ITINERARY

DAY 1 Depart USA/CANADA [-/-/-]

Get ready for the adventure of a lifetime as you explore India, from the bustling streets of Delhi to majestic forts, thrilling wildlife safaris in Ranthambore, serene landscapes, and the colorful traditions of Rajasthan.

DAY 2 ARRIVAL IN DELHI

Arrive at Indira Gandhi International Airport at any time, where our friendly representative will warmly greet you and transfer to your hotel. Spend the day at leisure to unwind, recover from your journey, or casually explore nearby areas like a local cafe or market at your own pace.

DAY 3 DELHI SIGHTSEEING - OLD DELHI & ICONIC LANDMARKS [B/-/-]

After breakfast, immerse yourself in Delhi's rich tapestry with a visit to the UNESCO-listed Qutub Minar, a 12th-century minaret, followed by the stunning Mughal-era Humayun's Tomb, also a UNESCO site, then head to Old Delhi to explore the grand Jama Masjid, wander the vibrant Chandni Chowk for street food like parathas, and tour the majestic Red Fort, another UNESCO gem, wrapping up with an optional stop at Dilli Haat for handicrafts before returning to your hotel for the night.

DAY 4 DELHI EXPLORATION - MODERN & CULTURAL HIGHLIGHTS [B/-/-]

After breakfast, discover Delhi's spiritual and modern side by visiting the sprawling Akshardham Temple with its intricate carvings, the serene Lotus Temple shaped like a lotus flower, the iconic India Gate for a quick photo stop, and Raj Ghat, Mahatma Gandhi's tranquil memorial, followed by a scenic drive past Rashtrapati Bhavan in Lutyens' Delhi, ending the day with a rooftop **dinner (optional)** at Parikrama in Connaught Place for city views before resting at your hotel.

DAY 5 DELHI - AGRA [B/-/-]

Today you'll travel from Delhi to Agra (3-4 hours by car via Yamuna Expressway or 2 hours by Gatimaan Express train), check into your hotel, and visit the iconic Taj Mahal, a UNESCO marvel best seen at sunset, followed by Agra Fort, another UNESCO-listed Mughal stronghold, then browse Sadar Bazaar for marble souvenirs and enjoy Mughlai cuisine like kebabs or biryani for **dinner (optional)**, staying overnight in Agra.

DAY 6 AGRA - RAMATHRA [B/-/-]

After breakfast, leave behind the marble majesty of Agra and journey into the heart of rural Rajasthan, traveling to Ramathra (approximately 3-4 hours by car, 150 km approx), where the ancient Ramathra Fort rises like a sentinel over the rolling Daang Plateau. Check into this heritage stronghold or a nearby hotel, its weathered stone walls whispering tales of a bygone era, and step out to breathe in the crisp air as the serene Kalisil Lake glimmers below, fringed by mustard fields and grazing cattle. Wander through the quiet village, where mud-brick homes and the chatter of locals offer a glimpse into timeless traditions, then savor a hearty Rajasthani meal.

Overnight in Ramathra

DAY 7 RAMATHRA - RANTHAMBORE [B/-/-]

In the morning after breakfast, you'll travel from Ramathra to Ranthambore (3-4 hours by car, 140 km approx.), check into a hotel near Ranthambore National Park, and take an afternoon safari (**if pre-booked**) through the wild grasslands, spotting tigers and deer amid ancient fort ruins, then settle in for the night.

DAY 8 RANTHAMBORE SIGHTSEEING [B/-/-]

Today, enjoy a morning safari in Ranthambore National Park, tracking tigers and peacocks in the dawn light, then climb to the 10th-century Ranthambore Fort for stunning jungle views, before relaxing at your hotel or browsing Sawai Madhopur's craft shops for the night.

DAY 9 RANTHAMBORE - JAIPUR [B/-/-]

After breakfast, check out of your hotel and travel to Jaipur. You'll reach the Pink City by afternoon. Check-in to your hotel upon reaching, and later, embark on a guided evening stroll through the bustling Pink City market. Renowned as a shopper's haven, Jaipur's vibrant bazaars invite you to pause and browse, with shimmering rows of stalls displaying handcrafted bangles and ornate trinkets. As you weave through the lively markets, soak in the rich, spirited essence of the region's culture.

DAY 10 JAIPUR SIGHTSEEING [B/-/-]

Enjoy breakfast before heading out to discover Jaipur's top sights. Begin with Hawa Mahal, the "Palace of Winds," a striking facade designed as a tall screen for royal women to secretly watch street celebrations. Next, explore Jantar Mantar, a UNESCO World Heritage Site featuring nineteen ingenious astronomical instruments crafted by Rajput king Sawai Jai Singh, finished in 1738 CE. Then, step into the City Palace, constructed between 1729 and 1732 by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh, a sprawling complex that once spanned a seventh of the old city. Later, pause at Jal Mahal, a 17th-century palace floating gracefully in Man Sagar Lake. Continue to the majestic Amer Fort (or Amber Fort), another UNESCO gem, built in the late 16th century by Rajput rulers using pale yellow and pink sandstone paired with white marble, boasting a vast palace layout split into four unique courtyard sections. As evening falls, ascend to Nahargarh Fort for a stunning panoramic view of Jaipur's twinkling expanse, then return to your hotel for a comfortable overnight stay in Jaipur.

DAY 11 JAIPUR - DELHI [B/-/-]

Today, you'll travel back to Delhi from Jaipur (4-5 hours by Road). After arriving at Delhi check-in to your hotel and, if time allows, unwind with a visit to Khan Market for its trendy shops and eateries, before settling in for your final night.

Overnight in Delhi

DAY 12 DELHI - DEPARTURE

Enjoy your breakfast at the hotel and later you'll be transferred to the Delhi International Airport for your return journey back home.
