ITINERARY

DAY 1 DEPART - USA/CANADA

Prepare yourself! You are leaving today for Windhoek to start your unbelievable Deserts of Namibia Journey.

DAY 2 WINDHOEK - ARRIVAL [-/-/D]

Upon arrival at Hosea Kutako International Airport, a guide welcomes you and transfers you to your accommodation in Windhoek, Namibia's vibrant capital. The afternoon is spent settling in and exploring the city's charm at a relaxed pace. A visit to the Christuskirche, a historic German Lutheran church, offers insight into the country's colonial past, followed by a stroll through the lively city center to absorb the local culture. The evening concludes with a welcome dinner at a local restaurant, featuring Namibian cuisine.

Overnight in Windhoek

DAY 3 WINDHOEK - NAMIB DESERT [B/L/D]

After breakfast, depart early for a scenic drive south to the Namib Desert, one of the world's oldest deserts. The journey takes you through stunning landscapes, with a stop at a local rest camp for lunch. Arrive at your desert lodge by mid-afternoon, allowing time to relax and enjoy the serene surroundings. A guided nature walk introduces you to the desert's unique flora and fauna, setting the stage for an unforgettable experience. Dinner is served at the lodge under a star-filled sky.

Overnight in Namib Desert

DAY 4 NAMIB DESERT [B/L/D]

Start the day with breakfast at the lodge, followed by a morning visit to Sossusvlei, where you explore the iconic red dunes and the stark beauty of Deadvlei, a clay pan dotted with ancient acacia trees. The gentle pace allows ample time to take in the surreal landscape and capture photographs. Return to the lodge for lunch and a relaxing afternoon, perhaps enjoying the pool or a quiet moment watching the desert sunset. Dinner is at the lodge.

Overnight in Namib Desert

DAY 5 NAMIB DESERT - SWAKOPMUND [B/L/D]

Following breakfast, embark on a picturesque drive to Swakopmund, a coastal town with a distinct German colonial influence. The route passes through dramatic landscapes, including the Kuiseb Canyon, with a stop for a light lunch en route. Arrive in Swakopmund by afternoon and take a leisurely walk along the palm-lined promenade or explore the town's quaint architecture. Dinner is at a seaside restaurant, offering fresh seafood and local flavors.

DAY 6 SWAKOPMUND [B/L/D]

After breakfast, spend the morning exploring the Skeleton Coast, a rugged stretch of coastline known for its haunting beauty. A guided tour highlights the area's unique ecosystem and history, including a visit to a seal colony at Cape Cross. DAY 7 SWAKOPMUND - DAMARALAND [B/L/D]

Stop for lunch at a rustic lodge along the way, enjoying views of the dramatic landscapes. DAY 8 DAMARALAND [B/L/D]

After breakfast, embark on a morning exploration of Damaraland's highlights, including the ancient rock engravings at Twyfelfontein, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The guided tour offers insights into the region's cultural and natural history, with plenty of time to appreciate the surroundings. Return to the camp for lunch and a relaxing afternoon, perhaps reading or enjoying the tranquil environment. Dinner is at the camp.

Overnight in Damaraland

DAY 9

DAMARALAND - ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK [B/L/D]

Following breakfast, set out for Etosha National Park, one of Africa's premier wildlife destinations. The drive includes a stop for lunch at a local lodge, with opportunities to spot wildlife along the way. Arrive at your Etosha lodge by afternoon and settle in before an evening game drive, where you may see elephants, lions, or rhinos gathering at a waterhole. Dinner is at the lodge, surrounded by the sounds of the bush.

Overnight in Etosha

DAY 10

ETHOSHA NATIONAL PARK [B/L/D]

Start the day with breakfast, followed by a full-day

game drive in Etosha National Park. The leisurely pace allows for extended wildlife viewing at various waterholes, where animals like zebras, giraffes, and antelopes congregate. A picnic lunch is enjoyed in the park, surrounded by the vast savanna. Return to the lodge in the late afternoon, with time to relax before dinner.

Overnight in Etosha

DAY 11

ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK [B/L/D]

After breakfast, enjoy another morning game drive in Etosha, focusing on different areas of the park to maximize wildlife sightings. The relaxed schedule ensures ample time to observe animals in their natural habitat. Return to the lodge for lunch and spend the afternoon at leisure, perhaps visiting the lodge's own waterhole to watch animals. A farewell dinner celebrates the journey with local dishes.

Overnight in Etosha

DAY 12

ETOSHA - WINDHOEK (DEPARTURE) - USA/CANADA [B/L/-]

After a final breakfast, depart Etosha for the drive back to Windhoek. A boxed lunch is provided en route. Arrive at Hosea Kutako International Airport in the afternoon for your onward flight.
