Later, venture to the Orchid Nursery, where you'll be mesmerized by a breathtaking collection of over 50 different varieties of exotic and vibrant orchids, blooming throughout the year.

In the final leg of your excursion, you'll return to Chiang Mai and embark on a pilgrimage to one of the city's most sacred sites: Wat Phrathat Doi Suthep. This revered temple, dating back to 1383, sits atop a mountain 3,500 feet above sea level, just 16 kilometers from the city center. Behold the magnificent golden pagoda, which enshrines the holy relics of Lord Buddha and serves as a beacon for Buddhist pilgrims from around the globe. From the summit of Doi Suthep, you'll be treated to a breathtaking panoramic vista of Chiang Mai City and the picturesque Ping River valley.

To reach Wat Phrathat Doi Suthep, you'll ascend a steep staircase adorned with colossal mythical Nagas, symbolizing the journey of humanity towards enlightenment. For those who prefer an alternative, an elevator is available for convenience.

Evening relax at the hotel.

#### DAY 7

Chiang Mai - Full Day trip from Chiang Mai to White Temple, Wat Rong Seua Ten, and Baan Dam Museum [B/L/-]

at the Bay May coconut forest. Arrive to the restaurant, you will learn how to make 4 Vietnamese signature dishes. Start from grinding your own rice milk to cutting fresh vegetables, making special sauces, stir frying beefs and tasting broth. You will learn to make the 4 most iconic dishes of Vietnamese cuisine: Banh Xeo (Hoi An's famous pancake with traditional dipping sauce). Bun Bo: Noodles with sautéed beef, topped with peanuts & beef jus vinaigrette. Goi Cuon: Pork and Shrimp spring roll with peanut dipping sauce. Pho Bo: Iconic Northern beef noodle soup, infused with bones & spices. You also have a chance to learn grind fresh rice milk with an ancient Vietnamese stone mill. Lunch at our local house with dishes you have made. In the afternoon, transfer to a local handicraft village for a lantern-making class. Here, you'll learn the traditional techniques of crafting colorful silk lanterns - a proud symbol of Hoi An's culture. Enjoy hands-on experience as you design and decorate your own lantern to take home as a lovely keepsake. When dusk falls, head to Hoi An Ancient Town to admire the shimmering beauty of the lantern-lit streets. Then, enjoy a short bamboo boat ride on the Hoai River and release your own flower lantern (one lantern per person), wishing for peace and good luck.

DAY 10

Hoi An - Cu Lao Cham Island including Lunch (shared tour). Evening Cultural show [B/L/-]

After completing the boarding procedures, embark on a scenic boat trip to begin your island exploration. Visit the Marine Protected Area and historical sites such as the Ancient Well, Hai Tang Pagoda, Au Thuyen, and Tan Hiep Market. Explore the traditional craft cooperatives making Ngu Dong hammocks and Banh It La Gai cakes, browse dried seafood stalls, and shop for local souvenirs. Continue by boat to one of the beautiful beaches (Bai Chong or Bai Ong). Here, guests can snorkel to admire colorful coral reefs and discover the diverse marine life beneath the ocean surface. Afterwards, return to the freshwater area for relaxation and leisure. Enjoy a delightful lunch in a peaceful seaside setting, take a walk to admire the scenery, swim, and bask under the sun. Finally, board the boat back to the mainland. Arrive at Cua Dai Port, say goodbye our local team then we head to Hoi An Ancient Town again. Here, stroll through the charming streets and discover iconic spots such as the Japanese Covered

Bridge, Tan Ky Old House, Phuc Kien Assembly Hall, and the colorful lantern-lined alleys along the Thu Bon River. Afterwards, you'll have some free time to explore on your own after the guided visit or simply back to hotel for a rest.

In the evening, we will come to Hoi An Impression Theme Park to experience cultural activities and catch the grand spectacle of Hoi An Memories Show. Travel back 400 years in time and discover the history of this idyllic seaside town in five acts of awe-inspiring storytelling.

Uluwatu Temple is a Balinese sea temple in Bali. Built in the 11th century, it is one of nine directional temples mlemopuyeaant to protect Bali from evil spirits. It is located in Pecatu village, Kuta South District of Badung Regency of Bali. Even more remarkable than the temple itself is its location, perched on a steep cliff 70 metres above the roaring Indian ocean waves. There are more steep headlands on either side and sunsets over Uluwatu are a sight to behold. The temple is inhabited by large numbers of monkeys, They are believed to guard the temple from bad influences. Kecak Dance : Kecak and Fire Dance performance always become the favorite dance to watch in the evening, the perfect location make this dance more famous. The dance taking story from Ramayana is Hindu epic, is held in open air stage near the uluwatu temple. Is unique dance due to the sound of gamelan is not using the normal gamelan but use their mouth. The dancers with some group make sounds "cak", is like akapela but more interesting. Some humor put in the story make the dance more enjoyable to watch. Dinner at Hotel.
