DAY 1 Toronto - Niagara Falls [-/-/-]

Sail around the Niagara Gorge, getting up close to the Falls and feeling the refreshing mist on your skin. Rest assured, recyclable rain ponchos will be provided for your comfort.

Concluding your tour, your guide will lead you on a narrated driving tour of the city, sharing insights into Niagara's rich history and unique geography. Highlights include visits to the Dufferin Islands, the International Control Dam, the Old Scow, Whirlpool Rapids, and the Floral Clock. Your tour wraps up with drop-off at your hotel. Spend rest of the day at free at leisure.
