In Banff, ascend Sulphur Mountain via gondola for panoramic views and relax in the historic Fairmont Banff Springs Hotel. Conclude your journey with a scenic drive to Edmonton for your departure.

ITINERARY

DAY 1 VANCOUVER - ARRIVAL

Upon arrival in Vancouver, you will be met at the airport and transferred to your hotel. As flight times may vary, the remainder of the day is left free for rest and personal time. You can choose to relax at the hotel or take a gentle walk nearby to stretch your legs after the journey. If energy permits, you may explore the immediate downtown area or enjoy a quiet dinner at a nearby restaurant before settling in for the night.

DAY 2 VANCOUVER CITY TOUR [B / - / -]

Begin your adventure with a guided city tour showcasing the highlights of Vancouver. Visit Stanley Park, one of North America's largest urban parks, where you'll admire the famous First Nations totem poles and scenic views of the city and mountains. Continue through the historic Gastown district, home to the charming steam clock and cobblestone streets, before exploring bustling Chinatown and the colourful shops and eateries it offers. Later, head to Granville Island — a lively hub of art galleries, food stalls, and local crafts — where you can sample delicious treats at the public market. In the afternoon, enjoy free time to shop along Robson Street, relax by the waterfront, or visit the Vancouver Lookout for sweeping views of the city.

DAY 3 FREE DAY IN VANCOUVER [B / - / -]

Enjoy a leisurely day to explore Vancouver at your own pace. For nature lovers, a visit to Capilano Suspension Bridge Park offers thrilling treetop walks among towering evergreens, while Grouse Mountain provides panoramic views of the city and Pacific Ocean. Art enthusiasts can visit the Vancouver Art Gallery or the Museum of Anthropology at UBC to admire Indigenous and contemporary collections. Alternatively, take a stroll along the seawall, visit Queen Elizabeth Park's beautiful gardens, or unwind with coffee in one of the city's trendy neighbourhoods like Yaletown or Kitsilano.

In the evening, consider dining at a waterfront restaurant in Coal Harbour or enjoying the lively ambiance of Gastown's historic pubs.

DAY 4 VANCOUVER TO BANFF (FLIGHT + TRANSFER) [B / - / -]

After breakfast, transfer to Vancouver Airport for your flight to Calgary. Upon arrival, meet your driver for a scenic drive into Banff National Park — Canada's oldest and most iconic park. The journey from Calgary to Banff offers breathtaking views as you ascend from Alberta's open plains into the majestic peaks of the Rockies. Stop briefly for photos of the dramatic landscapes along the Bow Valley before arriving in the picturesque mountain town of Banff. Check into your hotel and take some time to relax or wander along Banff Avenue, lined with boutique shops, cafés, and local art galleries. In the evening, enjoy a cozy dinner surrounded by alpine scenery or take a peaceful walk along the Bow River.

DAY 5 BANFF SIGHTSEEING TOUR [B / - / -]

Embark on a guided sightseeing tour of Banff's natural and cultural highlights. Visit Bow Falls, where glacial waters cascade into the Bow River, and enjoy a photo stop at Surprise Corner, famous for its postcard-perfect view of the Fairmont Banff Springs Hotel. Continue to the Hoodoos viewpoint to see fascinating rock formations shaped by centuries of erosion. Learn about the park's wildlife, geology, and rich history as your guide shares local insights. Later, you may choose to ride the Banff Gondola to the top of Sulphur Mountain (optional, at your own expense) for spectacular panoramic views. Spend the afternoon at leisure — shop for souvenirs, relax at the Banff Upper Hot Springs, or enjoy a walk through the scenic trails surrounding town.

DAY 6**BANFF TO JASPER VIA ICEFIELDS PARKWAY [B / - / -]**

Today's drive along the Icefields Parkway is one of the most breathtaking journeys in the world. Travel through soaring mountain passes, turquoise glacial lakes, and vast valleys dotted with waterfalls. Stop to admire Bow Lake and Peyto Lake, whose dazzling blue colours are shaped by glacial rock flour. Visit the Columbia Icefield area, where you can gaze upon the immense Athabasca Glacier and take photos of the surrounding peaks. Along the way, watch for wildlife such as elk, mountain goats, and black bears often seen near the roadside. As you approach Jasper, the scenery softens into wide valleys and serene forests, offering a sense of tranquillity. Upon arrival, check into your hotel and enjoy a relaxed evening in the heart of Jasper National Park.

DAY 7**JASPER NATIONAL PARK TOUR [B / - / -]**

Spend the day exploring Jasper National Park's unspoiled natural beauty. Visit Pyramid Lake, where calm waters reflect the surrounding peaks, and explore Maligne Canyon, one of the deepest river gorges in the Rockies, with bridges and viewpoints overlooking roaring waterfalls. Continue to Medicine Lake, known for its mysterious disappearing waters, and learn about the park's fascinating geology and ecosystems. Your guide will share stories of local wildlife and conservation efforts that help preserve this UNESCO World Heritage Site. Enjoy free time in the afternoon to stroll around Jasper's charming townsite, browse its boutique shops, or relax in the peaceful mountain setting. As evening falls, you may step outside to witness one of the clearest night skies in North America — Jasper is designated as a Dark Sky Preserve, perfect for stargazing.

DAY 8**JASPER TO EDMONTON - DEPARTURE [B / - / -]**

After breakfast, depart Jasper and travel eastward through scenic landscapes toward Edmonton or the nearest airport for your flight home. Your unforgettable Canadian Rockies adventure concludes here.
