ITINERARY

DAY 1 USA/CANADA - JOHANNESBURG

Get ready! Today you'll depart for Johannesburg, marking the beginning of your unforgettable Journey Through South Africa and Victoria Falls.

DAY 2 JOHANNESBURG - ARRIVAL [-/-/-]

Welcome to South Africa! Upon your arrival at **O.R. Tambo International Airport** in Johannesburg, you'll be met by a local representative holding a personalized name board. After a warm greeting, you'll be assisted with your private transfer to the hotel.

Johannesburg, known as the **"City of Gold,"** is a lively blend of modern skyscrapers, leafy suburbs, and rich history. Depending on your arrival time, the remainder of the day is free to rest after your long flight or to explore the nearby surroundings. You might stroll through **Nelson Mandela Square** or enjoy dinner at one of Sandton's upscale restaurants.

Overnight in Johannesburg

DAY 3 DISCOVERING JOHANNESBURG AND SOWETO [B/-/-]

After a hearty breakfast, set out on a guided full-day exploration of Johannesburg and the neighboring township of Soweto, a journey into the heart of South Africa's history and resilience.

Begin at Constitution Hill, an inspiring museum complex built on the site of a former prison where political leaders, including Nelson Mandela and Mahatma Gandhi, were once held. The exhibits and architecture vividly tell the story of South Africa's road to democracy.

From there, continue to Soweto (South Western Townships)—a vibrant community and a living testament to the spirit of struggle and triumph. Pass through bustling streets lined with colorful houses, children playing, and vendors selling traditional food. Visit Vilakazi Street, the only street in the world that was once home to two Nobel Peace Prize laureates—Nelson Mandela and Archbishop Desmond

Tutu.

At the Hector Pieterse Memorial, pause to reflect on the 1976 student uprisings that changed the course of South African history. Learn about the courage and sacrifice of young people who fought for freedom and equality.

Enjoy a traditional lunch at a local Soweto restaurant (optional), where you can savor local favorites like pap, chakalaka, and grilled meats. Engage with locals to gain authentic insight into township life.

In the afternoon, return to central Johannesburg, where your guide may drive through the city's modern business districts, art hubs, and historic neighborhoods before dropping you off at your hotel. The evening is at leisure.

Overnight in Johannesburg

DAY 4 JOHANNESBURG TO VICTORIA FALLS (ZIMBABWE) BY FLIGHT [B/-/-]

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your short international flight to **Victoria Falls**, one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World. On arrival, a representative will greet you and assist with your transfer to your hotel, located near the falls.

The afternoon is at leisure to relax and soak up the tranquil ambiance of this charming town. You might choose to unwind by the pool, visit local markets, or embark on an **optional sunset cruise on the Zambezi River**. Watching the sun dip below the horizon while hippos and crocodiles lounge nearby is an unforgettable introduction to the magic of Zimbabwe.

Enjoy the evening at your own pace, perhaps dining at the hotel's restaurant or sampling local cuisine at a nearby venue.

Overnight in Victoria Falls

DAY 5 GUIDED VICTORIA FALLS TOUR [B/-/-]

After breakfast, set out on a **guided walking tour of Victoria Falls**, known locally as *Mosi-oa-Tunya* — "The

Smoke That Thunders.” Your expert guide will lead you along well-marked rainforest trails that reveal spectacular viewpoints of the falls. Feel the mist on your face as you witness the sheer power of the Zambezi River plunging into the gorge below.

This relaxed tour includes multiple vantage points — such as the Main Falls, Horseshoe Falls, and Rainbow Falls — allowing ample time for photography and quiet reflection. Learn about the region’s geology, flora, fauna, and the legend of the falls’ discovery by David Livingstone.

The afternoon is free for optional activities. Choose from a **helicopter flight over the falls**, a **visit to a local village**, **bungee jumping**, or a **river safari**. Return to your hotel to enjoy the evening at leisure, perhaps with dinner overlooking the river.

Overnight in Victoria Falls

DAY 6

VICTORIA FALLS TO KRUGER NATIONAL PARK
(VIA JOHANNESBURG) [B/-/D]

After breakfast, bid farewell to Victoria Falls and transfer to the airport for your flight back to **Johannesburg**, where you’ll connect onward to the **Kruger National Park** region.

Upon arrival, you’ll be greeted and transferred to your safari lodge, located within or near the park. After check-in, take a moment to freshen up before heading out on your **first evening game drive** in an open 4x4 vehicle. Guided by professional rangers, you’ll explore the vast wilderness as the sun sets, searching for Africa’s “Big Five” and other nocturnal wildlife emerging for the night.

Return to your lodge for a delicious dinner served under the stars in a traditional **boma** setting. Fall asleep to the sounds of the African bush — distant roars, rustling trees, and the calls of night birds.

Overnight in Kruger Area

DAY 7

SAFARI EXPERIENCE IN KRUGER NATIONAL
PARK [B/L/D]

Awake before dawn for coffee or tea before your early **morning game drive**. The first light of day reveals a landscape teeming with life — elephants moving gracefully through the trees, antelope grazing, and

perhaps a lion pride resting after a night’s hunt.

Return to the lodge for a hearty breakfast and leisure time. Relax by the pool, enjoy a nature walk with your ranger, or simply unwind on your veranda listening to the calls of the bush.

After lunch, depart for your **afternoon game drive**, when the softer light and cooler air bring many animals back into view. Stop for sundowners in the wild before returning to the lodge for dinner, conversation, and stargazing.

Overnight in Kruger Area

DAY 8

KRUGER NATIONAL PARK TO CAPE TOWN [B/-/-]

After a final early morning safari and breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight to **Cape Town**. Upon arrival, you’ll be welcomed and transferred to your hotel, ideally located near the **Victoria & Alfred Waterfront**.

The rest of the day is free to relax or begin exploring. Take a leisurely walk along the waterfront, browse shops and galleries, or enjoy dinner overlooking the harbor with Table Mountain as your backdrop.

Overnight in Cape Town

DAY 9

EXPLORE THE CAPE PENINSULA [B/-/-]

After breakfast, embark on a full-day scenic excursion around the **Cape Peninsula**. Travel along the dramatic **Chapman’s Peak Drive**, one of the world’s most breathtaking coastal routes, offering countless photo opportunities.

Enter the **Cape Point Nature Reserve**, where rugged cliffs, windswept landscapes, and endemic fynbos meet the sea. Ride the **funicular** to the lighthouse at Cape Point, then continue to the **Cape of Good Hope**, a legendary maritime landmark.

In the afternoon, visit **Boulders Beach**, home to a charming colony of African Penguins. Watch them waddle along the sand and swim in the turquoise waters. Return to Cape Town via Simon’s Town and Kalk Bay, two picturesque seaside villages.

Overnight in Cape Town

DAY 10 THE CAPE WINELANDS EXPERIENCE [B/-/-]

After breakfast, travel to the **Cape Winelands**, an idyllic region of rolling vineyards and historic estates. Visit **Stellenbosch**, known for its Cape Dutch architecture and lively atmosphere, and **Franschhoek**, famed for its gourmet cuisine and French heritage.

Enjoy guided **wine tastings** at select estates, learning about the region's varietals and winemaking traditions. Between tastings, take time to stroll through the charming towns, browse art galleries, or indulge in an optional fine dining lunch.

Return to Cape Town in the late afternoon, with the evening at leisure.

Overnight in Cape Town

DAY 11 TABLE MOUNTAIN AND CITY EXPLORATION [B/-/-]

After breakfast, weather permitting, ascend **Table Mountain** by cable car to enjoy sweeping views of the city, coastline, and Robben Island. Walk along the summit's trails before descending for a relaxed **city tour**.

Highlights include the **Company's Garden**, **St. George's Cathedral**, and the colorful **Bo-Kaap** district, famous for its Cape Malay culture and pastel houses. Explore **Greenmarket Square**, where local artisans sell crafts and souvenirs.

The afternoon and evening are yours to explore further or enjoy a farewell dinner overlooking the Atlantic Ocean.

Overnight in Cape Town

DAY 12 CAPE TOWN - USA/CANADA [B/-/-]

After breakfast, transfer to **Cape Town International Airport** for your onward flight. Reflect on your incredible journey — from the thundering power of Victoria Falls to the wild beauty of Kruger and the coastal charm of Cape Town — a once-in-a-lifetime adventure filled with unforgettable memories.
