DAY 1 Depart USA [-/-/-]

Jambo Kenya... Upon your arrival at Nairobi's Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, your driver guide will greet you and swiftly transport you to your hotel (Standard check-in time is 3:00 pm). Once you have checked in relax.

Overnight in Nairobi

DAY 3 Nairobi - Day free at leisure.

Today you have the opportunity to explore the city at your own pace. Just a short drive from downtown, you can immerse yourself in the natural beauty of **Nairobi National Park**, where lions, giraffes, and rhinos roam freely. Opt for a self-guided game drive or join a guided tour to delve into the fascinating world of wildlife. Next, visit the **David Sheldrick Wildlife Trust**, an inspiring elephant orphanage dedicated to rescuing and rehabilitating these gentle giants. Participate in a public viewing to learn about the important conservation efforts in place to protect them. For a unique experience, head to the **Giraffe Centre**, where you can get up close to the endangered Rothschild giraffe. Feed them and discover more about their habitat and the ongoing conservation initiatives. To deepen your understanding of the region, visit the **Nairobi National Museum**. Here, you can explore a rich collection of artifacts and art that showcase Kenya's history and culture, along with a beautiful botanical garden to wander through.

Another stop worth making is the **Kazuri Beads Factory**, where you can witness the art of crafting beautiful ceramic beads and pottery. Learn about the production process and pick up some unique souvenirs.

Don't miss the chance to indulge in **Nairobi's culinary delights**. Savor traditional Kenyan dishes at local restaurants or try street food for an authentic

taste of the city.

Finally, take some time to unwind at one of Nairobi's many cafés or bars, sipping on coffee or a refreshing drink while soaking in the lively atmosphere of the city.

Overnight in Nairobi

DAY 4 Nairobi - Serengeti National Park [B/L/D]

Today you will be transferred to Nairobi airport where you will connect with a scheduled flight to Serengeti. Upon arrival in Serengeti National Park, you will be picked up and transferred to your Lodge. Upon arrival, enjoy lunch, and settle in.

Once checked-in, You could opt to either relax at your lodge or begin your game drive or visit Masai Village

Add-on: Visit Masai Village - USD 75 Per person

Immerse yourself in a traditional **Maasai village**. The Maasai are one of Africa's most renowned tribes, primarily found in northern Tanzania, particularly near the Serengeti. This nomadic warrior community has maintained many of its customs, living largely free from modern influences.

Maasai villages are situated on the fringes of the **Serengeti National Park**. Although there is an entry fee, visitors are encouraged to buy handmade crafts from the locals, though it is not obligatory. The Maasai live in **Manyatta**, which are low huts made of mud and cow dung, featuring a single entrance and few windows. These huts cluster together to form a **Boma**, creating a homestead, and multiple Bomas can combine to form a larger village.

Inside a Manyatta, the dim lighting results from the small windows, and these traditional villages lack piped water, electricity, or gas, in contrast to nearby developed areas. A typical Manyatta hut, with a Maasai woman outside and an earthen stove within, exemplifies their simple yet resilient lifestyle.

Overnight in Serengeti

DAY 5 Serengeti - Full day game drives [B/L/D]

The **Serengeti** is a breathtaking destination, renowned for its expansive grasslands that offer exceptional wildlife viewing opportunities. While it is home to a diverse range of animals, it is most famous for the annual **Great Migration**, where large herds of wildebeests, zebras, and antelopes move in search of fresh grazing. The migration can be observed throughout the year; you just need to know where to look. Depending on your visit, you might witness one of the **Seven Wonders of the Natural World**.

This day is dedicated to game drives in the Serengeti, where you'll find an abundance of wildlife, including impalas, buffalos, crocodiles, and hippos. In addition to its stunning landscapes, there are also good chances of spotting predators such as lions, cheetahs, and leopards, making it a truly transformative experience. You can choose to embark on early morning and late afternoon game drives, returning to camp for lunch, or opt for a full-day game drive with a picnic lunch in the park.

For those seeking an extra adventure, there is an optional opportunity to partake in an early morning hot air balloon ride over the Serengeti, offering stunning landscapes and incredible wildlife views.

Add-on: Morning Hot Air Balloon including breakfast: USD 590 Per Adult / USD 540 Per child (7-11 years) (child below 7 years are not allowed)

A hot air balloon safari in the iconic Serengeti National Park promises to be a highlight of your Tanzania adventure. Rising at sunrise, you'll float gracefully over the vast Serengeti plains, soaring at treetop height above the baobabs and acacias, allowing for close views of wildlife below. This tranquil experience offers breathtaking panoramic views and an unparalleled perspective on the animals.

Begin your day before dawn, departing from your Serengeti camp in the serene silence of the early morning. At the balloon launch site, your pilot will conduct a safety briefing as the crew prepares the balloon. Then, climb into the basket and get ready to ascend into the sky.

As the balloon rises, watch the horizon reveal itself, painted in stunning gold and pink hues by the rising sun. Your experienced pilot will skillfully navigate the

African winds while pointing out wildlife beneath you.

After about an hour in the air, the basket will descend back to the Serengeti plains. Each flight is unique, with landing points determined by the wind direction, adding to the adventure. Upon landing, celebrate with a glass of bubbly before being transported to a special breakfast location.

Savor a delicious breakfast served under an acacia tree in the heart of the Serengeti. Enjoy tropical fruits, freshly baked bread, and eggs cooked in the bush, all presented elegantly on linen and bone china with Sheffield cutlery, in true "Out of Africa" style. Share the experience with fellow passengers as you reminisce about the extraordinary flight you've just enjoyed.

After breakfast, you'll make your way to **Seronera Airstrip** for your flight to **Zanzibar** (departure at **11:00 AM**). After being picked up from your hotel, start with a walking tour of Stone Town, the oldest part of Zanzibar City. Explore historical sites like the slave markets and bustling daily markets, and enjoy some shopping. Stone Town, a UNESCO World Heritage site since 2000, is known for its rich cultural heritage influenced by Arabian, Indian, Persian, and European elements. As you wander through the winding streets, admire former palaces, the Sultan's Palace, and Arab mansions, while learning about the tragic history of the slave trade.

Following the walking tour, you'll be driven to a spice plantation, where you'll discover why Zanzibar is known as the "Spice Island." The Spice Tour is a highlight of excursions in Zanzibar, renowned for its production of spices like clove, nutmeg, and cinnamon. You'll have the chance to smell, touch, and even taste some of the crops grown on the island while learning about their original uses. Spices and herbs were introduced to Zanzibar by Portuguese traders in the 16th century, who brought them from their colonies in South America and India. Enjoy a guided walking tour of a spice farm, where you can see the cultivation of spices, herbs, and fruits. Your knowledgeable guide will explain the cultivation methods and various uses of these crops. Immerse yourself in the delightful aromas and flavors of spices,
