DAY 3

Nairobi [B/-/-]

Following your breakfast, begin your day by visiting the Giraffe Center, the African Fund for Endangered Wildlife's main base, renowned for 'Daisy Rothschild.' Engage in an unforgettable experience meeting giraffes eye to eye, offering a genuine feel for the immense size of these graceful creatures. Explore the education center, delving into extensive information about the breeding and conservation efforts focused on Kenya's rarest giraffe species. Gain insights into their behaviors, characteristics, and conservation practices while enjoying an up-close encounter from a raised observation platform.

Next on the itinerary is a visit to the Beads Factory, a pottery establishment renowned for crafting some of the world's most exquisite beads. Witness the entire bead-making process from its inception to the final product. What makes this factory distinctive is its employment of single mothers from underprivileged neighborhoods, providing them with an opportunity to earn a livelihood and support their families. This pottery, ceramic, and bead factory exclusively employs single mothers, creating beautiful gifts and souvenirs

that are now exported globally. Explore their collection at the gift shop.

Subsequently, embark on a drive to the former colonial residence of Danish author Karen Blixen, now transformed into a museum. This property, set amidst the picturesque Ngong Hills, gained fame through the book and subsequent film 'Out of Africa.' It's a must-visit for Danes and enthusiasts of African history and romance.

Anticipate returning to your hotel by approximately 3 to 4 pm, granting you leisure time for the remainder of the evening. Spend the night in Nairobi.

DAY 4

Nairobi - Samburu Game Reserve [B/L/D]

Embark on your journey in a custom-built 4x4 safari vehicle, heading northward to Samburu Game Reserve located in the Northern Frontier District. Along the way, indulge in a delightful barbecue fish meal beneath the Sacred Fig Tree at Trout Tree Restaurant in Nanyuki. In the afternoon, engage in a thrilling game drive within the Samburu Game Reserve. As evening falls, enjoy dinner and spend the night at the lodge positioned overlooking the mighty Ewaso Nyiro River. The name Ewaso Nyiro originates from the local community, translating to "the river of brown or muddy water." In the arid northern reaches of Kenya, water signifies life, and the presence of this river attracts abundant wildlife to its banks, forming a lush green oasis. Nestled amidst a rugged landscape along the banks of the Ewaso Nyiro River, Ashnil Samburu is surrounded by doum palms and other native trees, offering stunning natural vistas. Situated south of the river in Buffalo Springs Game Reserve, the camp provides unparalleled access to superb game viewing opportunities. Buffalo Springs derives its name from a clear water oasis and is distinct from Samburu Reserve due to its flatter, less densely vegetated terrain.

DAY 5

Samburu Game Reserve [B/L/D]

Accompanied by your safari guide, delight in game drives across the vast expanse of Samburu Game Reserve. Samburu is renowned for its abundant elephant herds, while also offering frequent sightings of other unique wildlife species within this untamed wilderness. The region is inhabited by the Samburu tribe, pastoral relatives of the Maasai, adding cultural depth to the landscape. Characterized by rugged and dramatic terrain against a backdrop of volcanic mountains, stark hills, and sparse, withered scrub trees, the scenery is striking. The Ewaso Nyiro River serves as the lifeblood of the area, flowing along the southern boundary to separate Samburu Game Reserve from Buffalo Springs Reserve. This river is a focal point of interest for both visitors and wildlife alike. In the dry season, the river becomes vital as many animals rely on it to quench their thirst. Elephants, using their tusks, dig deep into the dry river beds to access precious water. This water source creates a verdant oasis, attracting a multitude of wildlife to its banks. Crocodiles and hippos share the river with small herds of elephants, indulging in bathing and playful activities in the muddy waters during the heat of the day before returning to graze on the lush vegetation of the riverine forest later on

Overnight in Samburu

DAY 6

Samburu Game Reserve - Great Rift Valley (Lake Nakuru) [B/L/D]

Start your day with an early breakfast before embarking on a scenic drive into the Great Rift Valley. You'll reach your Lodge in time for lunch, situated within Lake Nakuru National Park. This exquisite game lodge is perched atop Lion Hill, providing stunning vistas of the iconic flamingo pink-rimmed Lake Nakuru. Its strategic location offers sweeping panoramas of both the lake and the picturesque national park. The lodge's layout is designed to maximize these breathtaking views, ensuring that most rooms and sitting areas provide guests with captivating scenery. Spend the afternoon on a thrilling game drive within Lake Nakuru National Park, renowned globally for its vast flocks of flamingos and a diverse array of over 400 bird species, including both migratory and indigenous varieties. Lake Nakuru, a soda lake nestled on the floor of the Rift Valley, is often home to millions of flamingos, creating a mesmerizing spectacle as the lake takes on a pink hue from a distance. Additionally, the lake has gained international recognition as a crucial sanctuary for endangered wildlife species, notably the rare Rothschild giraffe and black and white rhinos. Other residents of the park include tree-climbing lions, zebras, gazelles, waterbucks, buffaloes, and baboons, adding to the park's rich biodiversity.

DAY 7

Lake Nakuru - Masai Mara [B/L/D]

After enjoying breakfast and admiring the breathtaking vistas of the Great Rift Valley, set off towards the Maasai Mara Game Reserve, renowned as the most celebrated wildlife sanctuary and Kenya's premier game reserve. The Maasai Mara boasts the highest concentration of wildlife globally, housing the iconic "Big 5" and hosting the awe-inspiring seventh wonder of the world, The Great Wildebeest Migration. Following lunch, embark on an afternoon game drive in the Mara, renowned for its breathtaking scenery of vast open plains intersected by the Mara River and its tributaries, adorned with marshes and forests. Situated in the Great Rift Valley, this world-renowned reserve primarily features open grasslands and is esteemed as the crown jewel of Kenya's wildlife viewing destinations. Nowhere else in Africa is wildlife more abundant. ensuring visitors rarely miss encountering the "Big 5" (buffalo, elephant, leopard, lion, and rhinoceros)...

DAY 8

Masai Mara [B/L/D]

Embark on a full-day game drive in the Maasai Mara, complete with a picnic lunch. The Maasai Mara stands as Kenya's most renowned safari destination, boasting a rich diversity of wildlife with over 450 species recorded. Here, sightings of lions, rhinos, hippos, crocodiles, giraffes, wildebeests, zebras, buffaloes, warthogs, hyenas, jackals, wild dogs, leopards, various antelope species, and elephants are common. Explore the Mara River, a pivotal site where thousands of wildebeests and zebras brave attacks by crocodiles while crossing during the annual "Great Migration" between Tanzania and Kenya. This migration ranks among the natural world's most awe-inspiring

phenomena. Each year, nearly two million wildebeests, accompanied by large numbers of zebras, Grant's gazelles, Thompson's gazelles, elands, and impalas, journey from the Serengeti to the Maasai Mara and back in search of fresh grazing. Following closely are the savannah's predators: lions, cheetahs, wild dogs, jackals, hyenas, and vultures. The migration typically occurs from July to late October, involving over 1.5 million animals. Witnessing these vast herds in motion is an unforgettable experience, often rated as one of the most spectacular natural events.

DAY 9

Masai Mara - Nairobi Departure [B/-/-]

Early in the morning, experience the breathtaking sunrise over the expansive plains of the Maasai Mara as you depart from the lodge and begin a morning game drive. This presents a final opportunity to witness lions, cheetahs, or leopards hunting in the early hours of the day before dawn. The Mara's wildlife diversity, variety, and abundance are truly enchanting and astonishing. Following breakfast, return to Nairobi, arriving in the afternoon. You will be either dropped off at your Nairobi hotel or at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) for your departure flight.
