DAY 2

Toronto - Niagara Falls sightseeing [B/-/-]

Embark on your Niagara Falls excursion with convenient pickup from downtown Toronto before heading to the majestic falls.

Your first destination is Skylon Tower, where you'll ascend 520 feet in a glass elevator to the observation area. From here, you'll marvel at panoramic views of all three Niagara Falls—Bridal Veil Falls, Horseshoe Falls, and the American Falls—as well as the Niagara River and even catch a glimpse of the Toronto skyline.

Next, delve into the immersive experience of Journey Behind the Falls, descending 125 feet to explore cavelike tunnels behind the roaring cascades. Feel the power of the falls as you hear and sense their thunderous presence, and capture stunning photos from two observation decks.

Following this, board the Niagara City Cruises Voyage To The Falls Boat Tour (seasonal, operating April - November only, replaced with admission to Niagara's Fury and Butterfly Conservatory in the winter months) for an up-close encounter with the falls. Sail around the Niagara gorge, feeling the refreshing mist while clad in a provided recyclable rain poncho.

After the boat tour, enjoy a narrated driving tour of Niagara, learning about its rich history and unique geography. Your guide will highlight points of interest such as Dufferin Islands, the International Control Dam, the Old Scow, Whirlpool Rapids, and the Floral Clock.

Finally, enjoy an hour of free time to explore the city independently, whether it's grabbing a snack, snapping extra photos, or picking up souvenirs. At the conclusion of your tour, your guide will escort you back to downtown Toronto.

DAY 3

Toronto Sightseeing [B/-/-]

Then, delve into another beloved Toronto institution, the St. Lawrence Market, acclaimed as the world's top food market by National Geographic. Here, you'll have some free time to shop or grab a quick bite to eat.
