DAY 1 Depart USA/CANADA [-/-/-]

Prepare yourself! You are leaving today for Indonesia to start your ultimate Bali adventure.

DAY 2 Bali Arrival [-/-/-]

Upon arrival in Bali, claim your bags and proceed toward the arrival hall. Our representative will meet you and assist you with your transfer to the hotel in Ubud. (Standard check-in time is 3:00 pm).

Check-in at the hotel and catch up on your rest. Ubud is a town located in the upland region of Bali, Indonesia. Known as the cultural and artistic heart of the island, Ubud offers a serene and picturesque setting surrounded by lush rice paddies, verdant forests, and scenic river valleys. It has gained popularity as a destination for those seeking a more relaxed and spiritual experience in Bali.

You can unwind for the remaining part of the day.

Overnight in Ubud

DAY 3 Ubud (Day free at leisure) [B/-/-]

Enjoy breakfast and have your day free at leisure in Ubud, you have the opportunity to explore the town at your own pace and immerse yourself in its unique atmosphere or pre-book one of our suggested add-ons -

Add-on: ATV Quad Biking Adventure including lunch - USD Per person

Explore this tropical paradise as you discover its varied landscapes, lush rice paddies, overgrown jungles, and rushing rivers on an ATV Quad bike adventure. Experience a convenient pickup at your accommodation by your English-speaking guide and head to the starting point in Ubud. You will be given a thorough safety briefing and all the equipment needed for a safe journey. Choose to either ride in tandem with a companion or drive your own ATV. Be treated to the spectacular sight of Bali's natural beauty as you move through and around the extensive track. If you're up for a bit more thrill, just let your guide know, and they'll

take you to a more technical terrain where you can make your way up steep hills at full speed or slide down slopes as you, please. After an exciting ride, freshen up with a relaxing shower before feasting on a buffet meal of scrumptious food. Be dropped off safely back at your hotel to enjoy the rest of your day.

Add-on: Authentic Cooking Class in a Local Village - USD Per person

Benefit from pick-up at your hotel, and then visit a local fresh food market to choose the ingredients for your cooking class. Select from the available vegetables, herbs, meat, and spices on display and experience a little of the local life in Bali. Next, visit a rice plantation and learn how the staple crop is cultivated and prepared. Soak up the scenic views of the surroundings. Continue to the traditional village of Laplapan, where you will get a warm welcome from the locals on arrival. Take part in a half-day morning or afternoon cooking class and learn all the secrets of preparing food from Bali, while expert chefs provide guidance and assistance. Interact with your fellow cooks and discover handy techniques as you prepare 3 starters, 4 main courses, and 1 authentic dessert. Then, sit down for a meal and savor the delicious flavors of your creations.

Overnight in Ubud

DAY 4 Ubud - Ubud tour including Waterfall, Ubud traditional market, Ubud palace, Tegalaing Rice terrace [B/L/-]

After being picked up from your hotel, the tour begins with a visit to the Tegenungan waterfall, a beautiful spot on the south side of Ubud where you can relax and enjoy the stunning view while sipping a cup of tea. Next, you will head to Mas Village, a town renowned for its intricate wood carvings. Here, you will have the chance to witness the skilled craftsmanship of Bali's prominent woodcarvers and learn about their traditional techniques. You will then proceed to the Ubud Monkey Forest, a tropical green forest home to over 600 long-tailed macaques. Within the forest, you will also find a sacred temple sanctuary guarded by monkeys, providing a unique opportunity to observe the local wildlife. Next, you will visit the Ubud

Traditional Market, a bustling hub where locals gather to sell fresh produce, handicrafts, and souvenirs. Here, you can immerse yourself in the daily life of the community and discover unique treasures. Afterward, you will visit the Ubud King Palace, a magnificent complex located in the heart of Ubud. This impressive site showcases traditional Balinese architecture and offers the opportunity to witness daily traditional Balinese dance performances. The tour then continues to Tegalalang Rice Terrace, a picturesque location where you can enjoy the breathtaking view of Bali's lush countryside. Finally, you will visit a coffee plantation where you can taste the famous Luwak Coffee while taking in the view of the Rice Terrace. The day ends with a thrilling Jungle Swing experience, providing an adrenaline-fueled finale to this memorable Ubud tour

Add-on: Bali Swing: USD Per person

Challenge yourself to ride the 20-meter Jungle Swing to the jungle valley or rice terraces. Enjoy the views and take Instagrammable pictures during this once-in-a-lifetime experience.

Overnight in Ubud

DAY 5 Ubud - Taman Ayun - Tanah Lot - Bali [B/-/-]

The morning after breakfast, spend time at leisure. Later this afternoon, meet your guide and visit the Taman Ayun Temple located in Mengwi, about 30 minutes from Ubud. It was built in the 17th century by the King of Mengwi and is surrounded by a moat and beautiful gardens. The temple's architecture and historical significance make it a must-visit site in Bali. Next, we will head to Tanah Lot Temple, situated on a rock formation in the middle of the sea and one of the most photographed and iconic landmarks in Bali. It's located in Tabanan, about an hour's drive from Taman Ayun Temple. Tanah Lot is a popular spot for tourists to enjoy the sunset and take stunning photos of the temple and ocean. Post-tour will be dropped off at the hotel in Bali. Spend the rest of the evening at leisure

Overnight in Bali

DAY 6 Bali - Day free at leisure [B/-/-]

Enjoy your breakfast. Your day is free at leisure to relax on Bali's stunning beaches. Spend the day sunbathing, swimming, pampering with some holistic massage, simply unwinding on the pristine shores, and exploring the Islands diverse attractions, or pre-book one of our suggested add-ons

Add-on - Norther Bali - Lake Bratan, Handara Gate, and Waterfall tour - USD Per person

Journey through the mountains towards Ulun Danu Beratan Temple. Like Bali's postcards, you will see the majestic temple sitting on a small lake island. Also known as Pura Ulun Danu, this 400-year-old Hindu temple is dedicated to the goddess Dewi Danu and is featured on the 50,000 Rupiah banknote. Explore the sacred water temple surrounded by scenic mountains with a knowledgeable guide who will share plenty of interesting facts about the history of the site. This lakeside temple was constructed in honor of Dewi Danu, goddess of the lake, which was formed by a volcanic eruption 30,000 years ago. Your guide will explain this ancient temple's history, the Balinese people, and culture. You will then visit the iconic Handara Gate, well known as the pathway to serenity. Take a wonderful picture in front of Handara Gate with the breathtaking view of green scenery and the gigantic-exotic traditional Balinese gate as your backdrop. Prepare your walking shoes because you will visit the majestic and beautiful Banyumala Twin Waterfall next. The natural pool is inviting with its translucent turquoise waters. Swim in tranquility, listen to the thunderous roar of cascading waters, and take in the sights of the vibrant greenery

Overnight in Bali

DAY 7 Bali - Day trip to Besakih Temple & Lempuyang Temple Gates of Heaven including lunch [B/L/-]

Morning meet your guide being your journey to the eastern part of Bali to visit the mother temple of Bali, Pura Besakih, along with Pura Penataran Agung Lempuyang temple and its iconic Gate of Heaven. Enjoy convenient hotel transfers and a lunch stop overlooking Mount Agung.

Following a pickup from your hotel, head to the majestic Lempuyang Temple in the eastern part of Bali. Along the way, pass long stretches of beautiful and pristine rice paddies, travel along winding roads, and

marvel at breathtaking mountains.

Be awed by the magical views of Mount Agung behind the temple. Your own private guide will not only snap cool shots for you but will also explain the history of the ancient temple as well as the Balinese people and their culture.

Next, visit Tirta Gangga, known as the most beautiful former royal water palace in Eastern Bali. Explore the water palace's tiered fountains, gardens, and stone sculptures of mythical creatures spouting water into pools. Outside the palace, soak up views of the lush rice paddies of northeastern Bali. After visiting the water palace, savor a scrumptious buffet lunch overlooking Mount Agung, Telaga Waja River, and the rice fields. When you are finished, make your way to the biggest temple in Bali, Pura Besakih. Learn why it is the most important, largest, and holiest temple of Hindu religion in Bali and one of a series of Balinese temples. The temple miraculously survived the catastrophic volcanic eruption of 1963.

Add-on - Uluwatu Temple, Kecak Dance and Jimbaran Bay with Sea Food dinner - USD Per person

Experience the best sundown spot in Bali on a visit to Uluwatu Temple, a Balinese temple to the sea gods with a commanding view of the Indian Ocean. Part of a series of temples built to protect the island from evil spirits, today its cliffside location is home to a family of friendly monkeys. Once night falls and you have seen the colors of the sunset, experience one of the island's most famous cultural performances at a "kecak" fire dance. Watch the locals act out a scene from the Ramayana with a mesmerizing trance chant, exciting performances of fire dances, and intricate costumes. Then, get the option to enjoy dinner at a seafood restaurant serving delicious barbecue food in Jimbaran Bay. Sink your feet in the sand as you dine and relax at the end of an unforgettable day!
