ITINERARY

DAY 1 DEPART USA/CANADA [-/-/-]

Your adventure begins today as you depart for Johannesburg to commence your Icons of Africa Journey.

DAY 2 Nairobi Arrival [-/-/-]

Welcome to Kenya! Upon arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Nairobi, you will be met and transferred to your hotel. Please note that the usual check-in time is 3:00 PM, so you can take some time to settle in and rest. The remainder of the day is free for you to relax after your international flight or take a stroll nearby.

DAY 3 NAIROBI TO MASAI MARA [B/L/D]

After breakfast at your Nairobi hotel, embark on a scenic journey to the legendary Masai Mara National Reserve, one of Africa's most celebrated wildlife destinations. If you are traveling by road, the drive will take you through the spectacular Great Rift Valley, offering breathtaking views and the opportunity to stop for photographs along the escarpment. Alternatively, a short flight will whisk you directly into the heart of the Mara, where vast savannahs stretch to the horizon.

Upon arrival, check in at your safari lodge or luxury tented camp and enjoy a freshly prepared lunch. After some time to relax and settle in, set out on your first thrilling afternoon game drive across the rolling grasslands. The Masai Mara teems with wildlife — from prides of lions lounging in the shade to graceful gazelles, towering giraffes, and herds of elephants moving silently through the plains.

As the sun sets in golden hues, return to your lodge for dinner and a restful evening surrounded by the sounds of the African wilderness.

Overnight in Masai Mara National Reserve

DAY 4 SAFARI DAY IN MASAI MARA [B/L/D]

Start the day with an early morning game drive when the light is soft and wildlife is most active. This is often the best time to witness predators hunting or elephants gathering at watering holes. After an exhilarating morning, return to the lodge for a full breakfast followed by some leisure time — perhaps a swim, a massage, or simply soaking in the panoramic views from your veranda.

Enjoy lunch at the lodge before heading out for your afternoon game drive, covering new territories of the reserve. Your experienced guide will share fascinating insights about the Masai ecosystem, animal behavior, and the culture of the local Maasai people.

As the day fades, pause for a traditional sundowner in the bush before returning to camp for dinner under the stars.

Overnight in Masai Mara National Reserve

DAY 5 MASAI MARA TO VICTORIA FALLS (ZIMBABWE) BY FLIGHT [B/-/-]

After an early breakfast, depart the Masai Mara for your return journey to Nairobi. From there, board your connecting flight to Victoria Falls, with a brief stopover in Johannesburg, South Africa.

Upon arrival in Zimbabwe, a friendly representative will greet you and transfer you to your elegant Victoria Falls hotel or lodge, located within close proximity to the falls themselves. The rest of the day is free for you to unwind after your travels — relax by the pool, enjoy a drink overlooking the Zambezi River, or take an optional sunset cruise where you might spot hippos, crocodiles, and elephants along the riverbanks.

In the evening, you could choose to dine at one of the local restaurants offering traditional African cuisine and live music.

Overnight in Victoria Falls

DAY 6 GUIDED VICTORIA FALLS TOUR [B/-/-]

After breakfast, embark on a guided walking tour of Victoria Falls, known locally as Mosi-oa-Tunya — “The

Smoke That Thunders.” Accompanied by your guide, explore the network of rainforest trails leading to a series of spectacular viewpoints offering breathtaking panoramas of the mighty falls. Feel the refreshing mist on your face as you admire one of the largest waterfalls in the world cascading into the deep Batoka Gorge.

Your guide will share the fascinating history of the falls, its geology, and cultural importance to the local people. This is also a perfect opportunity for photography enthusiasts to capture rainbows and dramatic water plumes.

After the tour, return to your hotel and spend the afternoon at leisure. You might choose an optional activity such as a helicopter flight over the falls, a local craft market visit, or simply relax and enjoy the amenities of your lodge.

Overnight in Victoria Falls

DAY 7 VICTORIA FALLS TO CAPE TOWN (SOUTH AFRICA) BY FLIGHT [B/-/-]

After breakfast, transfer to Victoria Falls Airport for your flight to Cape Town, South Africa’s coastal gem known for its vibrant culture and stunning natural beauty. Upon arrival, you will be met by your driver and transferred to your centrally located hotel.

The rest of the day is yours to explore at leisure. You might stroll along the Victoria & Alfred Waterfront, a lively area filled with shops, restaurants, and street performers, or enjoy a quiet dinner while watching boats drift by in the harbor. For those interested, optional evening excursions such as a sunset cruise on Table Bay or a wine-tasting dinner can be arranged.

Overnight in Cape Town

DAY 8 CAPE PENINSULA SCENIC TOUR [B/-/-]

Enjoy breakfast before departing on a full-day guided tour of the Cape Peninsula, a route considered one of the most scenic drives in the world. Travel along the Atlantic Seaboard, passing the exclusive suburbs of Clifton and Camps Bay with their white-sand beaches backed by the Twelve Apostles mountain range.

Continue through Hout Bay, where you may take an

optional boat ride to Seal Island, home to thousands of Cape fur seals. Drive along the spectacular Chapman’s Peak Drive, carved dramatically into the mountainside, to reach the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve — the southwesternmost point of the African continent.

Ascend by funicular to Cape Point Lighthouse for panoramic views where the Atlantic and Indian Oceans are said to meet. On your return journey, visit Boulders Beach to observe the charming colony of endangered African penguins up close before returning to your hotel in the evening.

Overnight in Cape Town

DAY 9 DISCOVER THE CAPE WINELANDS [B/-/-]

After breakfast, set off on a relaxing journey to the picturesque Cape Winelands, a region renowned for its scenic landscapes, world-class wines, and charming colonial architecture. Your route will take you through rolling vineyards framed by dramatic mountain ranges.

Visit several prestigious wine estates in Stellenbosch, Franschhoek, or Paarl, where you can sample award-winning wines and learn about South Africa’s winemaking traditions. Enjoy leisurely strolls through vineyard gardens, visit historic cellar doors, and admire the blend of Dutch and French architectural influences.

You may also opt for a gourmet lunch at a wine estate, complemented by panoramic vineyard views. Return to Cape Town in the late afternoon, with time to relax or explore local restaurants in the city.

Overnight in Cape Town

DAY 10 TABLE MOUNTAIN & CITY HIGHLIGHTS [B/-/-]

Start your day with a trip to the iconic Table Mountain, one of the New Seven Wonders of Nature. Take the revolving cable car to the summit for breathtaking 360-degree views of Cape Town, Robben Island, and the Cape Peninsula. Enjoy time at the top to walk along designated trails, take photos, or relax at the café overlooking the city.

Descend and continue your exploration with a guided city tour, visiting landmarks such as the historic Company’s Garden, the colorful Bo-Kaap neighborhood

known for its cobbled streets and pastel houses, and Greenmarket Square, a vibrant spot for local crafts and souvenirs. Learn about the city's fascinating history, from colonial influences to modern multiculturalism.

The afternoon is free for shopping, relaxing, or enjoying a leisurely waterfront dinner to celebrate your last evening in South Africa.

Overnight in Cape Town

DAY 11

DEPARTURE - CAPE TOWN - USA/CANADA [B/-]

Enjoy your final breakfast at the hotel. Depending on your flight schedule, you may have some free time to explore Cape Town one last time — perhaps a morning walk along the Sea Point Promenade or some last-minute souvenir shopping at the V&A Waterfront.
