthplace of pizza, and a relaxed lunch or dinner at a local pizzeria is a fitting way to spend part of the day.

DAY 6 NAPLES, AT LEISURE [B/-/-]

Indulge in a hearty breakfast spread before heading out. A further free day to relax and explore Naples at your own pace. With two consecutive free days, guests have the flexibility to revisit favourite spots from the day before, explore at a slower pace, or use the time to rest ahead of the excursions still to come. The hotel's central location makes it easy to reach the waterfront, local markets and cafés on foot.

DAY 7 NAPLES TO FLORENCE [B/-/-]

Appreciate a freshly prepared morning breakfast buffet. Private coach transfer from the hotel to Naples Central Railway Station to board the 2nd class high-speed train to Florence Santa Maria Novella Railway Station, a scenic journey north through the Italian countryside of around three hours. On arrival, a private coach transfer takes the group to the hotel in the heart of Renaissance Florence, with the remainder of the day free to get settled and take a first look at the city — perhaps a walk towards the Duomo or along the banks of the River Arno before dinner.

DAY 8 FLORENCE, AT LEISURE [B/-/-]

Enjoy a satisfying breakfast at the hotel restaurant. A free day in Florence to explore the city at your own pace. The historic centre, itself a UNESCO World Heritage Site, rewards unhurried wandering — from the red-domed Duomo and Giotto's bell tower to the shop-lined Ponte Vecchio spanning the Arno and the bustling stalls of the San Lorenzo market. Guests may also choose to browse Florence's leather workshops and boutiques, relax in the Boboli Gardens, or simply enjoy a coffee in one of the historic piazzas at their own pace.

DAY 9 SIENA AND SAN GIMIGNANO [B/-/-]

Relish an energizing breakfast before your Tuscan countryside adventure. A full-day excursion into the heart of Tuscany, with full-day private coach hire, includes a 2-hour private walking tour in Siena with a local licensed guide. The walk winds through the city's steep medieval streets and past the striped marble facade of its Gothic cathedral, ending in the shell-shaped Piazza del Campo — the sloping square that twice a year hosts the famous Palio horse race and is overlooked by the slender Torre del Mangia. The guide also shares the story of Siena's historic contrade, the seventeen city districts whose rivalry still shapes local life today. The group then continues to a local farmhouse for a wine tasting and lunch featuring regional Tuscan products such as local cheeses, cured meats and olive oil, enjoyed amid the rolling hills and vineyards of the Chianti countryside. The day concludes with a further 2-hour private walking tour in the walled hill town of San Gimignano, nicknamed the 'Medieval Manhattan' for its skyline of towering stone towers built by rival noble families in the Middle Ages. A local licensed guide leads the way through its narrow lanes and small piazzas, with views opening out over the surrounding Tuscan countryside, before the return drive to Florence.

DAY 10 FLORENCE TO VENICE [B/-/-]

Partake in a relaxing morning breakfast buffet. Private coach transfer from the hotel to Florence Santa Maria Novella Railway Station to board the 2nd class high-speed train to Venice Santa Lucia Railway Station, arriving directly into the heart of the lagoon city. On arrival, a taxi-boat transfer takes the group across the water to a dock close to the hotel, with luggage transferred separately (1 bag pp) — a fitting introduction to a city with no roads or cars, only canals and footbridges. In the evening, experience Venice from the water on a traditional 35-minute gondola ride (4 passengers per gondola), gliding past centuries-old palazzos along the quieter back canals as the city lights come on.

DAY 11 VENICE, AT LEISURE [B/-/-]

Indulge in breakfast at the hotel before spending a leisurely day discovering Venice independently. A free day to explore Venice independently. Guests may wander the narrow calli and quiet canals away from the main tourist routes, browse the shops and market stalls around the Rialto Bridge, or simply sit and take in the atmosphere of St Mark's Square with its café orchestras and pigeons. For those who wish to venture further, the vaporetto water-bus network makes it easy to reach the colourful island of Burano or the glass-making

island of Murano, right on the hotel's doorstep, at your own pace.

DAY 12 VENICE, DEPARTURE [B/-/-]

Conclude the journey with breakfast at the hotel before transferring to Venice Airport for the departure flight.

A private taxi-boat transfer takes the group from the dock close to the hotel to Venice Airport for the departure flight, with luggage transferred separately (1 bag pp), bringing a fitting close to the journey with one last glimpse of Venice from the water before departure.
