DAY 1 Depart USA/CANADA

DAY 2 ARRIVAL IN SÃO PAULO

Overnight in São Paulo

DAY 3 SÃO PAULO CITY SIGHTSEEING [B/-/-]

Overnight in Iguazu

DAY 5 IGUAZU FALLS - ARGENTINE SIDE [B/-/-]

Today, you'll explore the Argentine side of Iguazu Falls, one of the world's most spectacular natural wonders. A guided tour takes you through Iguazu National Park, where you'll walk along well-maintained trails to witness the falls' thundering cascades, including the iconic Devil's Throat. The tour includes stops at various viewpoints, offering breathtaking perspectives of the 275 waterfalls that make up this UNESCO World Heritage Site.
