ITINERARY

DAY 1 USA/CANADA - VIENNA [-/-/-]

Prepare yourself! You are leaving today for Austria to begin an unforgettable festive journey through imperial cities, Alpine landscapes and magical Christmas markets.

DAY 2 ARRIVAL IN VIENNA (-/-/-)

Welcome to the Austria! Arrive in Vienna, Austria's imperial capital. Meet and greet on arrival followed by transfer to your hotel. (Standard check-in time is 3:00 pm). Our local representative will assist you with a smooth check-in.

Check-in at the hotel and catch up on your rest. You can unwind or tour the city throughout the remaining part of the day.

Overnight in Vienna

DAY 3 VIENNA SIGHTSEEING (B/-/D)

After breakfast at your hotel, set out on a guided discovery of Vienna, Austria's refined capital and a city synonymous with imperial grandeur, art, and classical music. Begin with a panoramic drive along the famous Ringstrasse, a grand boulevard that encircles the historic old town. DAY 4 VIENNA - SALZBURG (B/-/-)
