# ITINERARY

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## DAY 1 VANCOUVER ARRIVAL [-/-/D]

Land at Vancouver International Airport, meet your representative and enjoy a comfortable transfer into the city. Check-in time is mid-afternoon, so you have a few quiet hours to settle in, adjust to the time zone and take a first stroll along the lively seawall. In the early evening everyone gathers for a relaxed welcome dinner overlooking Coal Harbour, a perfect chance to meet fellow travellers while watching floatplanes glide in for the night.

## DAY 2 PANORAMIC VANCOUVER CITY EXPLORATION [B/-/-]

After a leisurely breakfast, begin your guided introduction to Vancouver—a city celebrated for its dramatic setting between mountains and sea. Your narrated coach tour winds through the city's most distinctive neighbourhoods: cobblestoned **Gastown**, where the famous steam clock keeps time amid Victorian charm; bustling **Chinatown**, alive with heritage shops and traditional apothecaries; and the restored brick warehouses of **Yaletown**, now home to chic cafés and galleries. Cross to **Granville Island**, where artisans, buskers, and food stalls fill the Public Market with colour and flavour. Later, stroll beneath the towering cedars of **Stanley Park**, pausing for photos at the iconic **First Nations totem poles** and along the scenic seawall. Return to your hotel early in the afternoon with the rest of the day free—perhaps rent a bicycle, explore Robson Street boutiques, or relax on a sunny patio with a view of the harbour.

## DAY 3 NORTH SHORE RAINFOREST & CAPILANO ADVENTURE [B/-/-]

A relaxed morning departure takes you across the **Lions Gate Bridge** to Vancouver's green heart—the North Shore. Step into the temperate rainforest at **Capilano Suspension Bridge Park**, where moss-draped evergreens tower overhead and sunlight filters through the mist. Test your nerve on the gently

swaying bridge above the canyon, then follow the **Treetops Adventure**, a network of elevated walkways suspended among 1,500-year-old Douglas firs. Learn about Indigenous history and local ecology from interpretive displays before returning downtown mid-afternoon. Spend the rest of the day as you please: perhaps browse Gastown's designer boutiques, unwind in a café, or enjoy the ocean breeze along the waterfront promenade.

## DAY 4 CRUISING VANCOUVER HARBOUR & CULTURAL CORNERS [B/-/-]

This morning, embark on a **narrated harbour cruise**, gliding through **Burrard Inlet** for an exceptional perspective of Vancouver's skyline. Pass **Canada Place's** white sails, the working container port, and Stanley Park's wooded peninsula while watching floatplanes take off against a backdrop of mountains. Back on shore, return to **Granville Island**, where artists' studios, glassblowers, and gourmet stalls invite unhurried exploration. Savour lunch at your leisure and soak in the lively waterfront atmosphere. The evening is yours—perhaps dine at a seafood restaurant overlooking **English Bay**, or sip cocktails while the sun sets over the Pacific.

## DAY 5 TIME AT LEISURE & FAREWELL GATHERING [B/-/-]

Your final day is free to follow your own rhythm. Sleep late, rent a bike to circle the seawall, or visit the **Museum of Anthropology** to admire world-class Indigenous art. For a taste of local life, stop by a café in **Mount Pleasant** or browse the boutiques of **Main Street**. As evening falls, rejoin your group for a **farewell dinner** featuring the flavours of the Pacific Northwest—wild salmon, local produce, and BC wines. Share memories of mountain views, ocean breezes, and the friendly spirit of Vancouver as city lights shimmer across the harbour.

## DAY 6 DEPARTURE - VANCOUVER
